LET'S PLAY TWO: The FredNats suffered the first loss of 2024 last night, and will look to bounce back in today's doubleheader at Bank of the James Stadium against the Hillcats, making up for Thursday's rainout. Jarlin Susana makes his second start of the year on the mound in game one, and will look to follow up a very strong performance on Opening Night in Fredericksburg last week. Then, RHP Marc Davis makes his second start of the year in game two of the twinbill following up his opening weekend performance where he allowed 3 runs in the first inning of work but then nothing after that.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Hillcats scored 10 runs in the first three innings - five in the first and five in the third - to fall behind 10-2. The FredNats got within four late, but couldn't complete the comeback in a 12-7 loss. Elijah Green and Nate Ochoa hit their first home runs of the year, but a rough start from Gabriel Agostini could not be overcome last night as the Freddie's entered the loss column for the first time. Jose Atencio and Kevin Rodriguez both had solid relief appearances, with Atencio going 3 2/3, and Rodriguez going two innings.

HE LIKES BANK OF THE JAMES: Elijah Green hit his first home run of the season last night, a 400+ foot tank over the center field batter's eye at Bank of the James Stadium. That was his fifth career homer with the FredNats, four of which have come against the Hillcats. Three of those homers have been at Bank of the James Stadium in Lynchburg.

THE START BY THE NUMBERS: Fredericksburg's start on offense has been historic. The 61 runs scored through five games is the most at the Double-A level and below, nine more than the next closest team and more than nine Major League teams who have played 7-8 more games. In the last five games alone, the FredNats have 22 extra-base hits, 57 runs, a team OPS of .843, and a team batting average of .264. The team have two of the top four run producers in the Carolina League with Brandon Pimentel leading the way with 12, and Brenner Cox in fourth place with nine. Pimentel and Gavin Dugas are the top two in the league in doubles, and Dugas and Phillip Glasser are leading the way in batting average.

PROSPECTS IN THE 'BURG: Three of the Nationals' Top-30 prospects will begin the season with Fredericksburg. All three spent time with the FredNats in 2023, and all three of those prospects are ranked in the Top-10 in the system. Elijah Green is ranked as the 6th-best prospect in the system according to MLB Pipeline, Cristhian Vaquero is the 9th-best, and Jarlin Susana is the 10th ranked prospect. All three are also in the Top-10 in the Baseball America prospect rankings.

THE SKIP IS BACK: The FredNats' leader from the last two seasons returns to the Managerial role for 2024. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg. Lowery, 34, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Triple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978. Lowery is 146-121 in his two-plus years as Manager in Fredericksburg, including the 2022 Carolina League playoffs.

THE STAFF: The majority of the 2023 coaching staff returns for 2024, with the lone exception being Hitting Coach Mike Habas. Pitching Coach Justin Lord, Development Coach Carmelo Jaime, Performance Analyst Josh Freligh, Strength & Conditioning Nathan Sier and Athletic Trainer Jake Meyer are all back from last year's staff. Lord, 44, will begin his fourth season coaching in the Washington organization. The Alabama native and Florida State alum pitched six seasons professionally before transitioning to coaching, spending time in the Baltimore organization prior to joining the Nationals.

Habas, 33, begins his first season in the Washington organization after spending the last four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization. He was the hitting coach for the ACL Brewers the last two seasons, and was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats and Head Coach at Prairie State Junior College prior to his time with Milwaukee. Jaime, 38, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and has served as the first base coach and infield coach with the FredNats the past two seasons, roles he will continue in 2024. Meyer is in his seventh year with the Nationals overall and second with the FredNats, he spent his first five years at the facility in West Palm Beach, FL. Sier is in his second year with FXBG after previous stops with ZSP Sports and Macomb Community College (MI). Freligh begins his second year with the Nationals after previous stops with the Boston Red Sox and Los Angeles Dodgers.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won five Mills Cup Championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014.

TONIGHT'S START: Jarlin Susana is set to make his second start of 2024, after getting the nod on Opening Night. The big righty features a heater that routinely exceeds triple digits, to go along with a fading changeup and a sharp slider that will touch the low 90's.

EARLY-SEASON HIGHS: After an up-and-down April, Susana really hit his stride going into May. From his start on 5/3 vs Down East, Jarlin was flat out dominant. Over his next eight starts, Susana worked to a 2.35 ERA across 30.2 IP, with opponents hitting a measly .167 against him.

LATE-SEASON LULL: Unfortunately, Susana faltered as the season went on. After the aforementioned eight-start stretch, Jarlin made just four more starts the rest of the season. He struggled with his command, walking 15 batters in 22.2 IP, with an ERA north of 9.00. Susana made his final start of the year on 8/5 against Salem before being placed on the Development List to end his season.

LAST TIME OUT: In front of a packed VACU Stadium, Jarlin Susana was very effective in his 2024 debut. The big right-hander fired three frames, scattering a pair of base hits while allowing one unearned run. Crucially, he did not walk a batter.

TONIGHT'S START: Marc Davis is set to make his second start of 2024, in his return to the mound from Tommy John Surgery in 2022.

Davis had a promising start to his professional career, as the right-hander posted a 3.97 ERA out of the bullpen in '22, while earning a Carolina League Pitcher of the Week nod as well.

JUCO BANDIT: Davis played three seasons at Florida Southwestern State, a junior college located in Fort Myers, FL. With the Buccaneers, Marc worked primarily as a reliever; 34 of his 44 total appearances came out of the bullpen. He recorded a stellar 3.14 ERA to go along with a 1.41 WHIP for his collegiate career, while striking out a whopping 14.55 batters per nine innings.

TWO-WAY TALENT: Davis was recruited as a two-way player out of South Gwinnett High School. He impressed scouts at the plate on the travel circuit, with exit velocities north of 90 MPH as a teenager, and displayed excellent range as a shortstop. Of course, he also possessed a rocket arm, and ultimately chose to focus on the mound.

LAST TIME OUT: Davis returned to the mound for the first time since 2022. In a turn of fate, his last start before surgery and his first one afterwards were both home starts for the FredNats. Last Saturday, Davis gave up four runs in the first inning, but rebounded well to face the minnum over his next two frames.



NEXT GAME'S STARTER: RHP Travis Sthele (0-0, 5.40)

Sthele made four starts with FXBG last season after being drafted in the 12th round out of Texas.
