LAST TIME OUT

The Baysox snapped a four-game losing streak with an 8-3 victory in the series finale at Harrisburg on Sunday. **John Rhodes** drove in a career-high six RBI on a career-high five hits, including a three-run homer in the third inning. **Matthew Etzel** also drove in his first RBI in Double-A. On the mound, **Alex Pham** struck out a season-high eight over five innings of three run to ball to record the win. **Lincoln Hennen** and **Ryan Hennen** combined for four innings of scoreless relief.

TEENAGE DREAM

C Samuel Basallo is just the ninth teenager to reach 10 home runs in a season at the Double-A level since the year 2005. Basallo is the first teen in the Eastern League to reach the mark since Vladimir Guerrero Jr. did so with the New Hampshire Fisher Cats in 2018. Basallo's 55 games to reach 10 Double-A home runs makes him the third-fastest teenager to do so since 2005. Only Guerrero (44 GP in 2018) and Giancarlo Stanton (41 GP in 2009) reached 10 HR in fewer games.

RHODES IS ROLLING

OF/1B **John Rhodes** had a career day on Father's Day Sunday in Harrisburg. The Orioles No. 23 prospect collected a career-high five hits, went a perfect 5-for-5 at the plate and drove in a career-high six RBI, including a three-run homer. In the month of June, Rhodes is batting .343 with a team-leading 12 RBI. It's the first five hit game by a Baysox player this season and the 29th five-hit game in Baysox franchise history. Rhodes is the first Baysox player to go 5-for-5 since Aderlin Rodriguez on 6/7/17.

THE FANTASTIC FABIAN

OF **Jud Fabian** hit his 12th home run of the season on Saturday night, tying him for the second-most homers in the Eastern League. Fabian hit a league-high six homers in the month of May and has four thus far in June - including three last week in Harrisburg. He's hitting .241 through 53 games after hitting just .176 in 64 AA games last season. His batting average on balls in play has jumped over 50 points in that span.

ON-BASE BEAVERS

OF/1B **Dylan Beavers** has reached base in 46 of 53 games started in his second season with the Baysox. The Orioles No. 7 prospect leads the team in OBP (.365) and leads the team in walks (33), tied for the third-most in the Eastern League. On Saturday, Beavers reached base at least three times in a game for the 10th time this year.

WELCOME MR. ETZEL

OF/1B **Matthew Etzel** has made a nice first impression since being promoted from High-A Aberdeen on June 11. In his first Double-A series against Harrisburg, Etzel went 5-for-18 with an RBI and four stolen bases. He is the first Orioles '23 draft pick to be promoted to Double-A after being selected in the 10th round out of So. Miss.

BUILT BY THE BULLPEN

Bowie's bullpen leads the Eastern League and all of Double-A in innings pitched (300.0) and strikeouts (348). The Baysox bullpen owns a 1.19 WHIP, which is good for fourth-lowest in Double-A.

ASSESSING ALTOONA

Entering this week, the Altoona Curve sit in last place in the Southwest Division at 24-39 on the season. However, the Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates has won their last four in a row and eight of their last 10, including back-to-back series victories over Richmond and Erie. Altoona's roster includes six of the Pirates' top 30 prospects (per MLB Pipeline) - RHP Bubba Chandler (No. 3), LHP Anthony Solometo (No. 4), RHP Thomas Harrington (No. 5), SS Tsung-Che Cheng (No. 8), OF Jase Bowen (No. 19), OF Tres Gonzalez (No. 26)

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Po-Yu Chen takes the hill for the 13th time this season for Altoona. The 22-year-old has posted an ERA of just 2.89 through three June starts. The Taiwanese right-hander most recently pitched 4.2 innings and gave up four runs on five hits across four strikeouts and two walks and took the loss against Erie on Wednesday. In two outings against Bowie this season, Chen has a 9.45 ERA over 6.2 innings. He has allowed 12 hits and seven runs.

Threw longest outing of Double-A career in last home start on Thu. 6/6 vs BNG. Went 5.0 IP, gave up just 1 H, 2 BB and struck out 6 to pick up win. Holds a 1.65 ERA in four home outings. Baysox are 1-3 when Weston starts...Made first career Double-A start on 5/25 vs RIC. Pitched 4.0 IP, gave up 2 H, 2 R on a 2-R HR, 1 BB and struck out 3 to receive the loss. Bumped into rotation beginning on 5/25 after beginning Double-A career with four relief outings. Promoted to Double-A Bowie on April 30. First IronBird to be promoted to Double-A this season. Made Double-A debut on 5/1 vs ERI and struck out 8 batters over 4.0 scoreless innings to record first Double-A win. At time of promotion, posted a 0.54 ERA over 16.2 IP with 19 K/7 BB. 2023: Spent most of first half on IL with tendonitis suffered during Spring Training. Debuted in Aberdeen on June 15 after a one-game rehab appearance with FCL Orioles. Threw 40.1 IP, struck out 49 batters over 12 walks to an ERA of 2.68 in first full season in minors. Nine of his 12 appearances came out of the bullpen in bulk relief situations.

2022: Debuted in Single-A Delmarva in and made five appearances out of bullpen. Posted a 3.18 ERA over 11.1 innings with 11 strikeouts over three walks and 0.79 WHIP.

College/Personal: Drafted by the Orioles in the 8th round of the 2022 Draft out of Michigan. Worked as a starter for most of his career at Michigan until midway through his final season when he was pushed into the closer role. Named to All-NCAA Louisville Regional Team...Grew up in Canonsburg, Pa., about 20 miles south of Pittsburgh.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.



CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the "Chesapeake Baysox." This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stenciled outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince George's Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.



BOWIE PIT BEEF

The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s



COACHING STAFF

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization's Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado in the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

JOSH BUNSELMAYER

Hitting Coach

Bunselmeyer served as the hitting coach for the Orioles' Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, last season. 2024 is Bunselmeyer's fifth season in the Orioles' system after also spending the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League. He played three seasons in the Independent Frontier League following a collegiate playing career at Saint Louis University.

CHASE SEBBY

Fundamentals Coach

Sebby joins the Baysox staff as the Fundamentals Coach in 2024. Sebby was the fundamentals coach in Aberdeen last season and was a development coach within the Orioles' organization in 2022. Sebby played collegiately as a catcher at Cypress College and Ball State.

BILLY FACTEAU

Development Coach

A familiar face in Bowie, Facteau rejoins the Baysox staff in 2024. Facteau was the development coach in Aberdeen last season, but began his professional coaching career as a development coach on the Baysox staff in 2022. Prior to his first stint with Bowie, Facteau first served in the Orioles' organization as a technology intern.
