INF/OF **C.J. Kayfus**, MLB Pipeline's No. 28 Cleveland prospect, has knocked in 33 runs through his first 30 33 High-A games. Kayfus has the most RBI by a Captain through 30 games since at least 2005.

> RHP Trenton Denholm has recorded 3 quality starts this season, which rank tied for the 4th-most in High-A. His 2h quality start of the year came in his 2nd win of the year on April 27 at West Michigan. In 6 innings of work, Denholm allowed 4 hits, 1 earned run, and 1 walk, while throwing 8 strikeouts in an 8-1 Captains victory.

OF Guy Lipscomb has recorded 28 hits so far this month. which are the most in High-A and 4th-most in MiLB. He is batting .452 (28-for-62) during this span, which leads High-A and is 4th in MiLB.

CAPTAINS LOG

LAST TIME OUT: Lake County was outlasted by West Michigan 11-7 on Tuesday night at Classic Auto Group Park in Eastlake, in a game that featured 18 combined runs, 29 combined hits, and lasted 3 hours and 18

LF C.J. Kayfus, MLB Pipeline's No. 28 Cleveland prospect, went 4-for-5 and finished a home run shy of the cycle. CF Jake Fox, MLB Pipeline's No. 18 Cleveland prospect, went 2-for-5 with 3 RBI.

After West Michigan scored 2 runs in the top of the 1st, the Captains scored in 5 straight innings from the 2nd through the 6th. The Whitecaps also scored in 5 straight frames from the 3rd through the 7th, including back-to-back 3-run frames in the 4th and 5th

West Michigan RHP Marco Jimenez (1-1) earned the win in relief after LHP Joe Miller (ND) went 4 innings and allowed 3 runs (2 earned). Lake County RHP Juan Zapata (0-4) garnered the loss, going 3.1 innings allowing 4 runs (3 earned).

MORE SLAPS THAN THE BEATLES: While the Fab Four had 20 #1 hits, Lake County and West Michigan totaled 29 hits Tuesday, the 6th time this year that a Midwest League game featured 29+ hits. 14 players recorded a hit, with 7 notching multiple hits, and 3 tallying 4+ hits.

PITCH PERFECT: 250 of the Tuesday game's 384 pitches went for strikes, the most strikes thrown in a Midwest League game this year

2024 VERSUS WEST MICHIGAN: Lake County leads the season series 7-3 through 10 games. The Captains took 2 of 3 games from April 6-7 at home, and won 5 of 6 contests from April 23-28. Lake County is a perfect 7-0 in games that follow a West Michigan series-opening win.

YOU MAY BE RIGHT, GUY'S MAY BE CRAZY: But it just may be a Lipscomb that you're looking for. With his 11th multi-hit game of the year on Tuesday, <u>Captains OF Guy Lipscomb leads all of High-A with a</u> .452 AVG, and rank 2nd with a .527 OBP. He has reached base in all 16 of his games played this month, and is sporting a 7-game hitting streak.

2-OUT HITTING: As a team, the Captains have driven in 19 runs with 2 outs over their last 3 games. Lake County's .280 AVG with 2 outs this season ranks 3rd in Minor League Baseball.

21ST SEASON OF CAPTAINS BASEBALL: 2024 marks the 21st season of Captains Baseball. After the Columbus RedStixx were purchased in 2003, they were moved to Eastlake and became the Lake County Captains. In 2,774 regular-season games, Lake County has an all-time ecord of 1,395-1,379 (.503).

WINNING WAVES: The Captains have had a winning record in 13 of heir first 20 seasons, including in each of their last four campaigns. Lake County has made 7 playoff appearances in franchise history (5 Midwest eague, 2 South Atlantic League), with its 2010 Midwest League Championship being its sole title in franchise history.

TRENDS & NOTABLES

LIPSCOMB LEADING THE WAY: Captains OF Guy Lipscomb leads qualified High-A hitters with a .370 AVG. He also ranks 2nd among qualified High-A hitters with a 478 OBP. Last week, the 2022 5th-round pick became the only player from Single-A through Triple-A with a .479+ OBP, 9+ SB, 11-or-fewer strikeouts, and 96+ PA through 35 team games since 2005. The last MLB player to achieve these numbers was Hall-of-Fame 2B Joe Morgan, who did so in 1975 with the Cincinnati Reds.

FURMANATION: Lake County INF Nate Furman extended his hit streak to 9 games in Tuesday night's loss versus West Michigan, which is tied with Beloit INF Josh Zamora for the longest active streak in the Midwest League. **Furman** s batting .488 (20-for-41) with 4 home runs and 12 RBI during his streak.

ALL ABOARD THE TUGBOAT: On Tuesday, Cleveland announced the promotion of former Single-A Lynchburg Hillcats LHP Matt "Tugboat Wilkinson" to Lake County. Wilkinson, a 10th round pick in 2023 out of Central Arizona JC, leads Minor League Baseball with 71 strikeouts and ranks 5th with a 1.12 ERA through 8 starts with Lynchburg. The Vancouver, BC native fanned a season-high 15 batters on April 25 versus the Myrtle Beach Pelicans (Single-A Affiliate of the Chicago Cubs) in 6 no-hit innings of work.

TOP QUALITY: Through 40 games, Lake County starting pitchers have ecorded 11 quality starts (6+ IP, 3-or-fewer earned runs), which are the most in High-A. RHPs Austin Peterson (4), Trenton Denholm (3), and Carter Spivey (3) have each recorded at least 3, while LHP Parker Messick, MLB Pipeline's No. 21 Cleveland prospect, has also recorded 1 this season (4/25 @ West

BASH BROS 2.0: Captains INF Alex Mooney, MLB Pipeline's No. 20 Cleveland prospect, and INF/OF C.J. Kavfus, MLB Pipeline's No. 28 Cleveland prospect. have accounted for 31.0% of Lake County's RBI, while hitting 12 of the team's

STRONG STARTING PITCHING: Lake County's starting pitching staff has been one of the premier units in the Midwest League so far this season. The group ranks top-4 in the Midwest League in: wins (13, 1st), fewest walks (48, 1st), innings pitched (188.0, 2nd), strikeouts 181, 4th), and WHIP (1.31, 5th).

HEROIC HITTING: Captains hitters have been having a strong season at the plate so far this season. The team ranks top-3 in the Midwest League in: AVG (.261, 1st), OPS (.749, 1st), OBP (.356, 1st), hits per game (8.7, 1st), fewest strikeouts (299, 3rd), runs per game (5.2, 3rd), and walks (181, 3rd).

LAST TIME OUT: Trenton Denholm (3-1) recorded his first loss of the season and in 287 days (8/3/2023 at West Michigan) on May 16 at Lansing. The right-hander went 5 innings, allowing seasonhighs of 5 runs and 9 hits, fanning 4 and walking none in the 5-4 loss. The Lugnuts scored their 5 runs off **Denholm** via 2 homers, an RBI single, an RBI double, and an RBI groundout.

DENHOLM HAULS IN THE HARDWARE: On May 13, **Denholm** was named the <u>Midwest League Pitcher of the Week</u>, as well as the <u>4th Captain of the Week presented by Official League</u> after his 7-inning complete game shutout in Game 1 of Lake County's May 10 doubleheader versus Dayton, his most recent start at Classic Auto Group Park. This was the Captains' first 7-inning complete game shutout since September 4, 2022, when current Double-A Akron RubberDucks RHP **Aaron Davenport** pitched one in Game 1 of a road doubleheader against the Great Lakes Loons. **Denholm** was the first Captain to be named Midwest League Pitcher of the Week since current Captains RHP **Juan Zapata** earned the honor on June 26, 2023.

MIDWEST LEAGUE RANKS: Denholm ranks 6th in Minor League Baseball with a 13.33 strikeout-to-walk ratio. He also ranks 4th in the Midwest League in WHIP (0.96), and is tied for 10th in strikeouts (40).

CAPTAIN ON THE MOUND: In 2023, **Denholm** played a versatile role in his first season with Lake County's pitching staff. The right-hander made 23 appearances (6 starts), recording 3 wins and 3 saves in 5 opportunities out of the Captains' bullpen. He was also very efficient on the mound last year, tallying 67 strikeouts to just 18 walks, and compiling a 1.14 WHIP.

HILLCAT ON THE HILL: Denholm pitched his first professional season in 2022, making 23 starts for the Single-A Lynchburg Hillcats. The right-hander finished the season with a 5-5 record, 4.79 ERA, and 107 strikeouts in 97.2 innings pitched.

AWESOME ANTEATER: Denholm had a strong collegiate career in his four seasons at UC Irvine. As a sophomore in 2019, the right-hander was named the 2019 Big West Pitcher of the Year, as well as a *Collegiate Baseball Newspaper* 3rd Team All-American, after finishing the campaign with a 9-4 record, 1.81 ERA, and 93 strikeouts in 99.2 innings pitched. This season resulted in **Denholm** being invited to the USA Collegiate National Team training camp, and being named to the Golden Spikes Award Watch List prior to both the 2020 and 2021 seasons.

OTHER NOTABLE ANTEATERS: Three-time all-star and former Boston/Baltimore/Cleveland OF Brady Anderson (1983-85), Keston Hiura (2015-17), former Cleveland pitcher David Huff (2004).

BASEBALL IN THE FAMILY: Denholm is related to former MLB catcher Rod Barajas. He played 14 MLB seasons with seven different teams, notably winning a World Series with the 2001 Arizona Diamondbacks. Barajas hit .235 in his MLB career, with 812 hits, 136 home runs, 480 RBI, and 187 doubles.

Two former Lake County Captains have been promoted to the Cleveland Guardians during the 2024 season.

OF Johnathan Rodríguez: On Tuesday, May 21, **OF Johnathan Rodríguez** made his MLB debut at home against the New York Mets. He started in right field and batted 7th in the Guardians' order, going 0-for-4 with 2 strikeouts. **Rodríguez** played in 103 games for the Captains across the 2021 and 2022 seasons, hitting .275 with 103 hits, 20 doubles, 23 home runs, 70 RBI, and an .862 OPS.
