SUNDAY: The Amarillo Sod Poodles (14-13) split a doubleheader with the Midland RockHounds (18-9), taking game one, 9-2, while dropping game two, 3-2, on Sunday at Momentum Bank Ballpark. In game one, Amarillo hitters scratched five runs off Jamie Arnold in the second inning. They added one in the third and poured it on in the fourth, using a flurry of doubles. The RockHounds prevented a shutout in the sixth inning and put another run on the board in the bottom of the seventh, but a last-gasp comeback attempt fell well short. In game two, the Soddies once again struck first in the second inning, but the RockHounds propelled themselves into the lead as Clark Elliott doubled home two runs in the home half of the frame. In the third, Manuel Pena's 10th home run of the season tied the game at two. Amarillo's bullpen was strong in the middle innings, but they could not cash in on plentiful scoring opportunities. With the game eventually going to extras, the RockHounds walked off the Sod Poodles on a Brennan Milone single.

HOUSE OF PENA: Manuel Pena was named the Texas League Player of the Month for April on Tuesday...his nine home runs, .644 slugging percentage, 18 extra-base hits, and 67 total bases were all-league bests...the award remains with Amarillo, as Ryan Waldschmidt won the previous honor in August 2025.

ROAD WARRIORS: The Sunday split of a doubleheader brought Amarillo's 12-game stretch away from HODGETOWN to a close...the Sod Poodles secured nine wins, a franchise record for most victories in a single road trip.

THE 'PEN IS MIGHTIER: Amarillo's bullpen posted a 2.73 ERA over the 12-game road trip to San Antonio and Midland...the figure ranks second in the Texas League over the last two weekends, trailing only Arkansas (2.52).

YES SERRETTI: Staying hot at the dish was Danny Serretti...over the last week between Triple-A Reno and Amarillo, he batted .444 (8x18) with three XBH, five RBI, and a 1.246 OPS...his .542 OBP for the year leads the TL by 100 points (De Paula, TUL).

FRANCO, MY DEAR...: In his ninth game at the bottom of the Sod Poodles batting order, Junior Franco was very productive with a pair of hits, runs, and RBI on top of stealing a base in game one on Sunday...he is slashing .438/.514/.688 as the second leadoff and leads all of Double-A in batting average and on-base percentage when penciled in to the 9-hole (minimum nine games played).

SHORT N' SWEET: Avery Short turned in his finest start of the season on Sunday, blanking Midland over five full innings...it matches the longest outing by a Sod Poodles pitcher in 2026 and is the third start of five or more shutout innings in Short's career with the Soddies.

DOWN IN THE DESERT: Arizona's No. 2 prospect Kayson Cunningham maintained his lead over the California League in batting with a two-hit game in Single-A Visalia's 7-6 loss to the San Jose Giants on Sunday, improving his average to .382 for the season.

- ▶ Selected by the Diamondbacks in the 3rd round (102nd ovr.) of the 2024 MLB Draft out of Presbyterian College...inked a \$650,000 signing bonus.
- ▶ In 2024 at Presbyterian College, went 6-2 over 14 starts with a 2.67 ERA in 77.2 innings...struck out 121 batters, good for a 14.0 K/9 rate...fanned 172 batters total in his three-year collegiate career.
- ▶ One of only eight players ever drafted out of Presbyterian College...Presbyterian teammate Joel Dragoo was selected in the 7th round in 2024 by the Phillies...the most recent draft selection from Presbyterian was a 25th round pick by the Diamondbacks in 2013 as Arizona selected RHP Bud Jeter.
- ▶ Pitched his first professional game in 2025 with High-A Hillsboro on 4/3 against Eugene.

LAST TIME OUT

- ▶ Took home a no-decision as he was taken out of the game with one out in the bottom of the fifth inning, which would wind up being a game-tying six-run frame for the RockHounds...was replaced by Alec Baker, who let both inherited runners score.
- ▶ Faced the minimum his first time through Midland's order, allowing just one walk that was picked off and caught stealing.
- ▶ Issued a season-high four walks.

OPENING DAY

- ▶ Named the Opening Day starter for Amarillo in 2026.
- ▶ On 4/3 at home against Springfield, tossed four shutout innings out of the gate...fanned two Cardinals in his first inning of work.

A QUALITY FIRST IMPRESSION

- ▶ Made his Double-A debut on the road at San Antonio on 8/22/25.
- ▶ Was perfect through 5.1 IP...perfect game bid was broken up in the 6th when Moisés Gómez reached on an error...no-hit bid was broken on a Braedon Karpathios two-out single in the 6th.
- ▶ Only the fourth game in Soddies history where a starter tossed 7.2+ shutout innings...was also the fewest hits allowed (2) by a Sod Poodles pitcher pitching beyond the 7th inning...the longest start by a Soddie making their debut in club history.
