LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn surged back into the win column with a 2-1 victory over Jersey Shore on Thursday...The BlueClaws entered the contest needing a win and Greensboro loss to become the North Division's first-half champions, but neither occurred as the Grasshoppers defeated Hudson Valley, 4-2...RHP **Jonah Tong** was outstanding one day removed from his 21st birthday...The Markham, Ont. native spun 5.0 scoreless innings, and allowed just one hit while striking out seven...Both of Brooklyn's runs came in the second inning, thanks to a pair of RBI doubles from 2B **Junior Tilen** and C **Christian Pregent**...Jersey Shore got one back in the sixth when 2B **William Bergolla** laced a liner to left, but the Brooklyn bullpen remained stout the rest of the way to close the first half with a win...RHP **Josh Hejka** registered the final three outs for his fourth save...The Cyclones finished the first half at an even .500...The 33-33 record is Brooklyn's best in a first half since moving to the full-season level in 2021.

YOU SAY IT'S YOUR BIRTHDAY: RHP **Kade Morris**, tonight's scheduled starting pitcher for the Cyclones, celebrates his 22nd birthday on Friday...He is the second Brooklyn pitcher to enjoy a birthday this week, joining RHP **Jonah Tong**, who turned 21 on Wednesday.

DOUBLE OR NOTHIN': Brooklyn recorded six hits in Thursday's victory over Jersey Shore, five of which were doubles...3B **Nick Lorusso** (2x), SS **Wilfredo Lara**, 2B **Junior Tilen** and C **Christian Pregent** all collected a two-bagger...The only hit that did not go for extra bases was CF **Nick Morabito's** infield single in the seventh...Interestingly enough, all five doubles were hit to an eerily similar spot down the left-field line...The five extra-base hits are one shy of the most that Brooklyn has tallied in a game this season, when they scorched six, most recently on June 9 vs. Aberdeen...The five doubles tie the highest total Brooklyn has had in a game this year, matching their five on May 30, on the road, also against the BlueClaws.

SUPER STANLEY: OF **Stanley Consuegra** is in the midst of his best offensive stretch of the season...The 23-year-old tallied a career-high-tying four hits in last Sunday's loss at Hudson Valley...Consuegra has accomplished the feat four times, most recently on April 13, 2023, at Winston-Salem...He is also the second Cyclone to reach that mark in 2024, joining CF **Nick Morabito** (5/28 @JS)...Since May 17 at Bowling Green, he's hitting .297/.410/.554 with a .964 OPS...The Santo Domingo, D.R. native has scored 14 runs and added eight doubles, six home runs, and 20 RBI...Consuegra has raised his batting average by 62 points (.171 to .233) and his OPS by 220 points (.519 to .739) during the stretch...Since that date, the right-handed slugger is tied for fourth in the South Atlantic League in extra-base hits (14) and doubles (8), tied for sixth in total bases (56), ninth in slugging (.554) and OPS (.964), and tied for ninth in RBI (20)...On Wednesday, the veteran surpassed UTL **Jaylen Palmer** (204) for the most games played in franchise history (206)...Consuegra also set the Cyclones' all-time doubles record (40) on June 8 vs. Aberdeen and the all-time hits mark (185) on May 29 at Jersey Shore...He is also the franchise's all-time leader in extra-base hits (81), home runs (35), RBI (121), and outfield assists (19)...Consuegra also holds the single-season mark for home runs (23), and extra-base hits (42), and is tied with INF **Ronny Mauricio** (63) for single-season RBI.

JOLTIN' JEFREY: IF/OF **Jeffrey De Los Santos** is in the midst of perhaps his best stretch of the 2024 season...The Higuey, D.R. native has already notched six multi-hit games in June...During the calendar month, De Los Santos has hit safely in all but three games...The left-handed swinger is tied for second in the league in triples (2), sixth in batting average (.348), and eighth in slugging (.609) and OPS (1.032) in the month...Since May 16, the 21-year-old is second on the 'Clones in batting average (.286) and OPS (.896), trailing only OF **Stanley Consuegra** in both categories.

LARRUPIN' LORUSSO: INF **Nick Lorusso** has been one of the best hitters in the South Atlantic League throughout 2024...The 23-year-old is tied for seventh in the circuit in extra-base hits (25), tied for eighth in total bases (101), and ninth in slugging (.483)...Lorusso is third among New York Mets' full-season minor leaguers slugging (.483), tied for third in triples (3) and extra-base hits (25), fourth in OPS (.849), and tied for fifth in home runs (9) and RBI (35).

MARVELOUS MORABITO: OF **Nick Morabito** has been as good as any offensive player in Minor League Baseball in 2024...Morabito is tied for seventh in Minor League Baseball in stolen bases (32) and ranks 10th in on-base percentage (.438)...Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 7, the former second-round pick is second in the league in steals (21), third in runs scored (29), and tied for 10th in hits (41).

SUERO SUAVE: C **Chris Suero** has started to find his rhythm offensively in the South Atlantic League...The 20-year-old capped the last home series vs. Aberdeen with his first career multi-home run game, blasting two-run shots in the fourth and sixth innings...In five games against the IronBirds, Suero was 7-for-16 (.438) at the dish with seven runs scored, a double, three home runs, and an eye-popping 11 RBI...Since May 17 at Bowling Green, Suero has reached safely in 23 of 24 games, hitting .268/.413/.427 with an .840 OPS...The Bronx native has scored a whopping 20 runs with a double, four home runs, 18 RBI, and 20 walks...Since that date, Suero is tied for fourth in the SAL in walks (20), ninth in on-base percentage (.413), and tied for 10th in runs scored (20)...The third-year pro has also reached in 11-straight contests since June 6...Suero is hitting .293/.444/.537 with a .981 OPS in that span, accumulating 10 runs, a double, three home runs, 13 RBI, and 12 walks to 14 strikeouts.

vs. JERSEY SHORE: Brooklyn returns home for a six-game series, including the final three games of the season's first half, against the Phillies' High-A affiliate...Jersey Shore boasts seven of Philadelphia's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: INF **Aidan Miller** (2), OF **Justin Crawford** (4), INF **William Bergolla** (11), OF **Emaarion Boyd** (16), OF **Hendry Mendez** (22), LHP **Sam Aldegheri** (23), RHP **George Klassen** (28)...The Cyclones split both series played in 2024 at ShoreTown Ballpark, going 6-6 in 12 contests...Brooklyn does not return to Jersey Shore in the 2024 regular season, hosting the final 15 meetings...In 2023, Brooklyn dropped the season series to the Jersey Shore, 15-11...The Cyclones were 11-6 in Lakewood and 4-5 on Coney Island...Dating back to 2021, Brooklyn leads the all-time series, 53-45 (.541).

JUNIOR MINTS: INF **Junior Tilen** enters play with the second-longest active on-base streak in the South Atlantic League, and fourth-longest of the year, reaching in 25 consecutive games since Game 1 of a doubleheader on May 16 at Bowling Green...Greenville OF **Allen Castro** has the longest active streak in the circuit at 26 games...Greenville's INF **Kristian Campbell** reached in 34-straight contests from April 11 to May 31, the SAL's longest run in 2024...The 21-year-old has accumulated a .269/.360/.398 slash line with a .758 OPS during the streak, adding four doubles, a triple, two home runs, 12 RBI, and 14 walks...The infielder is the first Cyclone to record an on-base streak of 20 or more games since INF **José Peroza** reached in 31-consecutive games from May 29 until September 2, 2022...Tilen also posted a 10-game hitting streak from July 29 until June 9...He slashed .375/.409/.550 with a .959 OPS in that time.

OH, HENRY!: The Cyclones added RHP **Henry Henry** from Single-A St. Lucie on Tuesday...The 25-year-old made his Brooklyn debut on June 19th vs. Jersey Shore, tossing one scoreless inning of relief work where he accumulated two strikeouts and allowed one hit...Signed by New York as a minor league free agent on May 16, the San Cristóbal, D.R. native spent the first eight seasons of his professional career in the San Diego Padres...Between High-A Fort Wayne and Double-A San Antonio, Henry was 3-4 with a 5.19 ERA (29 ER in 50.1 IP) with 35 walks and 37 strikeouts in 34 appearances (three starts) in 2023...Henry Henry is not to be confused with former Pittsburgh Pirates infield prospect **Henry Henry** or the Cyclones' legendary on-field emcee **King Henry**.

WALK THIS WAY: INF **William Lugo** has had a keen eye at the plate in 2024, drawing 47 walks...That number ranks second in the South Atlantic League, while his 19.9% walk rate is first...Among minor leaguers with 230 or more plate appearances, Lugo sits fourth in walk rate...Major League Baseball's top prospect and Triple-A Norfolk's (Baltimore) SS **Jackson Holliday**, as well as Lugo's former Cyclone teammate and Double-A Binghamton's IF/OF **Ryan Clifford** are tied for the MiLB lead (22.0%).

YOU'LL GET NOTHING AND LIKE IT: RHPs **Dakota Hawkins** (5.0 IP), **Joey Lancellotti** (1.0), and **Joshua Cornielly** (3.0) combined on the first nine-inning no-hitter in Brooklyn Cyclones history June 4's 3-0 win vs. Aberdeen...The only previous no-hitter came on August 23, 2009, when RHP **Brandon Moore** tossed a seven-inning no-no in a 5-0 win during Game 1 of a doubleheader at Aberdeen...It is one of four no-hitters in Minor League Baseball in 2024...The effort was the first no-hitter by a Mets minor league affiliate since RHP **Joander Suárez** hurled a seven-inning one on September 7 at Hartford...It was also the first nine-inning no-hitter thrown in the borough of Brooklyn since RHP **Sal Maglie** tossed a no-no for the Dodgers against the Philadelphia Phillies on September 25, 1956, at Ebbets Field.

ATOP THE HEJ-ES: RHP **Josh Hejka** earned his first save of the season on May 5 vs. Aberdeen, making his Cyclones' franchise-record-setting 48th pitching appearance in the process...The 27-year-old broke a tie with **Hunter Parsons** (47) for the most pitching appearances in Cyclones franchise history...In his 61 career outings for Brooklyn since 2019, Hejka has accumulated a 5-3 record with a 2.35 ERA (26 ER in 99.2 IP) and 7 saves, walking just 24 and striking out 88.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have three of the Top 30 per BA: **Kade Morris** (21), **Jonah Tong** (22) and **Calvin Ziegler** (29)...Ziegler is currently on the full-season injured list...Plus four of the Top 30 per MLB: Tong (20), Ziegler (23), **Wilfredo Lara** (24), and OF **Nick Morabito** (26).

LAST TIME OUT: Took a no-decision last Saturday night at Hudson Valley...Permitted five runs on six hits over 4.1 innings...Walked two and struck out six...Surrendered a pair of two-run home runs in the fifth inning to 2B **Roc Riggio** and 1B **Rafael Flores**...Plunked a batter... Tossed 85 pitches and 54 strikes (63.53%)... Relieved by LHP **Julian Smith** with the bases empty and one out in the bottom of the fifth with Brooklyn trailing, 5-3...Cyclones scored four runs in the seventh and one more in the eighth to rally and defeat the Renegades, 8-5.

PROSPECT RADAR: Morris is considered the New York Mets' No. 21 prospect in 2024 according to *Baseball America*...He is the highest-rated prospect on the Cyclones' roster per the publication.

2024: Joined the Cyclones from Single-A St. Lucie on May 20...Made seven appearances (six starts) in the Florida State League...Posted an 0-3 record with a 3.63 ERA (14 ER in 34.2 IP), 11 walks, and 38 strikeouts...Struck out a career-high nine over five innings in a loss at Bradenton on May 9...Tallied a career-best 7.0-shutout innings of work in his final start on May 15 at Palm Beach...Punched out 27 (28.13 K%) and walked five (5.21 BB%) in his final 22.0 innings in the circuit.

2023: Signed with the Mets as a third-round selection on July 15 for \$666,500...Assigned to the Florida Complex League Mets on August 17...Made one start on August 17 at the FCL Marlins...Allowed one unearned run on one hit in 1.0 inning...Transferred to Single-A St. Lucie on September 6...Made one start on September 7 vs. Daytona...Permitted one run on one hit over 2.1 innings...Walked two and struck out three...Returned to the FCL on September 8.
