LAST TIME OUT

The Bowie Baysox's three-game win streak and five-game home winning streak came to an end on Thursday night in an 11-3 loss to Erie. The SeaWolves jumped out to a 4-0 lead at the end of the fourth inning against Trace Bright after back-to-back homers and a two-run triple by Stephen Scott. The Baysox got within a run on a TT Bowens two-run homer and an RBI single by Jud Fabian at the end of the fifth. Erie scored six unanswered runs in the sixth and seventh innings to put the game away and get their first win of the series.

SIZING UP THE SEAWOLVES

The Erie Seawolves suffered their first series loss of the season this past week, dropping three of five to Harrisburg at home. Sunday's finale was postponed due to inclement weather. Entering this series, Erie owns the second lowest ERA (2.56) in the league but has scored the fewest runs in the league (71). The defending Eastern League champion's roster includes five of the Tigers' top 30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline - RHP Jackson Jobe (No. 3), RHP Troy Melton (No. 11), IF Hao-Yu Lee (No. 14), RHP Tyler Mattison (No. 27), and OF/INF Trei Cruz (No. 30).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Austin Bergner gets the start for the SeaWolves tonight. The right-hander turned 27 on Wednesday and is making his first start for Erie this season after five starts in Triple-A Toledo to date the year. In five starts with the Mud Hens, Bergner threw 14 innings and posted an 11.57 ERA. Bergner was assigned to Double-A Erie on Monday. The Tigers' 9th round pick in 2019 spent much of last year in Erie out of the bullpen, pitching 51 innings with 62 strikeouts to an ERA of 4.41.

TERRY HITS TATERS

1B **TT Bowens** drilled his fourth homer of the season yesterday in the loss against Erie. The 25-year-old is tied with Samuel Basallo for the team lead in home runs and is currently on a six-game hit streak. After playing just 47 games last year due to injuries, Bowens is tied at the top of the Eastern League leaderboard with 20 RBI, along with New Hampshire's Josh Kasevich. The undrafted free agent is fifth in the league in AVG (.328), fourth in SLG (.594) and fourth in OPS (.983).

LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS

OF **Dylan Beavers** came through late for the Baysox on Wednesday with a go-ahead two-run homer in the eighth to give Bowie the lead and the win. All three of Beavers' homers have been go-ahead homers, including two that have been hit in the seventh or later. The Orioles No. 7 prospect owns the seventh-best batting average in the league (.312) and has the seventh-best OBP (.407). The 22-year-old owns the longest on-base streak on the team at 15 consecutive games.

BASALLO HITS BOMBS

After C **Samuel Basallo** recorded his first multi-homer game of the season and his first multi-homer game in Double-A in Richmond on Sunday, the Orioles No. 2 prospect homered again on Tuesday, his fourth of the season. The 19-year-old also drove in three RBI for a second consecutive game. Basallo is tied with TT Bowens for the team lead in homers with four.

FOREVER YOUNG

RHP **Brandon Young** makes his third start of the season tonight and his first one at home. The 25-year-old is coming off his best outing of the season last Saturday in Richmond when he pitched three perfect innings and matched his season-high and Double-A high in strikeouts with seven. It was Young's first outing back off the injured list after suffering left oblique soreness on April 16. The undrafted free agent out of Louisiana-Lafayette is in his third season with the Baysox after making six starts in Bowie last year. Young threw 25.1 innings and struck out 23 batters over just six walks to a 4.26 ERA last season.

HOME SWEET HOME

The Baysox have the best home record in the league so far at 9-3. No other Eastern League team has won nine games at home. At home this season, the Baysox are first in runs scored (81), first in home runs (17), OPS (.831), and are tied for second in the league in batting average (.270). Last night snapped Bowie's five-game win streak at home.

The “Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake” are an alternate identity of the Baysox, as a part of MiLB’s “Copa de la Diversión™” or “Fun Cup™”. During select games during the 2024 season, the Baysox will take the field as the Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake, as the Baysox look to continue to embrace the culture of local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie’s “Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake” identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.



CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the “Chesapeake Baysox.” This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stenciled outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince George’s Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.

BOWIE PIT BEEF

The “Bowie Pit Beef” is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore’s east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.



COACHING STAFF

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization’s Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado in the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

JOSH BUNSELMEYER

Hitting Coach

Bunselmeyer served as the hitting coach for the Orioles’ Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, last season. 2024 is Bunselmeyer’s fifth season in the Orioles’ system after also spending the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League. He played three seasons in the Independent Frontier League following a collegiate playing career at Saint Louis University.
