**Last Time Out:** The Binghamton Rumble Ponies fell to the Hartford Yard Goats 4-3 on Friday night on Marvel's Defenders of the Diamond Night at Mirabito Stadium. Trailing 4-1, Jaylen Palmer and Jose Peroza hit solo home runs in the fifth inning to make it 4-3. Both bullpens combined to allow two hits, one walk, and no runs over four innings with four strikeouts.

**Fryman is Heating Up:** Infielder **Branden Fryman** is riding an eight-game hitting streak. Over that span, he has 11 hits, two doubles, two triples, three runs batted in, and five runs. He has drawn two walks and has a stolen base over that span too. After having just one triple all of last season and two in his entire career, Fryman hit two triples in Friday night's game. He has three triples this season and all have come against Hartford (one on May 11 and two on June 30).

**Thomas The Tank:** Left-handed relief pitcher **Tyler Thomas** has been dominant since signing with the Mets and being assigned to Binghamton on June 5. Thomas tossed 1.2 scoreless frames last night with one hit allowed and two strikeouts. In five appearances with Binghamton, Thomas is 1-0 with a 1.17 ERA, .167 BAA, and 0.65 WHIP. His line: 7.2 IP, 4 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 1 BB, 8 K.

**The Kid from Flushing:** Outfielder **Jaylen Palmer** recorded the first hit of his Double-A career on a solo home run in the fifth inning of Friday's game. It was his third game at the Double-A level. Palmer hit four homers across 59 games with High-A Brooklyn before being promoted to Binghamton on June 26. The 22-year-old from Holy Cross HS in Flushing hit nine home runs with the Cyclones last year.

**The Binghamton Stakes:** The Binghamton Rumble Ponies went an even 13-13 in the month of June. The Ponies raised their batting average 11 points from May to .246 as a team in June. The 11-point jump in team batting average moved Binghamton from 10th in the Eastern League to sixth in the league. The Ponies hit 33 home runs as a team in the month, which ranked fourth in the league. Luke Ritter led the Ponies with seven homers in the month, followed by Rowdey Jordan and Brandon McIlwain who hit five each. Binghamton also ranked fourth in the league in walks in June with 101. Jordan and Matt Rudick each walked a team-leading 14 times in the month of June.

**2022:** Began the season with Brooklyn (A+) and made four starts before being assigned to Binghamton (AA) on May 2. Chacin had a strong Double-A debut last year on May 4 at Hartford. He went seven innings and struck-out three batters, while allowing two runs on four hits. Chacin led the Rumble Ponies in innings pitched (101.2) and starts (20) in 2022. He finished third in strikeouts (94) for Binghamton. Chacin pitched to a 4-9 record with a 5.67 ERA at the Double-A level in 23 appearances.

## **Reid Brignac - Manager - 2nd season with Binghamton - 4th year in the Mets organization.**

In 2022, Brignac led a team that saw five players make their major league debut with the Mets after starting the season with the Rumble Ponies (Francisco Álvarez, Brett Baty, Jose Butto, Nate Fisher, and Bryce Montes de Oca), tied for the second-most in franchise history. This past fall, Brignac was one of two Mets staff members selected to be a part of the Arizona Fall League coaching staff, serving as the manager of the Peoria Javelinas. Following his retirement as an active player in 2018, Brignac was the manager of the St. Lucie Mets (Low-A) in 2021 before coming to Binghamton last year. As a player, Brignac appeared in parts of nine seasons in the major leagues with the Tampa Bay Rays, Colorado Rockies, Atlanta Braves, Philadelphia Phillies, New York Yankees, and Miami Marlins. He was drafted by the Rays in the second round of the 2004 MLB Draft.

**AJ Sager - Pitching Coach - 1st season with Binghamton - 2nd year in the Mets organization.** Sager served in the same role for the Brooklyn Cyclones (High-A) last season. Sager previously spent twenty seasons with the Detroit Tigers organization, including six seasons as the pitching coach with Triple-A Toledo. He pitched for parts of five seasons in the major leagues, playing for the San Diego Padres, Colorado Rockies, and Detroit Tigers as part of a 12-year professional career.
