TONIGHT'S GAME

Round Rock and Sugar Land get set for game five of the series on Friday night. Express RHP Kyle Cody is slated to start against Space Cowboys RHP Jairo Solis. First pitch at Dell Diamond is scheduled for 7:05 p.m.

Tonight's game can be heard live on the flagship home of the Round Rock Express, AM 1300 The Zone. Online audio is also available at am1300thezone.iheart.com and via the iHeart Radio app. Fans can also watch the game with a valid MiLB.tv login or on the Bally Live app. Express Director of Broadcasting Mike Capps will be on the call providing play-by-play coverage while former Round Rock High School Head Baseball Coach John Langerhans provides color commentary.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT

Round Rock won on Thursday 8-4 after putting up a three-spot in the first inning, which was capped off by a homer from C Sam Huff. E-Train RHP Cole Winn loaded the bases in the fourth inning before Sugar Land DH Luke Berryhill grounded into a double play but sent a run home to cut the lead to 3-1. In the fifth, 1B Yoshi Tsutsugo launched a solo homer to keep Round Rock in front and make it a 4-1 game. In the sixth, the Express tacked on two more to extend the lead to 6-1. Back-to-back hits had two Space Cowboys in scoring position and back-to-back groundouts plated two runs for Sugar Land in the top of the seventh inning. In the home half, Huff grounded into a force out and scored a run to give the E-Train a 7-3 lead. Sugar Land CF Pedro Leon tallied a solo home run in the eighth inning to cut the lead to three, but in the home-half, Round Rock took the run back and secured the 8-4 win.

KYLE GETS THE CALL

Express RHP Kyle Cody is slated to be on the mound for Round Rock tonight in what will be his eighth start. He owns a 7.32 ERA (29 ER/35.2 IP) and has 34 strikeouts on the year. Cody's last start came on the road in Albuquerque where he gave up six runs on eight hits through 3.1 innings.

BULLPEN BY THE NUMBERS

In Thursday's win, the E-Train bullpen gave up just three hits that came over 5.1 innings of relief. The trio of relievers, LHP Josh Dye, RHP Chase Lee and LHP Grant Wolfram, each retired the first batters they faced on Thursday and combined to give up three runs, three walks and three strikeouts.

HERNANDEZ KEEPS BRINGING IT

After going 14-for-60 during the first three weeks of May, Express CF Elier Hernandez has hit 14-for-32 in his last eight games. He is riding a seven-game hitting streak after two singles in Thursday's win. The righty is batting .538 (7-for-13) in the series against Sugar Land. He has also doubled, tallied four RBI, one run, one walk and three strikeouts.

HUFF'S HOME RUNS

Express C Sam Huff launched a two-run home run in the first inning that traveled 404 feet last night in the win over Sugar Land. It is his eighth dinger of the season, though just his first at Dell Diamond. He is now one shy of tying INF Davis Wendzel for the team lead at nine home runs.

STAYING POSITIVE

Round Rock tallied eight runs in the win over Sugar Land on Thursday, which brings them back to a positive run differential on the season at +4. The Express have 23 runs in four games against the Space Cowboys during the series, which is the most through the first four games of a series at Dell Diamond this year. It is the third-most runs through the first four games of any series this season.

FOSCUE BOUNCING BACK

E-Train 3B Justin Foscue went 2-for-3 with a triple, an RBI, two runs scored and a walk yesterday. Since going 0-for-17 to start the season, Foscue has never had more than two consecutive games without a hit. Five times this year, he has had back-to-back games without a hit. In the games after going hitless on two consecutive nights, Foscue is 9-for-19 with two triples, three home runs, 10 RBI, eight runs scored and three walks. If you take away his 0-for-17 start to the season, Foscue is batting .307 (51-for-166) over 44 games.

EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2023 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's Pacific Coast League debut. Davis spent the previous two years as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 673-588 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.



In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.
