The Brooklyn, NY native spent 11 seasons managing in the New York Yankees organization and 16 seasons at the AAA level overall, going 1093-1185 during his time in the International League.

Gene Cook

(Elected in 2008 as an executive)

The man behind "one of the greatest public relations moves in the history of Minor League Baseball" according to USA Today, Gene Cook served as the general manager of the Mud Hens from 1978-1998. Aside from convincing Toledo native Jamie Farr to wear a Mud Hens hat of M*A*S*H, Cook was considered to be an innovator in minor league baseball promotions. The 1980 I.L. Executive of the Year played a key role in boosting Toledo's average attendance from below 100,000 a year, to over 300,000 per year, as well as gaining public support for the construction of Fifth Third Field. The University of Toledo grad was promoted to Executive Vice President of the Mud Hens in 1998.

Larry Parrish

(Elected in 2013 as a manager)

The recordholder for most seasons, games and wins as manager of the Mud Hens, Larry Parrish spent ten non-consecutive seasons at the helm of the World Famous Toledo Mud Hens. During his stints of four, three, two and a single season, Parrish went 700-708, as well as leading the Mud Hens to back-to-back Governors' Cup champions in 2005 and 2006. He missed out on a chance to go for a three-peat as he spent 2007 as a roving instructor for the Tigers following an ankle surgery for a degenerative condition. He spent all 16 of his managerial seasons within the Tigers organization.

James Earl "Jim" Weber

(Elected in 2014 as a broadcaster)

On Saturday, April 12, 1975 the Toledo Mud Hens welcomed in a new 'Voice of the Hens' as Toledo native Jim Weber took to the airwaves as the new play-by-play voice of the team. Weber did not miss a game that was scheduled to be broadcasted since his debut on the road when the Mud Hens played in Charleston, West Virginia against the Charleston Charlies at Watt Powell Park. He was inducted into the International League as a first ballot inductee in the 2014 class. Weber is the first and only broadcaster to be inducted into the I.L. Hall of Fame. His accomplishments include calling over 6,000 consecutive games and calling the Mud Hens Governors Cup Championship teams in 2005 and 2006. Weber was also awarded the play-by-play duties of two IL All-Star contests in 1990 (Las Vegas) and when the game was held at Fifth Third Field in 2006. Weber called 6,395 consecutive games for the Mud Hens.

Lee Gardner

(Elected in 2017 as a pitcher)

The righty reliever spent just one season at the backend of the "Hen Pen", saving 30 games in 35 chances. Gardner posted a 5-5 record with a 2.92 ERA over 58 appearances in his lone season. He holds the single-season record for most saves for a Mud Hen, as his 2006 campaign is the lone 30-save season since the save became a stat in 1969. Gardner posted a 20-18 record and 107 saves in 320.2 innings over parts of six International League seasons - five with Durham and one with Toledo - while striking out 251 batters and walking 93.

Mike Hessman

(Elected in 2018 as a player)

"King" Mike Hessman claims hold to the minor league home run record, as he belted 433 round-trippers during his 19 minor league seasons. Hessman played 13 seasons at the AAA level, all but one in the International League, and seven with Toledo. Hessman recorded 1,758 hits and 1,207 RBI in his minor league career alongside the record home run total. Hessman clubbed 184 home runs and 494 RBI during his playing days in the Glass City, sporting a .230 batting average. Hessman's International League numbers contain 288 home runs, 791 RBI and 1,135 hits, making him a shoo-in for the International League Hall of Fame. Including his major league and foreign totals, "King" clubbed 462 home runs. Hessman's record-breaking home run on August 3, 2015, would also be his last as a professional. The record-breaking shot also doubles as one of the most iconic calls in the career of longtime Mud Hens broadcaster Jim Weber.

Sam Jethroe

(Elected in 2019 as a player)

One of two players in the history of Toledo baseball to have a 20HR/20SB season, Jethroe led the 1953 Toledo Sox to a 90-win season. "Jet" was an absolute force for the Sox, clubbing 28 home runs with 74 RBI while swiping 27 bases and racking up 70 extra-base hits. While Jethroe's lone season with Toledo was not part of the International League, he split parts of seven International League seasons between Montreal and Toronto, clubbing 91 home runs, tallying 383 RBI and swiping 205 bags all while hitting .293 in 875 games. The seven-time all-star and World Series champion wound up playing 12 major league seasons, racking up the counting stats with 58 home runs, 273 RBI and 136 stolen bases in 604 career major league games.

Billy McMillon

(Elected in 2019 as a player)

The Alamogordo, New Mexico native suited up in Toledo for part of the 2000 Mud Hens season, hitting .345 and smacking 13 home runs before heading up to join the Detroit Tigers. McMillon played parts of six seasons in the International League, making stops in Charlotte, Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, Toledo and Columbus. The Clemson product hit a stifling .302 in 512 I.L. games, clubbing 62 home runs and notching 266 RBI in the process.

Johnny Neun

(Elected in 2020 as a player)

Another member of Toledo's days in the American Association, Neun spent part of the 1929 season as a Mud Hen, lacing up in 53 games for the club that season, hitting .285. The switch-hitting first baseman split that year between Toledo and his native Baltimore Orioles of the International League. The four-year Detroit Tiger spent parts of four seasons in the I.L., and the last three all with the Newark Bears. Neun was a .320 hitter with 19 home runs during his 490 career games in the International League. He spent two years as a player-manager before transitioning into a full-time managerial career. He managed four seasons for the I.L.'s Newark Bears from 1938 through 1941, going 381-240 during his tenure.
