YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels swept a double-header against the Yard Goats to reach four consecutive wins. In Game 1, **Matt Frisbee** and **Patrick Ruotolo** combined for a shutout in a 2-0 win. **David Villar** brought in the first run of the game with an RBI double. In the sixth, Villar scored after a throwing error. In Game 2, the Flying Squirrels erupted for eight runs in the fourth inning to pull away from the Yard Goats in a 9-5 win. **Sandro Fabian** hit a three-run homer in the inning.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the sixth game of the 2021 season and the finale of a six-game series against the Hartford Yard Goats, Double-A affiliate of the Colorado Rockies. This series marks Hartford's only visit to The Diamond in 2021. The Flying Squirrels will visit Connecticut's capital city from June 22-27 for a six-game series.

A BUNCH OF SELLOUTS: The Flying Squirrels have sold out all five openings of the 2021 season, including today. While adhering to guidelines set forth by the Commonwealth of Virginia and Major League Baseball, maximum capacity is currently capped at 30 percent, which is 2,943 fans. Although a bit below the standard sellout of 9,845, the Flying Squirrels' all-time sell-out total is now at 55. The Flying Squirrels are 37-21 all-time in sellouts (including double-headers). The Flying Squirrels have sold out all 11 of their home openers in the franchise's history.

GOING STREAKING: The Flying Squirrels have won four straight games, matching the team's longest winning streak from the 2019 season. The last four-game winning streak for the Flying Squirrels was August 26-29, 2019, which was part of a stretch where the team won seven of the final eight games to close out the year against Erie and Bowie. They also had a four-game winning streak from June 20-23, 2019. The last time the team won at least five games was a six-game winning streak from April 13-18, 2018, which came at The Diamond against Reading and Bowie.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS finished the 2019 season with a 55-84 record, the worst in the franchise's history, and finished in last place in the Eastern League's Western Division for the second consecutive year. Seven players from the 2019 team are back in Richmond to start the 2021 season, including **Jacob Heyward**, **Sean Hjelle**, **Ryan Howard**, **Peter Maris**, **Heliot Ramos**, **Frank Rubio** and **Raffi Vizcaino**. Reliever **Patrick Ruotolo** did not appear with the Flying Squirrels in 2019, but he did pitch in Richmond in 2018. Outfielder **Vince Fernandez** played in the Eastern League with Hartford in 2019.

THE YARD GOATS return four players from their 2019 team and welcome 24 newcomers. Six players from the 2019 Yard Goats have gone on to reach the majors. The 2021 Hartford roster includes four players ranked by MLB.com in the Rockies' Top-30 prospects, including RHP **Ryan Rolison** (2), 3B **Elehuris Montero** (9), OF **Jameson Hannah** (13) and RHP **Tommy Doyle** (22). The Yard Goats went 73-66 in 2019 and finished in third place in the Eastern League's Eastern Division.

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Tristan Beck** makes his second start of the season. He last pitched in the season opener on Tuesday against the Yard Goats, working 4.0 innings and allowing three runs (two earned) in a loss. Drafted by the Atlanta Braves in the fourth round in 2018, Beck was traded to the Giants along with RHP Dan Winkler for reliever Mark Melancon on July 31, 2019 at the trade deadline. That year, his first full professional season, he began the campaign with the High-A Florida Fire Frogs and went 0-1 with a 7.71 ERA through his first four starts before being placed on the injured list with an oblique injury in late-April. After a rehab assignment in the GCL, Beck returned to make four more starts before being traded. He made six total starts with High-A San Jose to close out 2019, and went 3-0 with a 0.47 ERA (1 ER/19.0 IP) in his last three outings of the season. **For more on Beck, see page two.**

FOR HARTFORD: Right-hander Ryan Rolison makes his second start of the 2021 season. Selected by Colorado in the first round (22nd overall) in the 2018 MLB Draft, Rolison has a career 3.87 ERA and 173 strikeouts over 165 innings pitched. The 23-year-old attended Rockies spring training twice as a non-roster invitee in 2020 and 2021 and also saw work at the Rockies' Alternate Training Site over the last year. Rolison is rated by *Baseball America* and MLB.com as the Rockies' No. 2 prospect. He pitched on opening night against the Flying Squirrels and allowed one run on three hits over 5.0 innings with seven strikeouts.

PLAY THE HITS: The Flying Squirrels are batting .321 as a team, which is best in the league and second-highest in Double-A behind Chattanooga. The team is also ranked second in the league in runs scored (32), second in hits (50), second in RBIs (28), second in OBP (.381), second in SLG (.462) and second in OPS (.843), sitting behind Erie in each of those categories.

RAMOS RAKING: **Heliot Ramos** homered in back-to-back games for the fifth time in his career with blasts on Wednesday and Thursday. He has now collected five home runs at the Double-A level and 35 during his career in the minors. Ramos is currently ranked fourth in the Double-A Northeast in batting average (.444), tied for third in home runs (2), tenth in OBP (.524), fifth in SLG (.889), third in OPS (1.413), tied for second in hits (8), tied for second in extra-base hits (4), second in extra-base hits (16) and first in runs scored (8).

SWINGIN' SUGILIO: **Andy Sugilio** enters the day leading the Double-A Northeast in batting average (.500) tied for fifth in OBP (.533), tied for fifth in hits (7), and tied for first in stolen bases (2). Sugilio is in his first season at the Double-A level and his first with the Giants organization after playing the first six seasons of his career as a member of the Cincinnati Reds minor league system from 2014-2019.

WELCOME BACK, AUGGIE: **José Alguacil** returns to manage the Flying Squirrels after leading the team to a 72-68 record in 2015, the most recent season the team has posted a winning record. Alguacil is in his 15th overall season with the Giants organization and worked at the Alternate Training Site in 2020. He previously served as the first base coach and oversaw bunting instruction while assisting with infield defense and baserunning in San Francisco from 2017-2019 on Bruce Bochy's major league staff.

ALL OVER THE MAP: The Flying Squirrels roster contains 18 players from 11 different states across the United States: California (5), Georgia (3), Florida (2) and one player from North Carolina, Minnesota, Illinois, Massachusetts, New York, Missouri, Washington and Ohio. Nine players grew up in four countries and territories outside of the 50 states, including the Dominican Republic (4), Puerto Rico (2), Venezuela (2) and Colombia (1).

THE MORE THE MERRIER: Under the new Player Development License structure, Double-A active rosters include 28 players, up from 25 in the previous system. The Flying Squirrels initial roster includes 15 pitchers and 13 position players.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have three players included in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects: **Heliot Ramos** (3), **Tristan Beck** (12) and **Sean Hjelle** (13). Ramos is also rated by *Baseball America* as the No. 83 overall prospect. Ramos (3), Hjelle (11) and Beck (20) are also ranked in MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospects.

BULLS REUNITED: Richmond's **David Villar** and Hartford's **Coco Montes** were teammates while at University of South Florida during the 2016-2018 seasons. As a junior, Villar was an 11th round selection by the Giants in the 2018 MLB Draft while Montes was selected in the 15th round by the Rockies. This season marks the first time the pair have been in the same league/level in the minors with one another as professionals.

THE SAME BUT DIFFERENT: Prior to the 2021 season, Major League Baseball realigned its player development structure, eliminating the Eastern League, which was the home of the Flying Squirrels for ten seasons. Under the new alignment, the Flying Squirrels play in the 12-team Double-A Northeast, which includes 11 of the former E.L. teams. The Somerset Patriots are the only new opponent on Richmond's schedule this year. The Flying Squirrels are in the Double-A Northeast Southwest Division, which includes its former foes from the E.L. Western Division, including Akron, Altoona, Bowie, Erie and Harrisburg. The Northeast Division includes Binghamton, Hartford, New Hampshire, Portland, Reading and Somerset.

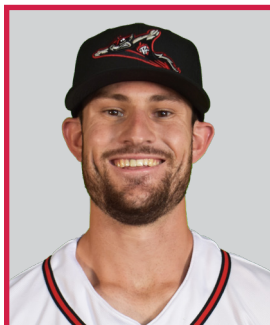
