

Today: The Lansing Lugnuts, the High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the finale in a six-game series with the Dayton Dragons, High-A affiliate of the Cincinnati Reds, the 15th game in a 21-game season series. The Nuts won the series opener, Dayton triumphed the next three nights, and the Lugnuts struck back with a rout yesterday to set up the potential for a series split with a victory this afternoon.

Last Night: Lugnuts 14, Dragons 1. Colby Halter launched a three-run homer in a four-run 3rd, Cole Conn and Jonny Butler drilled RBI doubles in the 4th, and the Nuts turned the game into a blowout with an eight-run ninth inning in front of a season-high crowd of 9,007 at Day Air Ballpark. Mitch Myers needed only 49 pitches to toss five innings of five-hit, one-run ball, striking out five, and Chen Zhong-Ao Zhuang and Hunter Breault combined for four scoreless innings of relief.

On Deck: The Lugnuts enjoy a day off tomorrow before opening a six-game homestand with the Cedar Rapids Kernels from June 11-16.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2009: In Game 1 of a doubleheader at Cooley Law School Stadium, Chase Lirette twirled a seven-inning complete game in a Lugnuts 8-2 win over the West Michigan Whitecaps. Game 2 was a marathon: The Whitecaps scored three in the 1st, the Lugnuts scored three in the 2nd, and then both teams hung goose eggs until the 11th inning when Avisail Garcia's two-run triple gave the Whitecaps a 5-3 victory. It took just three hours and three minutes to play the full 11 innings.

2017: Bo Bichette went 0-for-3 with two walks, ending his league-leading 17-game hitting streak, in a 5-4 loss at Fort Wayne. TinCaps starter Ronald Bolaños struck out nine in five innings for the TinCaps.

In a Nutshell: Signing bonus of \$3 million broke the record given to Sandy Gaston by Tampa Bay in 2018 (\$2.61m)... declared a free agent on August 25, 2022... signed on the first day of the international signing period, January 15, 2023, and motored through four levels in his professional debut... glove this year is green and black to represent A's green and Lugnuts' black... opened 2024 on the Injured List, activated April 29... notable splits:



Prospecting: Morales is ranked the Oakland Athletics' no. 2 prospect and top pitching prospect by MLB Pipeline, which grades his fastball at 60, his curve at 50, his slider at 55, his change at 50 and his control at 50.

They write, "Morales was billed as the consensus top pitching prospect of the 2023 international signing period when he signed for \$3 million with the A's in January that year. After setting a U-18 record for strikeouts with 161 across 82 2/3 innings between 2019-20 in Cuba's Serie Nacional, he defected in 2021 to Mexico, where he trained with Maels Rodríguez, a former Cuban National team pitcher and Olympian who regularly threw 100 mph fastballs. Initially expected to pitch solely in the Dominican Summer League for his introduction to pro ball, his excellent performance earned him stops at four different levels. He finished the year at High-A Lansing, combining for a 2.86 ERA with 53 strikeouts in 44 innings.

Morales' whip-like delivery produces an electric fastball that sits around 94-97 mph and can reach up to 99. His four-pitch mix also includes a slider, a changeup and a curveball, all of which appeared to be quality secondary pitches as he rapidly ascended through the Minors in his debut season.

Adding about 10 pounds of muscle to his 6-foot-3 frame in preparation for his first full season as a pro, Morales will see his durability tested as he looks to navigate the rigors of pitching. While his command was solid upon joining the A's, he has struggled with controlling his pitches in the past. If he can keep that control steady, he has a chance to make another significant jump through the system in 2024, with enough potential to evolve into a frontline starter in the future."

Path to Lansing: Luis opened the 2023 season in the Dominican Summer League, making his professional debut on June 6 with 1 2/3 hitless innings vs. DSL Astros Blue, striking out three... struck out six batters in three one-hit innings on June 20... struck out five batters in four one-hit innings on June 27... made four appearances in DSL before he was promoted to the Arizona Complex League Athletics on July 2, debuting on July 4 with three innings, allowing one run with three strikeouts vs. D-Backs Black... made three starts in AzCL before he was promoted to the Stockton Ports on July 24, debuting on July 28 with three one-hit innings and five strikeouts vs. Lake Elsinore... in last of five California League starts, tossed four two-hit scoreless innings at Fresno on August 25... promoted to Lansing on August 30, his fourth different stop along the ladder... strikeouts high: 6, 6/20/23.

In a Nutshell: Watters first appeared for the Lugnuts on August 31, 2022, pitching against Cubs rehabber Wade Miley at South Bend in his second professional appearance... he then spent the full 2023 season for the Nuts... he has spent all but one MiLB inning (of 93 total professional innings) with the Lugnuts.

2024 Notes: Opened the season in a piggyback tandem with Wander Guante, who was promoted to Double-A Midland on May 14... started May 18 and May 24 without a tandem-mate before piggybacking Luis Morales during last start... on May 24 at Fort Wayne, tossed one scoreless inning before game was suspended due to rain... on May 29, needed only 39 pitches to fire five scoreless innings against Peoria... notable splits:

Off to College: Did not receive much notice before his high velocity was discovered at a tryout in Morgantown... named to the Academic All-Big 12 Rookie Team as a freshman (5 G, 4.70 ERA, 7 2/3 IP, 4 R, 6 BB, 11 K)... as a sophomore, made 19 appearances: 3.33 ERA, 27 IP, 15 H, 11 R, 32 BB, bullpen-leading 53 K, .165 avg. allowed, tied for team lead with four saves; named Academic All-Big 12 Second Team; NCBWA Stopper of the Year Midseason Watch List... made first college start in the 2021 Big 12 Championship vs. Texas: 3 IP, 0 H, 1 R, 4 BB, 8 K... as a junior in 2022, named preseason All-American; dominated early as team closer and was moved into role as Friday starter; struck out 15 Texas Longhorns in 6 1/3 IP on May 7; overall: 18 G, 11 GS, 3-7, 6.22 ERA, 59 1/3 IP, 64 H, 44 R, 41 BB, 75 K; named All-Big 12 Honorable Mention.

Entering Draft Day: Rated Keith Law's No. 68 draft prospect for The Athletic, with Law writing, "Watters started the year in the Mountaineers' bullpen, where he hit 99 mph a few times, so the team moved him to the rotation around midseason, where he struggled more with control (37 walks in 50.2 innings) but also showed enough that some scouts think he can start in pro ball. Watters sits 94-97 mph with a power slider in the mid-80s that can miss bats ... when he locates it. It's not a bad delivery, with a reasonably short arm stroke and strong finish, so that's not the reason he doesn't throw strikes, but it's true across all of his pitches. It's more likely he ends up a power reliever with two plus pitches. But with enough of a changeup to start and a delivery that looks like it should work, I wouldn't be surprised to see a pro team keep him in the rotation."... Fangraphs' No. 96 draft prospect.

Inked: Selected 124th overall by the A's in the 4th round and signed for \$491,750... highest pitcher taken by the Athletics in 2022 (following first-round catcher Daniel Susac and three straight outfielders in high schooler Henry Bolte in the second round, Clark Elliott in the compensatory round B, and Colby Thomas in the third round).
