

PITCHER'S DUEL DEFEAT: The Augusta GreenJackets four-game winning streak came to an end on Thursday night as the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers defeated them in a low-scoring game, 3-1. All three runs for Kannapolis came in as unearned with an error in the third and fourth inning opening door for Kannaplis to plate three runs that proved to be enough for a victory.

RARE DEFEAT: Thursday's 3-1 loss to the Cannon Ballers marked just the fifth time this season Augusta had been defeated when allowing three runs or less as they own a record of 41-5. In addition, the GreenJackets outhit Kannapolis and are now 48-11 when they have more hits than their opponent.

FANTASTIC FLOYD: Francisco Floyd has put together a great week in Kannapolis by adding two more hits and a run scored in Thursday's defeat. He also provided multiple hits on Tuesday night and has 11 multi-hit performances in Augusta since joining the club in July.
