Strikes:

LAST OUTING: Small last pitched on August 24 with the ACL Brewers in a 1.0-inning minor league rehab start against the ACL Indians. He threw seven pitches and allowed two hits in the scoreless frame.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Small is making his second career appearance against Gwinnett. He started at Coolray Field on July 6 and tossed 6.0 shutout innings. He walked two batters, struck out one and picked up the win in Nashville's 8-0 victory.
