WHITE BRILLIANT, OFFENSE EXPLODES LATE IN THIRD-STRAIGHT WIN:

The Frisco RoughRiders dominated the Corpus Christi Hooks on Wednesday night, winning 9-0 from Whataburger Field for their second shutout win of the season. **Owen White** (2-3) poured in the longest start of the season for any Frisco (24-28) pitcher on the season, tossing seven shutout innings with six strikeouts while only allowing one hit and walking two. **Nick Starr** and **Eudrys Manon** then pitched an inning apiece to secure the shutout win, the first for the Riders since April 14th in San Antonio. On the offensive side, **Luisangel Acuña** scored on an RBI groundout in the first from **Nick Tanielu** to make it 1-0. Frisco added on in the fifth when **Thomas Saggese** clobbered the first Riders homer of the series, a two-run shot, to make it 3-0. It was Saggese's fifth home run of the season and he is the only player to hit a home run since May 26th, homering twice. Frisco then added on late, scoring three times in the eighth and ninth innings to cap the blowout win. Acuña, Saggese, Tanielu and **Dustin Harris** all totaled multi-hit games in the victory. Colton Gordon (2-4) was saddled with the loss for Corpus Christi (25-28), going five innings in his start and allowing three runs.

NEW MONTH, NEW ME:

In the first six games of June, the RoughRiders have turned around their struggles from May so far. Frisco is 4-2 in June with a 3.27 ERA, which is the third-best in the Texas League. The Riders are also at the top of the league in walks as an offense and third in OBP at a .365 mark.

COMEBACK KIDS:

With the RoughRiders victory on Tuesday, Frisco has had back-to-back come-from-behind wins. Frisco trailed 2-1 into the seventh before taking the lead for good on Tuesday while they trailed 6-2 into the fourth on Sunday against San Antonio before scoring five runs in the fourth to take a lead they would not give up. Of their 24 wins of on the season, eight have been after trailing at some point.

THE SPEAS THAT PLEASES:

With his appearance on Tuesday, reliever **Alex Speas** now has an ERA under 1.00 at 0.89 over 18 appearances. In 20.1 innings, he has struck out 35 to 10 walks. Opponents are hitting just .151 against him and he has not allowed an earned run over his last nine outings. During that span, he has struck out 20 to three walks over 10 innings. On the season, righties are just hitting .123 (7-for-57) against him on the season with a .383 OPS.

PLEASE CONNECT TO POWER:

Over the last 17 games (8-9 record), Frisco has hit just four home runs while batting .223/.341/.302/.643. The four home runs (from **Liam Hicks**, **Trevor Hauver** and **Thomas Saggese**, who has the last two) are the fewest in the league over the last 17. The Riders are averaging just 4.4 runs per game over the last 17 games, which is the second-fewest in the league (only in front of Northwest Arkansas, 2.8).

AMBUSH EARLY AND OFTEN:

Thomas Saggese has been fantastic on first pitches this season, fourth in the Texas League with a .579 average (11-for-19) when he puts the first pitch of an at-bat in play. He has a 1.442 OPS on the first pitch. **Luisangel Acuña** has also been great, hitting .485 (16-for-33) on the initial offering while his 16 hits on the first pitch lead the league.

DUSTIN' THEM AND LEAVING THEM BEHIND:

Dustin Harris has been running wild for the RoughRiders this season. After stealing 19 bases in 85 games in 2022, Harris has already swiped 23 bags in 50 games this season to lead the Texas League and the entire Rangers organization. If Harris plays 110 games this season, he is on pace for 51 steals, which would by far be a career high. **Luisangel Acuña** and Harris are tied for the league lead in steals with 23. The RoughRiders are second in Texas League swipes with 81 bases in 93 attempts (87 percent).

ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Thomas Saggese** hitting Frisco's seventh grand slam of the season on Friday. They are one of two teams with seven grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Six different players have accounted for the grand slams (**Hicks**, **Luisangel Acuña**, **Jax Biggers**, **Dustin Harris**, **Trevor Hauver**, **Thomas Saggese** (2)). Frisco also has a 1.189 OPS with the bags full, which is third in the minors (Low-A Myrtle Beach, 1.295 and Triple-A Saint Paul, 1.274).

ACUÑA MATATA:

RoughRiders infielder **Luisangel Acuña** has been on fire to start his 2023 season. The Rangers No. 3 prospect is hitting .297 (57-for-192)/.367/.417/.784 through the first 45 games. Over his last 41 games, he is batting .310/.386/.443/.829. When the 21-year-old arrived in Frisco in 2022, he had a wRC+ of 68 while it has nearly doubled this season (113).

WALK THIS WAY:

On the season, Frisco's 268 walks are tied for first among Texas League teams while their .354 team OBP is third in the Texas League. **Dustin Harris** is first in the league with 39 walks.

ABOUT NICK

-Went to Northgate High School in Walnut Creek, California (across the Bay from San Francisco, east of Berkeley). His senior season, he went 6-5 with a 2.20 ERA over 11 games.

-Krauth then went to the University of New Mexico for the 2018 season, where he was teammates with current RoughRiders pitcher Justin Slaten.

-After New Mexico, transferred to Diablo Valley College in Pleasant Valley, California where he went 8-4 with a 2.20 ERA. Following that strong season, he transferred again, this time to the University of Connecticut, where he was one of the best pitchers in the country for the 2020 season before it was cut short due to COVID. In his four starts, he went 4-0 with a 0.36 ERA and a .167 BAA. This included five one-run innings against the No. 1 Michigan Wolverines on February 23rd.

-Due to the 2020 MLB Draft getting shortened to five rounds, Krauth went undrafted and signed with the Rangers as a free agent on June 15th.

-Brother, Ben Krauth, pitched for the San Antonio Missions in 2022, making nine starts and recording a 7.18 ERA. In two starts against Frisco, the RoughRiders touched him up for a combined seven runs, six earned, over 7.2 innings while handing him two losses. Ben was released by the Padres organization at the end of the year and retired after six seasons of MiLB experience.

2023 SEASON

-Krauth made first appearance of the season out of the bullpen on Friday, April 7th, allowing three runs over four innings.

-In his first start, Krauth went shutout five innings at San Antonio on April 14th to earn the first win among RoughRiders starting pitchers.

-Threw four scoreless innings on April 20th before game was suspended due to rain in the top of the fifth with the Riders up 9-0, ending his night early. The Riders and the Travelers went on to finish the game on April 21st with Frisco winning 13-5.

-Allowed a run in the fourth inning against Amarillo on April 26th, snapping a 14.2-consecutive innings scoreless streak dating back to April 7th.

-Joined Triple-A Round Rock on May 2nd for a spot start and make two appearances. In his start, he went 3.2 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 0 ER, 3 BB, 1 K. Allowed a grand slam to David Freitas of Oklahoma City in relief appearance.

2022 SEASON

-Spent time as both a starter and reliever, going 4-7 with a 5.38 ERA in 17 starts and 1-0, 2.25 ERA out of the bullpen.

-An extreme groundball pitcher, Krauth rolled groundballs at a 50.2% clip with the Crawdads.

2021 SEASON

-Showing his durability, Krauth led the Low-A East and the Rangers organization with 102.2 innings pitched. He also made a team-high 20 starts.

-Earned Low-A East Pitcher of the Week twice, including once for a complete-game, one-hitter on August 28th vs. Fayetteville (9.0 IP, 1 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 2 BB, 9 K).
