FROM THE CROWS NEST

LET'S PLAY TWO: This evening, the Marauders and Threshers will play a doubleheader to make up their previously postponed matchup from last Thursday. The Marauders will be the home team in game one and road team in game two. Both contests will be seven innings. This season they have played two twin bills and are 2-2 those contests. This is their second at LECOM Park. Bradenton is off to a 16-16 start in the second half, currently 0.5 games above of Clearwater and Fort Myers for the FSL West's final playoff spot. With 35 games to go, the Marauders are eyeing their first postseason appearance since 2021 when they won their second FSL title. After taking two of three from the Mighty Mussels earlier this week, they have secured the season-series win which gives them the tie-break advantage if the two teams finish with even records at the end of the season. The Marauders enter tonight 8-9 versus the Threshers this season, with four more matchups to go. In order to secure the head-to-head advantage, they will need to take three of four at the minimum. **Clearwater can clinch the tie breaker with two wins this weekend.**

NEW KID ON THE BLOCK: On Wednesday, the Pirates acquired infielder **Sammy Stafura** and **LHP Taylor Rogers** from the Cincinnati Reds organization in exchange for third basemen **Ke'Bryan Hayes**. While Rogers was flipped to the Chicago Cubs before the trade deadline, Stafura remains in the Pirates system and has been assigned to Single-A Bradenton. The 20 year old is currently ranked as the No. 7 prospect in the Pirates system by MLB Pipeline. He was drafted by the Reds in the second round of the 2023 draft out of high school in Cortlandt New York. In 88 games with the Daytona Tortugas this season, he slashed .262/.393/.411 with four home runs and 28 stolen bases. In two games against Bradenton to begin the season, he went 3-for-6 with a double and RBI. The Marauders will face the Tortugas at LECOM park from August 19-24.

KELLINGTON GETS GAME ONE: Right hander **Owen Kellington** will take the ball in game one of the doubleheader versus the Clearwater Threshers. After undergoing Tommy John Surgery in 2024, Kellington made his return to the mound in June with three rehab outings with the FCL Pirates. Kellington was activated by the Marauders on July 12 when he tossed 2.1 innings versus the St. Lucie Mets. Over three outings with the Marauders, Kellington has fanned eight hitters and walked just two over 8.1 innings (4 ER). Tonight marks his first game started since 2023 when he made 18 starts and tossed a career-high 80 innings for the Marauders in 2023 (3.94 ERA). The 2023 fourth-round pick mixes in a four-seamer (91 mph), curveball (78.2 mph), changeup (84.5 mph) and slider (81.5 mph).

MUETH IN GAME TWO: Pirates No. 12 prospect **Zander Mueth** is set to start game two of the twin bill for the Marauders. Mueth is set to make his eleventh start of the season with Bradenton, and seventh since being activated off the injured list. Last Saturday vs Dunedin, he tossed 0.2 innings while allowing one run. The righty threw 34 pitches in the first and walked three before the Marauders went to the bullpen. Throughout the year, Mueth has struggled with his command, having walked 19 hitters over 18 innings. However, he has done a tremendous job of pitching with traffic as he's limited opponents to a .208 average with runners in scoring position. This season, right-handed hitters have struggled to find the barrel against Mueth, as they're batting just .150 with one extra-base hits against him. He features a sinker (94.1 mph), slider (83.9 mph), and changeup (86.7 mph).

TONY TATORS: Pirates No. 21 prospect (MLB Pipeline) **Tony Blanco Jr.** demolished his first Single-A homer last night in the bottom of the sixth inning on Wednesday night after sending a fastball 415 feet to left field, that cleared the confines of LECOM Park. The ball left his bat at 118.9 miles per hour, marking the hardest-hit ball in Single-A this season, clearing the next closest batted ball by 4.4 mph. Only five batted balls at the Major-League level have been hit harder this season. He joins Oneil Cruz (3) and Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (2) on the list. Only him and Cruz (122.9 mph) have left the yard with such batted ball quality. He was activated and assigned to Single-A Bradenton on Saturday, July 19 at Jupiter.. Blanco began the season on the injured list and just completed a two-game rehab assignment with the FCL Pirates where he went 1-for-6 with a home run. In 30 FCL games last year, Blanco Jr. batted .305 and slugged .505 with four homers. His father Tony Blanco played 62 big-league games for the Washington Nationals in 2005 and spent eight seasons in the Nippon Professional Baseball League in Japan.

MARAUDERS MASHERS: The Bradenton Marauders return from the All-Star Break as one of the best home-run hitting teams in all of Class-A. Their 82 longballs this season are tied for the most in the Florida State League and Class-A (San Jose - California League). 126 of their 456 total runs have been generated via the long ball (27.6%). They're 29-23 when leaving the yard at least once, and 17-28 when not homering at all. They've seen four players launch 9+ home runs this season, more than any other team in the FSL (**A. Plaz**, **Y. De Los Santos**, **K. Griffin**, **J. Severino**)

BURNING THE BASE PATHS: **Yordany De Los Santos** stole his 40th stolen base of the season on Friday, adding to a career-best mark (34 between FCL/Single-A in 2024). In the process, he passed **Jesus Castillo** (2023), for the most single-season stolen bases by a Marauder in franchise history. He ranks first in the Florida State League and seventh in Single-A. Moreover, he sits only behind **Konnor Griffin** (44) for the most swipes in the Pittsburgh Pirates system. They are the ninth and tenth 40+ stolen-base seasons in Pirates-MilB history. The two are approaching **Rich Thompson** for the most in a season by a Pirates minor leaguer when he stole 58 in 2005 between Double-A Altoona and Triple-A Indianapolis.

- Returns to Bradenton in 2025 for his second season as manager of the club
