NEW YORK YANKEES DOUBLE-A AFFILIATE 2025 SCHEDULE HOME

AN EERIE FEELING: The Somerset Patriots and Erie SeaWolves meet this week for the first time since the 2024 Eastern League Championship Series, when Erie swept Somerset in two games to win its second consecutive Eastern League Championship. Somerset's alltime regular season record against Erie is 17-27 (series record: 1-4-2). The .386 winning percentage is the Patriots' lowest against any Eastern League foe, as is their -53 run differential in 47 games against Erie. The Patriots won their first ever Eastern League Championship over the Erie SeaWolves in 2022, clinching the series with a 15-0 no-hitter in the winner-take-all third game of the series. **BEASTS OF THE EAST:** This week's matchup features the two teams

that pace Eastern League in home runs: Somerset (80) and Erie (68). The two teams have ranked top-3 in the league in home runs every year since the Patriots became the Yankees' Double-A affilate in 2021, year since the Patriots became the Yankees Double-A atfilate in 2021, with the Patriots leading the league in homers every year thus far. Since the start of the affiliation, Somerset has clubbed 805 home runs in 600 games, good for 48 more than the next-closest Double-A team (AMA-757) and 112 more than the next-closest Eastern League team (ERI-693). The Eastern League's top-10 home run hitters are comprised of four Patriots (S. Jones-16-1st, Flores-12-4th, Hardman-11-5th and Jasso-10-T-8th) and three SeaWovles (Holton-13-T-2nd, Anderson-11-T-5th and Valencia-11-T-5th) 5th and Valencia-11-T-5th)

SPENCER IS SPECIAL: On Wednesday night, Yankees No. 2 prospect Spencer Jones crushed his Eastern League and Yankees Milb-leading 16th home run of the season at 429 feet and 108.1 mph off the bat.

Now with 16 HR in 170 AB, Spencer Jones enters today with a 10.62
AB/HR ratio, which is the lowest AB/HR ratio of any batter in Minor
League Baseball. The only player in professional baseball with a lower
AB/HR ratio is Cal Raleigh with 9.12 (32 HR in 292 AB). Aaron Judge is
third with 10.68 AB/HR (28 HR in 299 AB).

YOU CAN'T STOP MR. JONES: Following his home run on
Wednesday, Spencer Jones has scored a run in 13 of his last 14 games
dating back to 6/10 vs. POR. Over this 14-game stretch, Jones is 20-for51 (.392/.483/.804) with 16 R, 9 XBH (3 2B, 6 HR), 12 RBI, 9 BB and 3
SB. Jones leads all Yankees minor league and Eastern League batters
with 16 HR and a .600 SLG. Jones paces all Yankee minor leaguers,
and is second in the Eastern League, with a .989 OPS. Jones' .600 SLG
ranks third in MiLB, while his .989 OPS ranks eighth.

2025 SOMERSET PATRIOTS COACHING STAFF

RAUL DOMINGUEZ: Manager (3rd year)

Raul Dominguez enters his third consecutive season as manager for the Somerset Patriots, 11th overall as a manager and 19th coaching in the Yankees organization. He led the 2023 Patriots to a Double-A best record of 84-53 and a +211 run differential, which ranked first among all MiLB teams. Under his leadership, the Patriots finished with the Eastern League's top record in both halves of the season and clinched their second straight playoff berth. In 2024, Dominguez led the Patriots to their third consecutive playoff berth and their second appearance in the Eastern League Championship Series with an overall record of 75-62. Dominguez's Patriots erased a 6.0-game deficit in the final 30 games of the regular season by going 22-8 to end the campaign and clinching the Eastern League Northeast division's second half title with a second half record of 43-25. Before joining Somerset, Dominguez spent the prior two seasons (2021-2022) as a defensive coach for Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre. He previously served as defensive coach for Trenton (2018-2019) and Tampa (2017). He gained prior managerial experience with the GCL Yankees East (2016), DSL Yankees 1 (2011-15) and DSL Yankees 2 (2009-10). An outfielder during his playing career, Dominguez spread four minor league seasons for with the Yankees between the DSL and the GCL. He began his coaching career in 2008 with the DSL Yankees 2, after spending 2007 as a Yankees' tryout scout in the Dominican Republic.

MIKE FRANSOSO: Hitting Coach (1st year)

Hitting coach Mike Fransoso enters his first season as a Double-A coach in Somerset and with the Yankees organization. He spent the past five years as a member of the Seattle Mariners organization, most recently with the Double-A Arkansas Travelers as the team's hitting coach. On 8/13/24, Fransoso took over as the Travelers' interim manager and led the team to clinch a second-half playoff berth en route to winning the 2024 Texas League Championship. He also previously served as the hitting coach for High-A Everett (2023), Class-A Modesto (2022) and the AZL Mariners (2021). During his playing career, Fransoso played for the Somerset Patriots in 2018 and 2019 when the team was independent. Prior to his stint playing for the Patriots, he spent three seasons in the Pittsburgh Pirates organization after being a 27th round pick of the team in 2013 MLB Draft out of the University of Maine.

PETER LARSON: Pitching Coach (1st year)

Pitching coach Peter Larson enters his first season in Somerset and with the Yankees organization. He spent the past six seasons as a member of the Minnesota Twins organization, including the last two with the Triple-A St. Paul Saints (2023-2024). For Minnesota, Larson also previously served as the pitching coach for Double-A Wichita (2022) and Low-A Fort Myers (2019). In 2020, he was slated to be the pitching coach for Low-A Cedar Rapids, before the Covid cancellation of the minor league season. His first season with the Twins, he served as the minor league rehab pitching coach (2019). Prior to his professional career, Larson worked as a pitching coach at the collegiate level for Fordham University (2018) and the University of Albany (2017). He also served as an assistant coach for Siena College (2016) and King University (2015).

DEREK WOODLEY: Defensive Coach (1st year)

Derek Woodley enters his first season in Somerset and his third with the Yankees organization. He spent the last two seasons as the defensive coach for High-A Hudson Valley (2023-2024). Following the 2024 season, he represented the Yankees at the Arizona Fall League as an extra coach for the Salt River Rafters. Prior to joining the Yankees organization, Woodley spent 30 seasons as a college baseball coach, racking up over 300 wins and most recently as the head coach for Defiance College for 15 seasons from 2008-2022. He also served as the school's athletic director from 2019-2022.

UZIEL VILORIA: Defensive Coach (1st year)

Uziel Viloria enters his first season in Somerset and in the Yankees organization. He began his coaching career in 2024 as a coach in the Phillies organization. During his playing career, Viloria signed with the Phillies as an international free agent in 2019 and went on to play 112 games in four seasons as an infielder in the organization (2019-2023), making it as high as High-A Jersey Shore.

Selvidge was selected to represent Yankees in MLB All-Star Futures Game at Globe Life Field in Arlington, alongside Spencer Jones, but did not attend due to his injury.

Spent all of 2022 with the FCL Yankees: in 11 games (9 GS), going 3-1 with a 2.95 ERA and 53 K (T-5th in FCL) in the regular season. Helped the Yankees to win the 2022 FCL Championship, including a post-season start vs. the FCL Rays on 8/26/22 in which Selvidge began the game with three hitless IP.

Made pro debut in 3 appearances (2 GS) in September for the FCL Yankees, going 3.2 total IP and allowing 1 ER with 4 K and 2 H.

Full name is Joshua Brock Selvidge. Attended Hamilton High School (Chandler, AZ), the same school as 2019 NL MVP Cody Bellinger, Ravens LB Terrell Suggs. During his senior year he went 5-2 with a 2.41 ERA in 11 appearances as a pitcher and hit .304 with 17 R, 6 HR and 21 RBI in 23 games as a batter. His Junior year he was the 2020 Arizona High School Baseball Player of the Year. Ranked by Perfect Game as the top pitcher in AZ and the No. 2 overall prospect in AZ. Committed to play college baseball at LSU prior to being drafted by the Yankees. Born in Carrolton, TX, spent his youth in Castle Rock, CO, went to HS in Chandler, AZ.

Selected by the Yankees in the 3rd round of the 2021 MLB Draft (No, 92), his \$1.5 Million signing bonus was T-60th highest in Draft, he was 92nd pick. Higher signing bonus than NYY 2nd round pick Brendan Beck.
