YESTERDAY'S RECAP: The New Hampshire Fisher Cats hit a season-high five home runs on Thursday night, defeating the Reading Fightin' Phils 9-2 at FirstEnergy Stadium. Orelvis Martinez collected his first multi-home run game of the season, hitting two in the victory while Miguel Hiraldo, Sebastian Espino and Damiano Palmegiani followed with a home run each. Last year, Martinez had four multi-home run performances. On the mound, starting pitcher Adam Kloffenstein pitched five strong innings, allowing two runs (one earned) on one hit and one walk while striking out seven in a no decision. Kloffenstein has now struck out six or more hitters in each of his last four starts. The Fisher Cats bullpen of Luis Quinones, Adrian Hernandez, and Troy Watson combined for four shutout innings of relief with six strikeouts.

**HOME RUN DERBY:** New Hampshire has hit 10 home runs in the three games so far in this series (two on Tuesday, three on Wednesday, five on Thursday). Coming into the series, the Fisher Cats had only hit 17 homers all season through the first 26 games of the year. Orelvis Martinez and Damiano Palmegiani have combined for half of the 10 home runs this week (Martinez has three, Palmegiani has two).

MUST SEE MARTINEZ: IF Orelvis Martinez is enjoying his time in Reading so far this week. The Blue Jays No. 4 prospect has homered in back-to-back games and has 3 home runs and 5 RBIs in the series. All three of his hits in the series have gone over the wall. He also collected his first multi-home run game of the season on Thursday. The 21-year-old Dominican Republic native currently leads the Fisher Cats with seven home runs and 20 RBIs to start the season after hitting a team-high 30 home runs last season, breaking the Fisher Cats single-season record of 27 home runs previously set by Chip Cannon (2006) and Eric Thames (2010). Martinez was second in the Eastern League in home runs and had four multi-homer games.

ON-BASE PALMEGIANI: IF Damiano Palmegiani is at the top of the Eastern League leaderboard in on-base percentage. The corner infielder is getting on-base at a .417 clip, fourth-best in the league. The Blue Jays No. 29 prospect is tied for second in the Eastern League in walks (24). He has more walks than hits (21). Palmegiani has reached base in an impressive 23 of 27 games played this season and has walked in 18 games.

CAN'T STOP STEWARD: OF Steward Berroa currently has the longest active hit streak on the team at five consecutive games. The speedy outfielder has driven in six RBIs over his last five games after driving in six RBIs all of April. During his hit streak, Berroa is 7-for-18 (.389) with three doubles, a homer and six RBIs.

THIS DAY IN FISHER CATS HISTORY (May 12, 2022) - In a 7-2 win against the Rumble Ponies, the Fisher Cats hit five home runs in five different innings. Sebastian Espino got the party started with a two-run shot in the second. Tanner Morris homered in the third. Espino hit another out in the fourth inning. Orelvis Martinez homered in the fifth, and John Aiello (eye-ELL-oh) homered for New Hampshire in the 7th.

MANCHESTER-BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: Toronto (21-16) had Thursday off. The Blue Jays open a big 10-game home stand with Atlanta tonight. The Yankees and Orioles will also come to Rogers Centre...Triple-A Buffalo (15-21) scored four runs in the bottom of the ninth to beat Syracuse 6-5. Ernie Clement hit a bases-loaded double to drive in three runs to tie the game, and Spencer Horwitz followed with a walkoff single...High-A Vancouver (16-10) dispatched Everett 13-1, scoring nine runs in the first two innings. Riley Tirotta (Jays 12th rounder, 2021, Dayton) drove in seven runs with three hits...Class A Dunedin (17-13) capped a big-day by Jays affiliates with a 15-5 win over Clearwater as starter Rafael Sanchez improved to 5-0.

COMING UP: The Fisher Cats continue their road trip at Reading for a six-game series against the Fightin Phils'. The next home stand for New Hampshire begins on Tue. May 16 when they host the Binghamton Rumble Ponies for a six-game set.
