# Visalia Rawhide (23-31)

RANCHO CUCAMONGA QUAKES (25-28)





LHP Wilkin Paredes (0-2, 6.75 ERA) vs. LHP Garrett McDaniels (0-4, 3.61 ERA)

**TONIGHT'S GAME:** Welcome to LoanMart Field for game five of a six-game series, as your Quakes host the Visalia Rawhide (Arizona). The Quakes will transform into the Rancho Cucamonga BBQ's, with special jerseys and caps, as we celebrate the joy and passion of a summer time BBQ with family and friends, while taking in a baseball game! Fans will also enjoy a post-game Fireworks Show tonight! Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

VS THE RAWHIDE: Today's game is the 11th of 30 meetings between the two clubs in 2024 and the fifth of 15 at LoanMart Field. The Quakes are 6-4 against the Rawhide in 2024, 2-2 here at home. Last season, the Quakes went 17-13 against the Rawhide, 7-5 here at home.

**LAST GAME:** Logan Wagner smashed a grand slam and the bullpen gave the Quakes five solid innings in relief, as Rancho held on to defeat Visalia on Friday night, 8-4 in front of more than 4,400 fans at LoanMart Field. The Quakes trailed 3-0, but scored the game's next eight runs. Wagner's slam and second homer of the year proved to be the game-winner, as Rancho took the lead for good against Denny Larrondo (2-2) in the third. Felix Cabrera (1-1), Callum Wallace and Christian Ruebeck combined to allow just one unearned run over five innings. Rancho starter Christian Zazueta got touched for three runs in the first, but settled in to give the Quakes four innings in his Cal League debut. The Quakes ended a two-game skid with the win, marking just their second home win in 11 games. **GO GRANNY:** The Quakes have clubbed two grand slams in 2024, with Logan Wagner collecting the second in last night's win over the Rawhide. Rancho's other slam was on April 28 in a win at home over Lake Elsinore.

**EXTRA:** The Quakes played in just one extra-inning game over the course of their first 43 games. They would go on to play three over a four-day stretch last week in Lake Elsinore, and they've now played in five extra-inning games after Thursday night's loss in 10. The Quakes have lost all five games, holding a tenth-inning lead in two of them.

APRIL 12: On April 12, the Quakes started the day in second place in the South Division. With a win that night over Stockton, the Quakes moved into first and remained there until Friday night's game went final. That stretch came to an end last Friday in Lake Elsinore, as the Quakes were knocked from first place after their fourth straight loss to the Storm. Now, with just 12 games to play in the first half, the Quakes trail Lake Elsinore by three games. Rancho's last 12 games of the first half will be at home against Visalia (3), on the road at Fresno (6), then finishing at home with Inland Empire (3). The Storm are at Inland Empire (3), home against Stockton (6) and then at Visalia (3) to end the half. **GARRETT MCDANIELS:** Garrett McDaniels makes his 11th appearance and seventh start of the year, his second appearance and first start against Visalia. In his lone game against Visalia, he allowed one run on six hits over four relief innings in a no-decision on May 10. In his last outing, last Sunday at Lake Elsinore, he suffered the tough-luck loss after allowing two runs on five hits over five innings. McDaniels signed with the Dodgers as an undrafted free agent in 2023 out of Mount Olive College in North Carolina.

WILKIN PAREDES: Lefty Wilkin Paredes makes his fourth start of the year for the Rawhide and first against the Quakes. Parades opened the year in the ACL and went 2-0 over two starts, allowing just one run over eight innings. In his last outing overall, he allowed seven runs (six earned) on nine hits over 4.1 innings in a no-decision against Inland Empire on June 1. Paredes was signed to an international free agent contract in January, 2023, out of the Dominican Republic, but did not debut until this year.
