LAST TIME OUT

The Bowie Baysox were nearly no-hit last night by a final of 4-2 from The Diamond. The Baysox did not score a run or record a hit for the first eight innings after Hayden Birdsong, Tanner Kiest, and Tyler Myrick combined for eight shutout, hitless innings. The Flying Squirrels scored a run in the third off **Trace Bright** and added two more in the seventh off **Ryan Hennen**. **Frederick Bencosme** broke up the no-hit bid with a leadoff single in the ninth and **TT Bowens** drove in the only runs of the game with a two-run double to cut the lead in half. **Samuel Basallo** had a chance to tie the game, representing the tying run at the plate, but he grounded out to second to end the game.

SIZING UP THE FLYING SQUIRRELS

The Flying Squirrels go for their first series win of the season after previously splitting their last two series against Akron and Harrisburg. Richmond is hoping to make the postseason for a third year in a row after falling to eventual 2023 Eastern League champion Erie last year. Richmond's roster includes six of the Giants' top 30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline - RHP Hayden Birdsong (No. 6), LHP Reggie Crawford (No. 8), OF Grant McCray (No. 13), OF Vaun Brown (No. 15), OF Victor Bericoto (No. 20), C Adrian Sugastey (No. 24)

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

LHP John Michael Bertrand gets the start for Richmond tonight. The 26-year-old is in his second season with the Flying Squirrels and will make his fourth start of the year. The left-hander most recently went 4.2 innings, allowing three runs (two earned) on six hits and three walks in a no-decision last week in Harrisburg. Prior to that start, he had pitched at least five innings in each of his first three starts. The 10th round pick out of Notre Dame climbed three levels last season between Single-A San Jose and Double-A Richmond and posted a 3.65 ERA in 118.1 innings pitched, which was third-most in the Giants system.

LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS

OF **Dylan Beavers** is off to a solid start in his second stint with the Baysox. The Orioles No. 7 prospect extended his on-base streak to 15 consecutive games on Thursday night and is one game away from matching his career-long on-base streak set back in 2022 with Single-A Delmarva. Beavers currently owns the longest active on-base streak in the Eastern League and has already surpassed his season-long on-base streak from last season at 12 games, while with High-A Aberdeen.

BOWENS IS BACK

1B **TT Bowens** continues to perform well at the plate to start the season after only playing 47 games last year with the Baysox due to injury. Bowens is tied for the league lead in RBI with 18, along with Reading's Carson Taylor. The 26-year-old ranks eighth in slugging percentage (.574) and ninth in OPS (.951). He has now recorded multi-RBI performances in back-to-back games.

BENCOSME BARRELS

IF **Frederick Bencosme** has barreled up the ball since arriving the Double-A level to begin the season. The Orioles No. 27 prospect is eighth in the Eastern League in batting average (.324), is tied for first in runs (15), is tied for second in hits (22) and is third in total bases (36). The middle infielder has hits in 13 of his first 17 Double-A contests, including seven multi-hit contests. Bencosme has also already hit three homers on the season after hitting only two all of last year in High-A Aberdeen. Only 21 years old, Bencosme was signed by the Orioles as an international free agent out of Moca in the Dominican Republic in August of 2020.

FOREVER YOUNG

RHP **Brandon Young** gets the starting nod for the Baysox today. This will be Young's 11th career Double-A start and his second of the year. The 25-year-old is coming off soreness in his left oblique that has had him on the injured list since April 17. His most recent outing was on April 16 vs Altoona where he went only one inning, allowing one run on three hits with two strikeouts after piggybacking Orioles rehabber Kyle Bradish. This will be Young's first time facing Richmond since his Double-A debut on April 9, 2022, when he went 4.1 innings, allowed five hits, one run, three walks and struck out five in a no-decision at home.

CATCHER IN THE RYE

C **Silas Ardoin** has been arguably the best defensive catcher in the league, thus far. The 23-year-old has caught a league leading 11 base runners stealing and has allowed only six stolen bases, the lowest total amongst the top 10 Eastern League catchers. Ardoin has also not committed an error behind the plate nor has he allowed a passed ball. Last season, he caught seven out of 30 base stealers in his first 26 games at Double-A.

2023: Activated off the 60-day injured list by Bowie on 8/15 and finished the season making six starts for the Baysox in his first Double-A action since 4/22/22. Rehabbed between the FCL Orioles, Single-A Delmarva, and High-A Aberdeen through July and early August, only allowing one run through eight frames in July, before allowing seven runs through 6.2 across two starts for Aberdeen in August.

2022: Started three games for Bowie, not allowing more than one run in any contest, before he was transferred to the injured list for the remainder of the season in late April and underwent Tommy John Surgery.

2021: Split time between Delmarva and Aberdeen, combining for the sixth-most strikeouts in the Orioles' system.

Personal: Signed by the Orioles following the shortened 2020 draft out of Louisiana-Lafayette. Pitched two seasons for the Ragin' Cajuns following two seasons with Howard Community College. Owns a flip phone and does not have any social media.

CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the “Chesapeake Baysox.” This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stenciled outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince George’s Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.

The “Bowie Pit Beef” is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore’s east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.



COACHING STAFF

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization’s Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado in the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

JOSH BUNSELMEYER

Hitting Coach

Bunselmeyer served as the hitting coach for the Orioles’ Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, last season. 2024 is Bunselmeyer’s fifth season in the Orioles’ system after also spending the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League. He played three seasons in the Independent Frontier League following a collegiate playing career at Saint Louis University.

CHASE SEBBY

Fundamentals Coach

Sebbly joins the Baysox staff as the Fundamentals Coach in 2024. Sebbly was the fundamentals coach in Aberdeen last season and was a development coach within the Orioles’ organization in 2022. Sebbly played collegiately as a catcher at Cypress College and Ball State.

BILLY FACTEAU

Development Coach

A familiar face in Bowie, Facteau rejoins the Baysox staff in 2024. Facteau was the development coach in Aberdeen last season, but began his professional coaching career as a development coach on the Baysox staff in 2022. Prior to his first stint with Bowie, Facteau first served in the Orioles’ organization as a technology intern.
