### CORDERO GRAND SLAM SINKS JACKSONVILLE

Lewin Díaz homered but a Franchy Cordero grand slam on Friday helped Worcester power by Jacksonville 8-4. Díaz opened up the scoring in the bottom of the first by homering on a 3-0 pitch from Worcester starter Josh Winckowski. However, after the Jumbo Shrimp added a run on an RBI ground out in the second, the Red Sox mounted a two-out rally with a single sandwiched between a pair of walks to load the bases. Cordero's grand slam put Worcester up for good, and later on, both Johan Mieses and Jeter Downs homered to help seal the 8-4 Red Sox win.

### LEWIN AND CLARK BURDICK

Both Jacksonville first baseman Lewin Díaz and outfielder **Peyton Burdick** have gotten off to a strong starts to the season. Díaz is 5-for-16 to begin the campaign, slashing .313/.313/.563/.876 with a double, home run, four RBIs and three runs scored. Meanwhile. Burdick. the Marlins' Minor League Player of the Year in 2021. is 4-for-his-first-13. compiling a batting line of .308/.438/.538/.976 with one homer, two RBIs and five runs. Thus, of the 23 runs the Jumbo Shrimp have scored this season - a figure that ranks fourth in the International League - the pair have accounted for 12 of those tallies, a ratio of 52.2 percent.

#### POWFR UP?

Though Jacksonville is 1-3 to start the season, the Jumbo Shrimp have popped six home runs thus far, tied for third in the International League. Power has not been a forte of recent First Coast clubs: no Jacksonville team has finished outside the bottom 10 in either Triple-A (2021) or Double-A (2014-19) in home runs since 2013, when the Jacksonville Suns bashed 104 bombs to place 14th in Double-A. The last time a Jacksonville club ranked in the top 10 of its league in long balls was 2009, when the Suns cracked 110 homers.

#### IT TAKES A VILLAGE

The Jumbo Shrimp finished 2021 with a 75-55 (.577) record, something the club accomplished despite a whopping 287 roster moves. Jacksonville used a remarkable 77 different players in 2021, shattering the previous club record of 65 set in 2018. Of those 77 players, 38 were pitchers, which tied a club record. The Jumbo Shrimp had 21 different pitchers start a game in 2021, again marking a franchise record.

RATMEN

Through four games on the season, the Jumbo Shrimp have compiled 23 runs, a total of 5.8 per game, which ranks fourth in the International League. Jacksonville has done this mainly by scoring in bunches thus far this season. The Jumbo Shrimp have plated multiple runs in an inning in eight of the 13 frames the club has scored in this season. Additionally, the club's longest drought without scoring was a six-inning scoreless from the third through eighth innings on Friday against Worcester.

#### DON'T CRY ... SMILE BECAUSE IT HAPPENED

Jacksonville finished the 2021 season, which marked the club's return to Triple-A for the first time since 1962-68 with a 75-55 (.577) record - the club's best mark since an 81-59 (.579) tally in 2014. The 2021 campaign represented Jacksonville's first winning record since that 2014 season, and the Jumbo Shrimp won with plenty of dramatics: Twenty-one of Jacksonville's 75 victories came in the club's last at-bat. Those close victories have helped the Jumbo Shrimp go a whopping 49-28 (.636) in games decided by three runs or fewer, the second-best record in the league in contests determined by those slim margins.

### ROAD WAS WHERE THE HEART IS

The Jumbo Shrimp boasted a 39-26 (.600) mark away from 121 Financial Ballpark in 2021, ranking the club tied for fourth for the most road victories in Triple-A. Jacksonville's .600 winning percentage away from the First Coast equaled both the 2006 and 2014 Jacksonville Suns, who each posted 42-28 (.600) away records, for the best road winning percentage for any Jacksonville team since at least 2005. In 2021, the Jumbo Shrimp ranked 28th in Triple-A in runs scored at home, mustering just 256 (3.9 per game) of their 577 tallies (44.4 percent) at 121 Financial Ballpark. The club's .672 home OPS ranked dead last in the level. Meanwhile, on the road, Jacksonville placed 14th in runs scored in away games (321, 4.9 per game) and 13th in OPS (.758).

### SHRIMP SKEWER

Jacksonville issued nine walks to Worcester on Friday, the most the Jumbo Shrimp have handed out in a game since July 24, 2018, when they walked 13 Montgomery Biscuits

#### ABOUT MATTHEW

-It took Kent until his third season at Texas A&M University to move into the Aggies' starting rotation. He totaled six starts out of 45 total appearances between his freshman and sophomore years in 2013-14. In 2015, the left-hander started 14 games out of his 19 appearances, going 9-1 with a 2.76 ERA (98.0 IP, 103 H, 12 BB, 84 K). That performance helped convince the Boston Red Sox to select Kent in the 13th round of the 2015 draft.

-After six seasons in the Red Sox organization, Kent elected free agency on November 7, 2021. Less than a month later, on December 3, 2021, he inked a minor league deal with the Miami Marlins.

### **2022 SEASON**

### **2021 SEASON**

-Kent started just three games out of 27 appearances in 2021. In his previous four campaigns, he started all but eight of his 112 outings.

-The southpaw held left-handed hitters to a .161 average and .450 OPS in 56 at-bats. However, over 178 at-bats, righties batted .315 with an .823 OPS against him.

-Kent struggled pitching with runners on base. With Double-A Portland and the bases empty, opponents recorded a ..256 average and 674 OPS in 133 at-bats. In comparison, with runners on, opposing hitters hit .307 with a .809 OPS in 101 at-bats.

### **2019 SEASON**

-Kent still had platoon splits in 2019, but far less pronounced than he would experience in 2021. In Double-A, opposing right-handed hitters posted a .755 OPS against him in 294 atbats compared to a .629 OPS for left-handed batters in 187 at-bats.

#### **2018 SEASON**

-Over 170 at-bats while Kent pitched for Double-A Portland, left-handed hitters collected a .650 OPS. In comparison, right-handed batters registered a .723 mark in 387 at-bats.

### **ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES**

-An outstanding hitter in addition to his pitching prowess at Midway High School in Waco, Texas, Kent went 10-1 with a 0.63 ERA and 122 strikeouts in 66.2 innings pitched as a senior while also batting .421 with 24 extra-base hits. In the district playoffs, he tossed three consecutive no-hitters.
