**FRISCO USES SEVEN-RUN NINTH INNING FOR COMEBACK WIN IN AMARILLO:**

Behind a seven-run ninth inning, the Frisco RoughRiders came back to beat the Amarillo Sod Poodles 15-11 on Tuesday night from HODGETOWN. Frisco (6-4) scored four runs off of Amarillo (2-8) starter Avery Short thanks to two-RBI singles from **John Taylor** and **Orlando Martinez**, but still trailed 6-4 entering the sixth inning after **Josh Trentadue** gave up five runs in his second start of the season. Martinez led off the sixth inning with a solo home run, his first as a RoughRider and added another blast for good measure in the seventh inning following a **Keyber Rodriguez** RBI triple, which cut Frisco's deficit to 9-8. By the ninth, the Riders trailed 11-8 again, with Martinez due up first in the inning. He promptly bashed a leadoff double off of Alfred Morrillo (0-1) for his fourth hit of the night and scored on a double from **Marcus Lee Sang**, his third two-bagger of the night. **Frainyer Chavez** smacked an RBI single that made it 11-10. The next batter, **Ian Moller**, hit a grounder that Amarillo tried to turn a double play on and threw the ball away, allowing two runs to score and giving Frisco a 12-11 lead. Taylor notched another RBI single and Martinez smoked his second hit of the inning and fifth of the night, driving in two more runs for a 15-11 advantage.

**GET RICH OR DIE DREILING:**

RoughRiders outfielder **Dylan Dreiling** has been on a heater to start the season. The No. 10 prospect in the organization is hitting .333 (12-for-36)/.429/.528/.957 with 1 double, 2 home runs, 8 RBIs, 6 walks, 5 runs and 2 steals through 9 games. The former second-round selection by the Rangers won the College World Series Most Outstanding Player award with Tennessee in 2024.

**CHAVEZ IN CHARGE:**

RoughRiders infielder **Frainyer Chavez** has been on fire at the plate. On Thursday, Chavez tied a career high with 4 hits, going 4-for-5, followed that up with a two-hit game on Friday, including a home run, and another blast on Sunday. In his 10 games, he has reached in all 10, and is hitting .333 (14-for-42)/.420/.524/.944 with 2 doubles, 2 home runs, 6 RBIs, 7 walks and just 7 strikeouts. The five-year RoughRider is 9th in the league in T-1st in runs (12), 5th in total bases (22) and T-4th in hits (14).

**THIS BASEBALL BAT BRO CAN SWING IT:**

RoughRiders utility player **John Taylor** rides a 7-game hitting streak into action on Wednesday. In the streak, he is hitting .321 (9-for-28)/.375/.464/.839 with 1 double, 1 home run, 7 RBIs, 3 walks and 5 runs scored. Taylor has hit safely in every game except for one that he has played in while collecting multiple hits in 3 games. The streak is the longest-active streak on the Riders and the fourth-longest active streak in the Texas League. Taylor is part of the social media-famous Baseball Bat Bros, who rate baseball bats and have over 1 million followers on YouTube, TikTok and Instagram.

**YOU WANT THE HITS, WE GOT UM:**

Through 9 games the RoughRiders are first in Double-A with 108 hits and first among all non-Triple-A teams. Among teams with at least 10 games played, they are second in Double-A in batting average (.294) and tied for 7th in runs (61, 6.1 runs per game). The RoughRiders have not led the Texas League in batting average since 2014. Holding them back, they are hitting just .254 (32-for-126) with just a .645 OPS with runners in scoring position. On Sunday, they were held to just two hits, their fewest since they were held to one hit on August 17th, 2025, also by Midland. **Orlando Martinez** collected 5 hits on Tuesday, the only 5-hit game in the Texas League this year and one of two in Double-A. It is the only 5-hit game with 2 home runs in the Minor Leagues this year and the third time in franchise history (since 2005) a Riders player accomplished the feat, joining **Cody Freeman** on April 25th, 2024 and **Abimelec Ortiz** on September 14th, 2024. Freeman's was at home against Amarillo, while Ortiz collected the 5 hits and 2 home runs at Amarillo.

**CAUGHT YOU THIEVING:**

RoughRiders catcher **Julian Brock** had a sparkling day on Wednesday, going 2-for-4 at the plate with a double and an RBI while also catching three baserunners trying to steal. He added a home run on Thursday. Through 9 games, he has the second-most in Double-A with 6 caught stealings and is 6-for-11 in catching runners. In 17 games for the RoughRiders last season, Brock hit .321/.400/.446/.846 with 4 doubles, 1 home run and 10 RBIs. As a team, the Riders are 5th in Double-A with a 30% caught-stealing rate.

**AMARILLO BY MORNING:**

In 2025, the Riders went 12-6 against Amarillo and showed off the power, hitting 22 homers while allowing 12 overall. In HODGETOWN, the Riders hit 18 home runs in 12 games, following a trend over the years. Since Amarillo joined the Texas League in 2019, the Riders have played 84 games in HODGETOWN, 13 more than the next-closest team (Midland). In those 84 games, Frisco has hit 144 home runs (1.7 HR/G) averaging 6.4 runs per game. Since 2019, Frisco is averaging just 0.8 HR/G at all other Texas League parks and averaging just 4.8 R/G since 2019 in all other parks. Former Rider **Blaine Crim** holds the record for the most home runs at HODGETOWN by a visiting player, hitting 10 over his 18 games there while slashing .354/.381/.785/1.166. **Abimelec Ortiz** (8) and **Justin Foscue** (7) are also in the top 5 among visiting players. The RoughRiders franchise record for most home runs in a six game series is 17 and has been done three times, all in Amarillo (6/7-6/12, 2022 at AMA... 8/30-9/4, 2022 at AMA ... 9/10-15, 2024 at AMA).

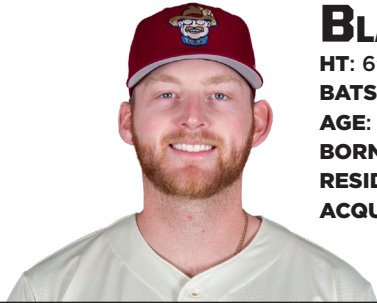

### ABOUT BLAKE

-Australian native pitched for Team Australia in both the 2023 and 2026 World Baseball Classics. In 2023, he threw 1.0 scoreless inning before tossing two scoreless outings (2.1 innings) in 2026, including inducing a lineup to right field from Shohei Ohtani.

-Before the WBC, he was a member of the Australian National Team at the U-15 baseball World Cup in Iwaki, Japan in 2016.

-Pitched for the U-18 Australian Team against extended Spring Training Major League teams in 2018, leading to his signing by the Mariners on June 19th, 2018.

-After seven years with the Mariners, he was released in August of 2024 and signed by the Pirates, where he pitched for 2025 as well after resigning in the offseason.

-He elected free agency following 2025 and signed with the Rangers on January 23rd, 2026.

### 2026 SEASON

-Enters the season in the RoughRiders starting rotation.

### 2025 SEASON

-Among MiLB pitchers who threw at least 90.0 innings, he was 4th in the minors with a 1.76 ERA.

-Had just a 0.97 ERA through his first 25 games (six starts), allowing earned runs in just six of those outings.

-In his last 9G/6GS, went 1-2 with a 3.62 ERA.

### 2024 SEASON

-Pitched between Seattle and Pittsburgh organizations.

-2.35 ERA on the season over 38.1 IP was 84th in all of MiLB among relievers (0 starts) with at least 30.0 IP.

### 2023 SEASON

-All 35 games were in relief in 2023 for Low-A Modesto, finishing fifth on the team in appearances.

## CHAD COMER

Years with Rangers: 10

Years with RoughRiders: 2 (1st as manager)

Comer returns to Double-A Frisco in 2026 after managing at the High-A level over the last three seasons. The native of Mansfield, Texas will enter his 10th season with the Rangers and his second in Frisco.

In 2022, Comer helped pilot the Riders to their second Texas League Championship in franchise history, serving as a development coach. Over the last three seasons, Comer managed High-A Hickory (2023-2024) and High-A Hub City (2025), going 197-191 (.508).

Prior to Frisco, Comer was the hitting coach for the High-A Hickory Crawdads in 2021, after serving as a coach at various levels of the Rangers system from 2016-2019.

The former University of Texas at Arlington catcher played two seasons in the Atlanta Braves organization, reaching High-A Lynchburg in 2012. He was drafted by Atlanta in the 29th round of the 2011 draft after four seasons at UTA.

## THOMAS ST. CLAIR

Years with Rangers: 5

Years with RoughRiders: 1

St. Clair joins the Riders as the pitching coach after leading a Hub City staff that finished third in the SAL with a 3.50 ERA in 2025. St. Clair also will serve as the assistant pitching coordinator in the Rangers farm system in 2026.

Initially, St. Clair came to the Rangers as a coach in the Dominican Summer League in 2022 before serving as a pitching coach for the ACL Rangers from 2022-23. Before professional baseball, he spent two and a half years as pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at North Carolina Wesleyan College.

The right-hander pitched three professional seasons in the St. Louis Cardinals system from 2017-19 after he was picked in the 24th round of the 2017 June draft, making 88 outings for the organization's Rookie and Single-A affiliates.

The Winston-Salem, North Carolina native played four years (2014-17) at Division II Lenior-Rhyne University in Hickory, N.C.

## JASON HART

Years with Rangers: 13

Years with RoughRiders: 9

Hart returns as the hitting coach in Frisco for the first time since he served as the RoughRiders hitting coach from 2012-2019. Before that, most recently, he was the Major League hitting assistant for the Miami Marlins under current Rangers manager Skip Schumaker.

In 2015, Hart was named the Mike Coolbaugh Texas League Coach of the Year for his work with the Riders hitters. Prior to joining Frisco, Hart spent two seasons as the hitting coach with Low-A Hickory. His tenure with the Rangers began after he assisted the Single-A Clinton staff with coaching responsibilities for a portion of the 2008 season and continued when he accepted the role of hitting coach for the Arizona Rangers before the 2009 campaign.

Hart played professionally for parts of eight seasons from 1998-2006, with stints in the Oakland, Texas and Minnesota organizations. He made his Major League debut with the Rangers in 2002, when he batted .267 (4-for-15) with three doubles over a span of 10 games. He missed the 2004 campaign following the removal of a benign brain tumor, but returned to the field in 2005 and hit 21 home runs in 128 games with Frisco.

Originally drafted by Oakland in the fifth round of the 1998 draft, Hart was acquired by Texas in a January 2002 trade with the Athletics. He attended Southwest Missouri State University, where he paced the conference in homers in 1997 and was named a Missouri Valley Conference All-Star in 1998.

Hernandez joins the RoughRiders for his first season with the Rangers organization.

During 2020, Hernandez managed the Texas Collegiate League Frisco RoughRiders after the MiLB season had been canceled. In 2025, he served as a bench coach for Triple-A Jacksonville and spent 19 seasons with the Marlins as a coach and coordinator. As part of that stint, he served eight seasons as a manager, most recently in 2022 with High-A Beloit.

Hernandez started his coaching career at the University of Mobile in 1993 as a hitting coach and stayed there through 2001. From 2005-2006, Hernandez served as the hitting coach for the Independent Pensacola Pelicans.
