Today's Game: The Nashville Sounds and Durham Bulls wrap their six-game series this afternoon from First Horizon Park. The Sounds have won three of the first five, including last night's 2-1 win behind a strong performance from starter Josh Lindblom. Southpaw Ethan Small starts for Nashville against right-hander Robert Dugger for Durham.

Ethan Small: 25-year-old Ethan Small starts for Nashville in today's finale. The left-hander is making his second start of the season after getting the ball on Opening Day. He got a no-decision after throwing 4.1 innings in Nashville's 5-4 win. Small allowed two unearned runs on two hits. He walked a pair and struck out six. Small enters the season as the #7 prospect in the Brewers organization according to MLB Pipeline and #9 prospect according to Baseball America. He made nine starts for Nashville in 2021 and went 2-0 with a 2.06 ERA. He's also coming off a season where he was named a MiLB.com Organization All-Star and pitched for the National League Futures team in the MLB Futures Game. Milwaukee selected Small as the 28th overall pick of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft.

Robert Dugger: 26-year-old Robert Dugger starts for the Bulls in today's finale. The right-hander is making his second start of the season after getting the ball in game two of the year. He tossed 2.0 scoreless innings in Durham's win. Dugger was signed by Tampa Bay as a free agent on March 20. He spent the 2021 season in the Mariners organization, going 0-2 with a 7.36 ERA in 12 games (4 starts) with Seattle and 4-5 with a 6.10 ERA in 15 games (14 starts) with Triple-A Tacoma. He made 4 appearances (1 starts) with Miami in 2020, posting a 12.66 ERA over 10.2 innings pitched. Dugger was originally drafted by the Mariners in the 18th Round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft. He played collegiantly at Texas Tech University and graduated from Tomball (TX) High School.

Looking for a Series Win: Nashville is looking for a series win to start the season for a second consecutive year. Last year the Sounds opened in Toledo and won three of five over the Mud Hens. The last time Nashville won their first home series of the season was in 2018 when they took two of three games over visiting Iowa.

Start Me Up: On the heels of Jason Alexander's 5.0 scoreless innings Friday night, Nashville's Josh Lindblom matched his fellow right-hander with 5.0 shutout frames of his own. Nashville starters have not allowed a run in 11.1 innings, dating back to Dylan File's start Thursday night.

Walks Lead to Runs for JD: Outfielder Jonathan Davis has been an on-base machine in the early going. Davis has a .643 on-base percentage and has reached safely in all three games he has played. He has drawn six walks and scored three runs. He has drawn at least one walk and has scored one run in every game he has played.

First to Score Wins: In all five games in this season-opening series, the team that has scored first has gone on to win the game.

On the Mark: Mark Mathias has played in two games for Nashville and has a multi-hit game in each. He's hitting .571 (4-for-7) on the season, with two of his four hits going for extra bases. Mathias is making his third start of the season today and hitting in the five spot.

How Sweet It Is: Sounds manager Rick Sweet begins his third season overall and second consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. Sweet led the Sounds to a 70-58 record in 2021 and a 77-67 record in 2014. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season and has compiled a 511-462 record during this span.

Nobody's Perfect: The Sounds enter the day in a tie for second place in the International League's West Division, 1.0 game back from St. Paul. No team in the division is unbeaten through five games, as the Sounds are tied with three other teams that are also 3-2.

The Future Brew Crew: Nashville opens the 2022 season with four players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Infielder Brice Turang is the No. 4 prospect, left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the No. 7 prospect, catcher Mario Feliciano is the No. 21 prospect and right-handed pitcher Dylan File is the No. 25 prospect.

LAST OUTING: Small started for Nashville on Opening Day and got a no-decision in the 5-4 win. The southpaw went 4.1 innings and allowed two unearned runs on two hits. He walked a pair of batters and struck out six. He threw 48 of his pitches for strikes.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Small is facing Durham for the second time in his career with Opening Day as the first.
