MADE 'EM MIZERABLE IN MAY: Jacob Misiorowski will make his first start since being named the Brewers' Minor League Pitcher of the Month in May. The no. 4-rated prospect in the system (no. 69 overall in MLB Pipeline's Top 100) entered the series last week against the Indians 3-0 with a 1.55 ERA on the year but left the week with his first two losses. He'll look to get back on track on Friday night against Gwinnett who is he 2-0 against with a 0.93 ERA in two games this year.

FISHING IN HENDERSONVILLE: Brewers' no. 12-rated prospect Logan Henderson will make his seventh Triple-A start of the year and his eighth overall appearance with the Sounds as he will start in Game 2 of the Doubleheader Saturday. He worked a planned short start his last time out, working three scoreless innings on two hits and had four strikeouts last Sunday in Indianapolis. He's got an eight-game winning streak going entering Friday and the Sounds and Brewers are 9-1 in games that he has started.

29 AND COUNTING: Anthony Seigler extended his on-base streak to 29 consecutive games with a single in the top of the first inning on Thursday night. Since starting his streak back on April 25th, he is hitting .402 (39-for-97) which ranks second in all of minor league baseball and leads the minors with his .525 OBP and 1.216 OPS. He ranks fifth over the span with his .691 SLG.

FIRST OF MANY: Jeferson Quero collected his first Triple-A RBI with a single in the bottom of the third inning in Thursday's loss. He ended the night 1-for-3 with the RBI, a walk, and one run scored. The Brewers' no. 2-rated prospect has a hit in each of his first two games with Nashville and rides a seven-game hitting streak overall after ending his rehab stint with a hit in his final five games in the Arizona Complex League.

SHOWING OUR TOBIAS: Tobias Myers worked a season-high 6.0 IP and earned his first quality start since September 7, 2024, against the Colorado Rockies. Myers allowed five hits and three runs while also setting his season-high with nine strikeouts. It is the most strikeouts he has had since having 11 during his last quality start. Thursday night was his 14th career game with 9+ strikeouts in 180 career regular season Major League and minor league games. It's the eighth quality start by a Nashville starter on the year and first since Jacob Misiorowski tossed one back on May 15th on the road in Memphis.

EVERYDAY EDDIE: Eddie Rosario extended his on-base streak to 15 games with a walk in the first inning. He has reached base in all 15 games he has played in with Nashville and 28 of the 29 total Triple-A games he has played in this year including his start with Oklahoma City. Rosario did see his nine-game hitting streak come to an end after going 0-for-2. It was just the fourth Triple-A game this year in which he was unable to get a hit.

WELL, THIS IS NEW: The loss on Thursday night was just the second of the year in which the Sounds outhit their opponent. Nashville outhit Gwinnett 7-6 and entered the game 21-1 on the year when doing so. The Sounds are also 27-11 on the year now in games in which they have scored the first run. Including the three runs on Thursday night, the Sounds own a +55 run differential on the season in the first three innings of the game in 2025.

ALL GOOD THINGS: Jimmy Herron's 19 game on-base streak came to an end on Thursday night. It was tied for the second-longest of his career. He had a 23-game on-base streak with Triple-A Albuquerque last year from March 31-May 9 to set his career-high. He also had a 19-game streak with the Isotopes during the 2023 season.

JOIN THE CLUB: With his steal in the bottom of the sixth inning, Jorge Alfaro joined the Sounds 10+ stolen base club this year, making him the sixth different player with double-digit steals on the season. The Sounds have the second-most steals in the International League with 118 on the year and trail only Jacksonville (134) for the most in Triple-A. The Sounds and Jumbo Shrimp are the only two teams with six players with 10+ steals on the year while seven different Triple-A teams don't have a single player that has 10+ steals on the year so far. Lehigh Valley (4), Rochester (3) and Oklahoma City (3) are the only other teams that currently have more than two players with at least 10 steals.

- Selected by the Brewers out of Crowder Junior College (Crowder, MO) where he posted a 10-0 record and 2.72 ERA in 76.0 IP during his redshirt freshman season.
- Currently ranked as the no. 4 prospect in the Brewers' Top 30 (MLB Pipeline) and no. 69 overall in the MLB Pipeline Top 100.
- Has won International League Pitcher of the Week twice already in 2025...Seven career POTW awards.
- After having his senior season in high school wiped out during COVID, torn his meniscus during his first college start at Crowder.
- Finished third in NJCAA Division I with 136 strikeouts during the 2022 season and was named Second-Team All-American...Had a scholarship offer to LSU but decided to sign with the Brewers after being selected 63rd overall and above slot value at \$2.35 million..Became the highest-drafted player out of Crowder, surpassing current Brewers pitcher Aaron Ashby (4th Round, 2018).
- Worked his way through three levels of the Brewers system in his first full season in 2023...Combined to go 4-2 with a 3.41 ERA in 20 starts and had 110 K in 71.1 IP.
- Was selected to the Sirius XM All-Star Futures Game in 2023 and struck out the side during his lone inning.
- Named Pitcher of the Week in the Carolina League and Southern League during the 2023 season as well as being named Brewers MiLB Pitcher of the Month in May. Led the Brewers farm system in strikeouts (105) and BAA (.182) and was third in ERA (3.50) and WHIP (1.20) after his final start with Double-A Biloxi before his promotion to Triple-A on July 28, 2024.
- After starting his first 41 professional games, was made two planned short starts with the Sounds before moving to the bullpen in an attempt to limit innings on his arm.
- Ended the 2024 season with the fourth-most strikeouts in the farm system (127) and eighth-most IP (97.1) and posted a .167 BAA in 33 G (21 GS).

- Currently ranked as the no. 12-ranked prospect in the Brewers top 30...no. 2-ranked RHP behind Jacob Misiorowski.
- Made his Major League debut in 2025 and tossed a quality start in his first career start (6.0 IP, 3 H, ER, HR, 9 K, BB) against the Athletics...Through first four MLB starts is 3-0 with a 1.71 ERA (14 H, 4 ER, 29 K, 6 BB)...One of two MLB pitchers since 1901 to have struck out at least 29 and allowed four or fewer runs through first four MLB starts...Joined fellow Brewer Freddy Peralta (per Brewers' beat writer Curt Hogg).
- Got a late start to his 2024 season after injuring his oblique during the 2024 Spring Breakout Game...Made his season debut on May 9th in the Arizona Complex League.
- Earned Southern League Pitcher of the Month as well as Brewers Minor League Pitcher of the Month in June 2024 after going 4-0 with a 1.66 ERA in four starts...Held opposing hitter to a .192 AVG and matched his single-game career-high with 10 strikeouts in two of his outings (6/15 vs. TEN and 6/28 vs. PNS).
- From the time of his first start with High-A Wisconsin on May 24th until he was promoted to Nashville (8/8) he led the Brewers farm system with his 78 strikeouts.
- Made his Triple-A debut on August 9th and allowed one run on three hits over 4.0 IP but took the loss...Tossed a quality start in his second game vs. DUR (6.0 IP, 0 R, 8 K, 3 H).
- Finished the 2024 season 8th in the Milwaukee farm system in strikeouts (104) and was T-8th in wins (7)...Added to the Brewers 40-man roster on November 19th. 35.2% strikeout rate was fourth best among 661 minor leaguers with at least 70.0 IP in 2023.
- Missed the majority of 2022 after undergoing non-Tommy John elbow surgery in the spring.
- Pitched one season at McLennan CC in Texas and was named NJCAA Division I Pitcher of the Year after going 10-2 with a 1.66 ERA in 17 games (14 GS)...Led NJCAA DI in strikeouts (169) and IP (97.2)...Struck out 17 over 8.0 IP with one run allowed to guide the Highlanders to their first championship since 1983.
