

The Bowie Baysox dropped the third game in their last four to the Erie SeaWolves last night, by a 7-4 final. Erie struck first in the top of the third inning with a solo home run by Diego Rincones, before Luis Santana scored later in the frame, thanks in part to an error from Bowie. The Baysox would get one back in the bottom of the fourth on a solo shot from Heston Kjerstad, his eighth home run of the season. However, the SeaWolves would answer with two runs of their own in the top of the fifth, chasing Baysox starter Cade Povich in the process, as Colt Keith and Julio Rodriguez registered RBI singles to make it 4-1 Erie. Bowie would once again close the gap to within a run in the sixth inning off a two-run single by Billy Cook, but a troublesome seventh inning that saw three walks and three hits combined given up by relievers Dillon Tate and Conner Loeprich plated three additional runs for Erie, granting a 7-3 advantage. The Baysox got a run back late in the eighth on an RBI groundout by Donta' Williams but were held in check the rest of the way by the SeaWolves bullpen in the defeat.

#### TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Seawolves enter tonight with a record of 11-14 and sit in fifth place in the Southwest division standings - three games ahead of Bowie. The Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers, The SeaWolves have hit eight home runs in the first four games of the series and lead the Eastern League with 28 home runs on the season. However, Erie has the worst staff ERA in the league at 5.83. SeaWolves arms has allowed the most hits (242), earned runs (147), and home runs (29) in the league. The SeaWolves welcome back Gabe Alvarez for his second season as the team's manager, alongside a mostly new staff. Erie's roster consists of nine of the Tigers' top 30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline. Position players include infielders Colf Keith (No. 4 DET/ No. 94 overall), Wenceel Perez (No. 8 DET) and Gage Workman (No. 29 DET), along with C Dillon Dingler (No. 14 DET). Right-handers Wilmer Flores (No. 3 DET/ No. 85 overall), Ty Madden (No. 5 DET), Dylan Smith (No. 15 DET), and Elvis Alvarado (No. 23 DET), alongside left-hander Brant Hurter (No. 21 DET) feature on the mound.

### TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

The SeaWolves look to send right-hander Wilmer Flores to the hill this evening. Despite his status as the No. 3 prospect in the Tigers' system, and the No. 85 overall prospect, per MLB Pipeline, Flores has struggled a bit thus far in 2023. Through five starts, he has allowed 15 earned runs in just 16.1 innings on 20 hits - good for a 8.27 ERA. However, the last two starts for Flores have been much better, allowing only a pair of runs across eight combined frames on six hits between division-leading Richmond and Portland. The right-hander made 19 starts for the SeaWolves last season, and posted a 3.01 ERA in 83.2 innings, with 95 strikeouts compared to just 21 walks. In three starts against Bowie last season, Flores allowed six earned runs across 14.1 innings (3.77 ERA), striking out seven batters in each of his three outings. He is the brother of 11-year big league vet Wilmer Flores and was originally signed by the Tigers as a free agent in July of 2020. His arsenal features a mid-90s fastball, high-70s curveball, and a mid-80s cutter

### AVOIDING THE TRAFFIC

Out of the 17 home runs hit by the Baysox this season, all of them have been either solo or two-run shots. Bowie is the only Eastern League team that has yet to hit a three-run homer or a grand slam in 2023. More specifically, 13 of the 18 home runs hit by the Baysox this season have been solo bombs, accounting for just over 72% of their long ball production. Only Portland has a higher portion of solo home runs in the Eastern League, at 81.3% (13/16)

### **HESTON IS BESTON**

OF/1B Heston Kjerstad has shown out as one of the top bats in the Eastern League so far this season. Kjerstad launched his eighth home run of the season last night, putting him back atop the League leaderboards in that category. Beyond the home runs, the Orioles' No. 5 prospect has also demonstrated plenty offensive consistency - leading the Eastern League in OPS (1.059) and slugging percentage (.671) among qualifiers, while standing second in extra-base hits (14) and total bases (57). Kjerstad has the most home runs and extra-base hits throughout the Orioles' system while his OPS is third best and his slugging percentage is second. Kjerstad's standout start to the season earned him Orioles Minor League Player of the Month honors for April.

#### HAIL CESAR

INF Cesar Prieto continues to pace the Eastern League with his 33 hits and .359 batting average. Last night's 2-3 performance was Prieto's 10th multi-hit contest in his first 23 games of 2023. Prieto's 11-game hitting streak last month is the second-longest in the Eastern League this season and is also the longest streak for any Orioles minor leaguer. Prieto's average and hits total are second best on the Baltimore farm among qualifiers

### HOBBLING AT HOME

The Baysox have not enjoyed much success at home this season. Bowie is just 4-11 in games played at Prince George's Stadium this season the worst home record in the Eastern League. The Baysox have been outscored by their opponents 79-58 at home this season. The Baysox have struggled containing the long ball in particular. Bowie arms have given up 23 of the staff's 28 home runs at home in 2023. The 23 home runs surrendered at home are the most in the Eastern League.

#### **COACHING STAFF**

#### Manager - Kyle Moore

2023 will be Kyle Moore's second season as the manager of the Baysox, and his 14th within the Orioles' organization. After leading Bowie to a division-best 14-28 through the back half of last season, Moore continues to display consistency at the heim of recent successful teams throughout the Orioles sys-tem. Moore led Class-A Delmarva to a minor league-best 90 wins as manager in 2019. The Shorebirds were named MiLB.com's Team of the Year and Moore won South Atlanic Manager of the Year honors. Moore's career managerial record sits at 254-216 (.540) entering the 2023 season. Prior to his managerial career, Moore also spent three seasons as a player/coach in the Orioles managerial career, Moore also spent three seasons as a player/coach in the Orioles system (2013 Frederick Keys, 2014 Bowie Baysox, 2015 Delmarva Shorebirds). He then took a position as the Shorebirds hitting coach in 2016, before joining the Keys in the same role in 2017. Moore played collegiately at Alabama, before signing with Battimore as an undrafted free agent in 2010. He currently resides in Sarasota alongside his wife Whitney, and his two daughters, Madilyn and Cameron.

Hitting Coach - Sherman Johnson

Sherman Johnson makes his coaching debut, as he joins the Baysox staff as the hitting coach in 2023. Johnson had a brief stint in the major leagues with the Los Angeles Angels back in 2018 and spent parts of nine minor league seasons across the Angels, Reds and Minnesota Twins organizations. Johnson's Japking career most recently landed him in independent ball this past season with the Kane County Cougars. Johnson as Japked two seasons collegiately at Florida State.

Pitching Coach - Forrest Herrmann

Priching Coach - Forrest Herrmann Forrest Hermann joins the Bowie Baysox coaching staff in his second season with the Orioles organization. He served as an assistant coach at the University of Memphis between 2017 and 2019 and was an assistant at the University of Hartford the two seasons prior. DeJohn played at Western Connecticut State from 2003-2008.
