ABOUT LAST NIGHT: OF **Alex Ramirez** hit a go-ahead grand slam in the top of the ninth inning to give Brooklyn a 9-7 lead and victory to clinch the series. Ramirez finished 2-for-5 with five RBIs and has driven in 10 over his first two games of the series. The game featured four lead changes. Brooklyn trailed 2-0 and 6-4. OF **Rowdey Jordan** finished with two hits and two RBIs. C **Jose Mena** homered against Phillies No. 1 prospect RHP **Andrew Painter**. RHP **Dylan Hall** earned the save, stranding the bases loaded in the bottom of the ninth.

RA-RA FOR RAMIREZ: OF **Alex Ramirez** has destroyed Jersey Shore pitching in this series. The 19-year-old has a double, two home runs, and 10 RBIs, going 6-for-10.

CRACKIN' CLAWS: The Cyclones have won 15 of 20 against the Phillies High-A club, compiling a few of their best head-to-head stats vs. a North opponent. Brooklyn is averaging 4.8 runs per game with a .689 OPS. On the mound, Brooklyn arms have recorded a 2.82 team ERA in 20 games.

CON SWAGGER: OF **Stanley Consuegra** has had a dominant start to his Brooklyn career, collecting eight doubles, one triple, and two home runs in 14 games with 10 RBIs.

PEROZA POP: INF **Jose Peroza** has collected 35 total bases in his past 18 games with five doubles, one triple, and three home runs.

CARSON COLLECTS 11 Ks: RHP **Carson Seymour** struck out 11 batters last Friday night against Greensboro, becoming the ninth pitcher in Brooklyn Cyclones history to fan 11 batters. It's the first time a Cyclones arm has struck out 11 hitters since 2016 when LHP **Thomas Szapucki** achieved the feat on August 6th at Tri-City. That year, three Cyclones struck out 11 batters between July 23-August 6: RHP

vs. JERSEY SHORE: The Philadelphia Phillies High-A farm club has the worst record in the league at 31-57 which is also one of the worst records in MiLB. Brooklyn has won 15 of the 20 games of the season series. The BlueClaws are home to eight of the Top 30 Prospects in the Philadelphia system. No. 1 RHP Andrew Painter and No. 2 RHP Mick Abel lead the pitchers while No. 6 OF Ethan Wilson leads the position players.

Nabil Crismatt vs. Aberdeen, RHP **Harol Gonzalez** at Vermont, and LHP **Thomas Szapucki** at Tri-City.

BOMBOSAS: Since the May 22nd doubleheader against Hudson Valley where the Cyclones blasted five home runs across two games in Coney Island, Brooklyn has turned around its power at the plate. The Cyclones have run into 46 home runs in the past 55 games after just seven over the team's first 34 games.

PROSPECT POP: Brooklyn is home to seven of the Mets Top 30 prospects, according to MLB Pipeline. Offensively, OF **Alex Ramirez** ranks as the No. 4 prospect along with No. 14 OF **Jaylen Palmer**, No. 19 prospect 1B **JT Schwartz**, and No. 29 prospect INF **Jose Peroza**. On the mound Brooklyn hosts No. 9 RHP **Dominic Hamel**, No. 16 prospect RHP **Junior Santos**, and No. 21 prospect **Mike Vasil**.

CONGRATS FELLAS: RHP **Garrison Bryant** and C **Matt O'Neill** were both promoted to Double-A Binghamton. In two corresponding moves, the Mets promoted C **Juan Loyo** and INF **Gregory Guerrero** from Low-A St. Lucie. Guerrero is the nephew of Vladimir Guerrero and the cousin of Vladdy Jr.

MLB DRAFT: This past week the Mets selected 22 new players in the 2022 MLB Draft, including five picks in the Top 90. The Mets selected No. 11 C **Kevin Parada** from Georgia Tech and No. 14 SS **Jett Williams** from Rockwall-Heath High School in Texas.

PUNCHIES: Zwack struck out 10 on July 6 against Aberdeen, becoming the first Cyclones pitcher to collect 10 strikeouts since Kyle Wilson on August 10, 2018 against the Connecticut Tigers in Coney Island.

SWEET STRIKEOUT SUCCESS: Zwack tossed just 12 2/3 innings with Low-A St. Lucie, making two starts and two other relief appearances, striking out 24 batters. The southpaw's strikeout rate was 46% in the Florida State League with a 3.8% walk rate.

YEAR ONE: After his draft selection mid-summer in 2021, Zwack reported to Florida to pitch for the Complex team, making five relief appearances with 13 strikeouts and two walks over just seven total frames.

BIG EAST BEST: Zack earned Big East Conference First-Team accolades after his 2021 campaign for the Xavier Musketeers, tossing a team-high 80 innings. He finished his Xavier career with the 12th-most wins in team history (15) and the sixth-most strikeouts in school history (214).

X MARKS THE SPOT: Xavier has been involved with two Hall of Famers -- Frank Robinson who spent 21 years in the Major Leagues with Cincinnati, Baltimore, Los Angeles (NL), California, and Cleveland. Robinson enrolled in Xavier after his first MLB season. On the pitching side, Jim Bunning, who pitched 591 games in the big leagues, represents the most famous arm out of the small Cincinnati college.

MINNESOTA! The left hails from Monticello, Minnesota where he played baseball, hockey, and was the quarterback on his high school football team. He is the only player from his high school -- Monticello High School - to ever play professional baseball.
