+49	The Captains' +49 run differential is the highest in the Midwest League and the 6 th highest in all of Minor League Baseball.
	In Fridav's 8-0 Game 1 win. Nate Furman became the first

Capitain to hit 2 homers in a game since current Capitains OF Jorge Burgos hit a pair on 5/30/2023 vs. Quad Cities, which included Lake County's most recent walk-off home run and only one of the 2023 season.

CAPTAINS LOG

LAST TIME OUT: The Captains secured their 3rd straight series win with a 9-3 victory on Saturday at Classic Auto Group Park in Eastlake.

After Dayton struck first with 2 extra-base hits to begin the game, which eventually resulted in 2 runs, RHP **Austin Peterson** retired the next 19 Dragons batters he faced. He earned his 5th win of the season, tossing 7 innings, allowing 3 earned runs on 4 hits, while fanning 4 and walking none.

CF Justin Boyd, the former #73 overall pick by Cincinnati in 2022, hit a go-ahead 3-run home run in the bottom of the 2nd. C Zac Fascia was the 2nd and final Captain to homer when he hit a 2-run shot in the bottom of the 7th. For each, this was their first home run of the season.

SS Alex Mooney, MLB Pipeline's No. 20 Cleveland prospect, notched a pair of 2-out RBI singles, while 1B Maick Collado clubbed a 2-out, 2-run single to put a bow on Lake County's scoring.

ZAC ATTACK: On Saturday, C Zac Fascia hit his 2nd home run in his 58th game as a Captain. The former Purdue Boilermaker has reached base in 7 of his last 8 games played, and has knocked in 6 runs in his last 3 games.

PETERSON'S PITCHING GEMS: Saturday marked the 4th quality start of the season by RHP Austin Peterson, as he became the 8th pitcher in MiLB this year to earn 4 quality starts. <u>Peterson is just</u> the 3rd Captain since 2005 with 4 quality starts in his first <u>7</u> starts, joining RHP Kevin Dixon (2006) and RHP Trevor Foss (2016).

2-OUT HITTING: In 5 games versus Dayton this week, 19 of Lake County's 32 runs have been scored with 2 outs, including a combined 4 2-out RBI from Mooney and Collado on Saturday. <u>The</u> Captains' .280 batting average with 2 outs this season is the best of any team between High-A and MLB.

21st SEASON OF CAPTAINS BASEBALL: 2024 marks the 21st season of Captains Baseball. After the Columbus RedStixx were purchased in 2003, they were moved to Eastlake and became the Lake County Captains. In 2,766 regular-season games, Lake County has an all-time record of 1,393-1,373 (.504).

WINNING WAVES: The Captains have had a winning record in 13 of their first 20 seasons, including in each of their last four campaigns. Lake County has made 7 playoff appearances in franchise history (5 Midwest League, 2 South Atlantic League), with its 2010 Midwest League Championship being its sole title in franchise history.

TRENDS & NOTABLES

THE WILD, THE INNOCENT, THE VINE STREET SHUFFLE: The Captains are 9-3 through 12 games of their 13-game homestand. Since April 30, the Lake County offense ranks 2nd in High-A in runs scored (67), and 3rd in both batting average (.270) and OPS (.785). On the mound, Captains pitching ranks 2nd in WHIP (0.99) and 4th in ERA (2.61).

FURMANATOR 2: JUDGEMENT DAY: In Game 1 of Friday's doubleheader, INF Nate Furman homered twice for his first Minor League multi-home run game. This was Furman's first career multi-HR game after 130 Minor League games, 94 college games, and 84 collegiate summer games. <u>After not hitting a home run in his first 115 MiLB games</u>, Furman has slugged 3 in his last 16 games.

THAT'S OUR GUY: Since April 30 vs. Fort Wayne, OF Guy Lipscomb is batting .444 (16-for-36) in 10 games, which is the 2nd best mark in the Midwest League. Lipscomb's 8-game hitting streak, the 3rd-longest by a Captain this year, ended in Game 2 of Friday's doubleheader.

TOP QUALITY: Through 32 games, Lake County starting pitchers have recorded 11 quality starts (6+ IP, 3-or-fewer earned runs), which are the most in High-A. RHPs Austin Peterson (4), Trenton Denholm (3), and Carter Spivey (3) have each recorded at least 3, while LHP Parker Messick, MLB Pipeline's No. 21 Cleveland prospect, has also recorded 1 this season (4/25 @ West Michigan, W).

BASH BROS 2.0: Captains INF Alex Mooney, MLB Pipeline's No. 20 Cleveland prospect, and INF/OF C.J. Kayfus have been the MWL's premier slugging tandem. The duo has accounted for 32.1% of Lake County's run production, while hitting 12 of the team's 28 home runs.

STRONG STARTING PITCHING: Lake County's starting pitching staff has been one of the premier units in the Midwest League so far this season. The group ranks top-5 in the Midwest League in fewest walks (36, 1st), wins (13, 1st), strikeouts (159, 1st), WHIP (1.10, 2nd) innings pitched (156.0, 2nd), and ERA (3.35, 4th).

IF I COULD BE LIKE MAICK: In Saturday's double-header, INF Maick Collado extended his on-base streak to 19, the longest by a Captain this year. His 19-game stretch is the 2nd-longest active streak in the Midwest League, trailing only South Bend's Yohendrick Pinango (25). Collado's streak is the longest by a Captain since Dayan Frías reached base in 19 straight games from 7/7/2023 to 8/1/2023.

LAST TIME OUT: Back on May 7 vs. Dayton, **Parker Messick** (2-2) earned his 4th career victory in 2 years as a Captain. **Messick** went 5 innings, allowing 3 runs (1 earned) on 4 hits, while striking out 4 and walking a season-high 4 in the 9-5 win. His lone earned run allowed was on a leadoff home run to begin the series, while 2 unearned runs scored on a throwing error by Captains 3B **Alex Mooney**.

MIDWEST LEAGUE RANKS: Messick ranks tied for 3rd with Cedar Rapids RHP Andrew Morris in the Midwest League in strikeouts (37), 5th in innings pitched (31.1), and 6th in ERA (2.59). Since his High-A debut on 6/29/2023 vs. Fort Wayne, **Messick's** 113 strikeouts are the most at the High-A level.

BEST SINCE BIBEE: Messick's 1.77 ERA through 3 starts this season was the lowest by a Captain through 3 starts in a season since RHP and 2023 American League Rookie of the Year runner-up Tanner Bibee posted a 0.00 ERA through 3 starts in 2022.

TOP 30 PROSPECT: Messick is currently Cleveland's No. 21 prospect according to MLB Pipeline. Per Baseball America, "He throws from a low release point, which helps him get swings and misses on his fastball. His tumbling changeup is his best pitch and gives him a strong weapon against righthanded hitters."

2023 IN REVIEW: Messick started his first career 13 games with Single-A Lynchburg from April 7 to June 10 before starting 11 of 13 games with High-A Lake County from June 29 to September 9. **Messick** finished second in the Cleveland player development system with 136 strikeouts and a 3.77 ERA. In his final seven starts for the Captains, he posted a 2.52 ERA, 48 strikeouts, 12 walks and a .211 opposing average in 35.2 innings of work. Overall, **Messick** also recorded 6 quality starts (4 with Single-A Lynchburg, 2 with Lake County). He was named Carolina League Pitcher of the Week after earned his second career Minor League win, pitching a career-high 7 innings and allowing career-lows of 1 hit (since tied), zero runs (tied), and zero walks (tied), while throwing a then-career-high 7 strikeouts on May 10 against the Myrtle Beach Pelicans (CHC).

FLORIDA STATE PHENOM: Messick had a stellar college career at Florida State. In 2020, as a true freshman, he was named a Collegiate Baseball Newspaper Freshman All-American. Then, in 2021, as a redshirt freshman, **Messick** became just the second-ever player to be named ACC Pitcher & Freshman of the Year in the same season. He was also named a semifinalist for the John Olerud Two-Way Player of the Year Award, as he finished with a .225 batting average, 9 hits, one home run, and 5 RBI on the season as a hitter. **Messick's** 2021 performance led to him being named a 3rd Team All-American by four different publications, as well as pitching for the 2021 USA Baseball Collegiate National Team. Finally, in 2022, he led Florida State with 144 strikeouts, as he was the only ACC pitcher named a finalist for both the 2022 Golden Spikes Award and Dick Howser Trophy. **Messick** was also named a 2022 1st Team NCBWA All-American. When his collegiate career ended, **Messick** was FSU's all-time leader with a 6.7 strikeout-to-walk ratio.
