On this date in 2017, the Sounds scored 8 runs in the 4th inning on their way to a 11-9 win over Round Rock. Nashville trailed 5-0 before their big inning. Joey Wendle (3-for-4, 2B) and Beau Taylor (3-for-5, 2 RBI) led the Sounds offensively.

Tonight's Game: The Nashville Sounds begin a six-game series against the Indianapolis Indians tonight at First Horizon Park. The Sounds walked off with a win in 11 innings over Gwinnett on Sunday. Righthander Alec Bettinger gets the nod for Nashville, facing Indianapolis' Osvaldo Bido.

Alec Bettinger: 26-year-old Alec Bettinger makes his fifth start for the Sounds tonight. He is 0-3 with a 6.48 ERA (25.0 IP/18 ER) in eight appearances this season. In his last outing, Bettinger allowed three runs (all earned) on three hits and two walks to take the loss vs. Gwinnett on June 23. He struck out three batters on 48 pitches (31 strikes). Bettinger checks in as the No. 22 prospect in the Brewers system according to MLB Pipeline. He went 0-1 with a 13.50 ERA in four outings (1 start) with Milwaukee last season. Bettinger spent most of 2021 with Nashville, recording a 3-7 record with a 4.75 ERA in 21 outings. The Woodbridge, Va. native was drafted by the Brewers in the 10th Round of the 2017 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Virginia.

Osvaldo Bido : 26 -year-old Osvaldo Bido will toe the rubber for the Indians. He is 1-4 with a 4.86 ERA $(50.0\ \text{IP/27}\ \text{ER})$ in 16 appearances (12 starts) with Indianapolis in 2022. Bido pitched 4.0 scoreless innings in his last start on June 22 vs. Memphis, yielding just one hit and three walks on 69 pitches (43 strikes). He struck out four Redbirds in his 12th start. Bido spent most of last season with Double-A Altoona, going 4-8 with a 5.09 ERA in 21 appearances (19 starts). He also had an 8.22 ERA in two starts for Indianapolis. A native of Los Hidalgos, Dominican Republic, Bido was signed as an undrafted free agent by the Pirates on March 14, 2017.

It's A Small World: Ethan Small was named the International League Pitcher of the Week (June 20-26) after turning in one of the best outings of his career last Saturday with a 10-strikeout performance. It was Small's third career double-digit strikeout game (also - 12, 6/12/21 w/ Biloxi vs. Mississippi and 10, 6/1/21 w/ Biloxi at Montgomery). It was also the second time in Small's career he went 7.0 innings (also - 6/18/21 w/ Biloxi

Summer Fun in Hit City: Sunday's walk-off win was Nashville's third of the season and first since May 5 vs. Norfolk. The Sounds also improved to 24-12 at First Horizon Park, the second-best home record in the International League behind only Columbus (25-11).

The Kid Walks it Off: Brice Turang (3-for-5, 3 R, RBI, SB) delivered a 2-out RBI single in the 11th inning to score Corey Ray and give Nashville a series win over Gwinnett on Sunday. Turang's 75 hits on the year are the fifth most in the International League. He also leads the Sounds in multi-hit games (21).

Marky Mark is Back: Infielder Mark Mathias came through in the clutch in his first game since being optioned by Milwaukee on Sunday. His 3-run homer in the seventh inning put the Sounds ahead 8-5 after trailing early in the contest. Mathias has reached base in 18-straight Triple-A games.

The Sad Man: Reliever Connor Sadzeck continued his brilliant season out of the 'pen with another scoreless outing Sunday night (1.0 IP, 2 K), his third outing of the series. In 21 games with the Sounds, the right-hander is 1-1 with a 1.16 ERA (23.1 IP/3 ER) with 30 strikeouts. Opposing batters are hitting just
