Ins: Hudson Valley pitchers have allowed only 533 hits through 80 games. The Renegades have allowed the fewest hits in MiLB, one fewer than the Carolina Mudcats (A, MIL). Incredibly, the Amarillo Sod Poodles [AZ, AA) have allowed a staggering 753 hits through 82 games, most among all non-AAA teams.

MIDWEST REINFORCEMENTS: Jace Avina debuted with the Renegades on April 17 after being traded to New York for Jake Bauers in November from Milwaukee. The 20-year-old has been crucial all season for the Renegades. Avina is hitting . 280 (71-for-254) with 22 doubles, 41 RBIs, 36 runs scored and a 823 OPS in 66 games. His 22 doubles are tied for the third-most in the South Atlantic League. Last Friday vs. Wilmington, Avina was 2 -for-4 with a home run, double, walk, and two runs scored. Avina also currently holds a 32-game errorless streak.

INTERNATIONAL OUTREACH: The Hudson Valley Renegades and the Bhutan Baseball \& Softball Association have partnered to present Bhutan Night on August 20 at Heritage Financial Park. The team is currently fundraising to bring over several Bhutanese baseball players for baseball and cultural enrichment tour of the Hudson Valley and New York. More details on the night can be found at www.hvrenegades.com/bhutan.

DEFENSIVE ISSUES: The Renegades have the third-most errors in High-A with 101 errors in 80 games. Their .964 fielding percentage is tied for ninth-worst in the minors. In six of their last 11 games, the Renegades have played error-free. With no errors in wins on Thursday and Saturday, Hudson Valley is now 19-6 in games this season where they do not commit an error. Excluding four losses to Greensboro in which they played errorless baseball, the Renegades are 19-2 in that scenario.

POWER SURGE: Garrett Martin has been hot at the plate recently. In his last 17 games, Martin has 11 extra-base hits, including five home runs, five doubles, and a triple. Martin has a . 673 slugging percentage and a 1.048 OPS during that stretch. The outfielder hit his seventh home run of the season last Monday vs. Brooklyn, his second long ball in three games. Martin has also not committed an error in 43 games in the outfield this season for Hudson Valley.

CAROLINA POP: Josh Moylan is having his best stretch of the season. Over his last 15 games, Moylan is hitting . 309 (17-for-55) with a .491 slugging percentage and a . 858 OPS.

LEFTY SLUGGING: Omar Martinez has been getting on-base in a variety of ways. In his last ten games, the Renegades catcher is has a 425 on-base percentage and a . 941 OPS. During that span, he has two home runs and nine RBls, to go along with nine walks. His 388 on-base percentage this season ranks sixth, and his 49 walks in 2024 are tied for the fourth-most season ranks sixth, and his 49

DOMINICAN BOOST: Since being called up in mid-June, Brenny Escanio has proved to be a key addition. In 13 games, the middle infielder is hitting .289 (13-for-45), with seven RBls and six doubles.

PRESEASON PROSPECT RANKINGS: Baseball America - NYY \#10; MLB Pipeline - NYY \#१२
LAST TIME OUT: Carr pitched far better than his final line indicates last Wednesday at Maimonides Park, allowing four runs on six hits in 5.2 innings while walking one and striking out five. The left-hander had allowed just one run until the sixth when the Cyclones touched him up for three runs including a two-run home run by Wilfredo Lara that jettisoned Carr from the game. He picked up the loss as the Renegades were shut out for the second straight game.

INJURIES IN SAN DIEGO: Carr spent two years playing at the University of San Diego before transferring to Palomar for 2023. During that time he struggled with injuries including Tommy John surgery in October 2020, and a broken hand and torn right shoulder labrum in 2022. Carr to the San Diego Union-Tribune: "I struggled with injuries and school at USD. And they were related. As I fought my way through the injuries, I let my schoolwork slip. And you can't do that in college. You have to stay on top of your classes. I didn't do that. I loved the coaches and players at USD. [USD head coach] Brock Ungricht is one of the really good guys, my favorite all-time coach. I felt I let him down."

POWER PITCHING: Carr opened eyes at Palomar with a fastball that touches 97 mph , a sharp-breaking slider and a mid80s power changeup. Scouts registered his velocity as continuing to sit at 95 late into games. Carr: "The biggest thing for me is that I'm finally healthy ... That hasn't always been the case. I've always been able to throw hard, but now as I've matured, I've been able to keep my stuff late into games."

## PERSONAL:

- Full name is Kyle Isiah Carr.
- Pitched one season at Palomar College (2023) after spending two seasons at the University of San Diego (2021-22). - Underwent Tommy John surgery in October 2020 after graduating from high school, also broke his hand in February 2022 while at San Diego, then tore his right (non-pitching) labrum in March 2022 while swinging a bat.
- Had committed to play at TCU following his graduation from Palomar, but signed with the Yankees instead. TCU had recruited him out of high school, but he decided to stay home in Southern California. When he transferred to Palomar, TCU was one of the first schools to reach out.
- Was named ABCA West Region Pitcher of the Year and the ABCA Pitcher of the Year after going 12-1 with a 2.31 ERA (78.0 IP, 20 ER) in 15 games ( 14 starts) for the Palomar Comets in 2023.
- At San Diego was a two-way player who mostly pitched, going 2-for-14 at the bat in 2022.
- Graduated from San Marcos HS in 2020, where as a two-way player he hit over .400 in his last two seasons.
