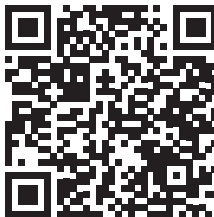

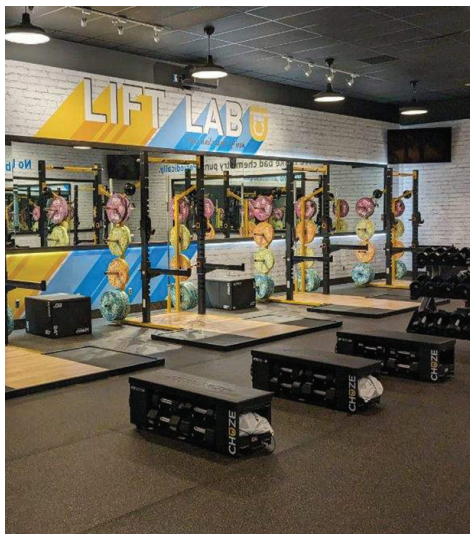

When you think of the word ambition, your mind should immediately shift to Maximo Acosta. This shortstop hailing from South America has continued to improve with every season he secures under his belt. His career in baseball since coming to America has come with lots of changes, injuries, and uncertainties. Where some players would be hesitant, Acosta has also welcomed the change with a positive attitude and lots of gratitude.

Acosta began his American baseball career signing with the Texas Rangers' organization at the early age of 16. There in Texas, he built a home with the team and the Rangers' organization.

He spent the 2024 season, playing for the Double-A Frisco RoughRiders for his fourth season in the mi-

nors. That season he hit eight home runs and only struck out 58 times out of 433 plate appearances. He slashed .288/.353/.425, recording his best stats thus far in the league.

On December 11, 2024, Acosta was traded to the Miami Marlins organization. This abrupt trade after he spent so much time in the Texas Ranger's organization took Maximo by surprise as he had just completed his most successful season thus far.

"I am grateful with this team," Acosta said. "They traded for me because they saw something special in me."

Of course, this trade was more than just changing teams and the number on his jersey. Acosta had established his life in the United States in Texas and in the Rangers organization over the last six years. Moving his life, family and career to Florida was not a simple task as it was a huge adjustment for him to move somewhere and not know anyone. "It's really weird but I just need to figure it out." Acosta moved to Jacksonville with his wife and one year old son, Maximo Junior.

Acosta has already learned so much from his new team including how to speak English. He completed his first English interview with Jumbo Shrimp broadcaster Scott Kornberg. How did he pick up English so quickly after joining the Jumbo Shrimp organization? Acosta strongly believes in supporting his team and encouraging them to improve themselves on

the field and off. He applied this mentality towards his learning of English. When speaking to other players he encourages them to speak in English, so he can improve his speaking and comprehension of the English language.

As a lifelong shortstop, who else for Acosta to look up to as a role model in the game than Hall of Famer and arguably the most iconic shortstop in baseball history Derek Jeter. Jeter has been his role model since he was a young boy. What sticks out the most to Acosta about Jeter is his personality. "He is human, humble, a leader and a captain not just on the field but off the field too." He considers him to be his hero and has since he was a young boy. Acosta strives to be like Jeter in his own dugout. When asked what three words he would use to describe himself, he replied, "winner, patient and humble." He went on to explain that being a winner is not about personal success in a game, but about the team as a whole. "If my team wins, I am happy." Of course, Acosta still recognizes and celebrates his personal wins, his most notable thus far, occurred this season when he hit a walk off against the Charlotte Knights on April 13th.

Another substantial influence in Acosta's life is his faith in God. His walk-up song in home games is

Praise by Brandon Lake in Spanish. When asked about his song choice his face lit up with excitement and pride. He described it as a "song of praise." He was inspired to choose the song by his friends at Church who suggested the worship song to him. He continues glorifying God when approaching the batter's box by drawling a "D" in the clay for "Dios" which is "God" in Spanish.

Acosta is a confident and humble player who brings more to the Jumbo Shrimp than just his athletic abilities. He brings a strong presence of leadership and confidence into the dugout.

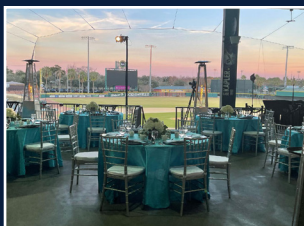

JACKSONVILLE JUMBO SHRIMP**







Bragan Field at VyStar Ballpark, which opened in 2003, is one of the premier Minor League ballparks in North America.

The ballpark was the first completed project of the Better Jacksonville Plan. Featuring an old-fashioned design, brick facade and a grass seating berm, VyStar Ballpark reminds fans of the days of yesteryear and preserves all of the wonderful tradition baseball has to offer. The vivid sight lines capture the action up-close while providing fans with comfortable seating and easy access to concessions and restrooms.

VyStar Ballpark features 12 luxury skyboxes, four skydecks, and a one-of-a-kind Tiki Terrace at the left field corner. It also has an HD videoboard and LED fence display in left field and two ribbon displays along the baselines of the suite level.

In 2016, owner Ken Babby invested \$1.8 million into the ballpark to add a new groups area directly behind the home bullpen, a Tiki Terrace near the left-field foul pole, renovations to all 12 private suites and expansion of the suite-level, third-floor lounge to give all fans a climate-controlled space to overlook the playing field.

In conjunction with the City of Jacksonville and ASM Global, the Jumbo Shrimp announced in 2024 a \$31.8 million publicly-funded renovation plan to VyStar Ballpark as part of Project NEXT. The project added a new office structure and seating experience in right field, a new fan-friendly main gate in center field and a new premium space area behind Homeplate. Project NEXT is the first major renovation to the ballpark since its opening in 2003.

The ballpark features nearly 6,000 stadium-style chairs and had accommodated more than 11,000 fans. Ballpark is also completely wheelchair accessible, including the dugouts, camera wells and playing field.

The ballpark has hosted three Major League Baseball exhibitions (2006, 2010, 2015), four ACC Baseball Tournaments (2006-09) and two Southern League All-Star games (2003, 2013). The 2013 Southern League All-Star game boasted a league-record 9,373 fans in attendance.

Since 2007, VyStar Ballpark has hosted a game in the annual college baseball series between in-state rivals, Florida State and Florida. The annual installment brings capacity crowds to VyStar Ballpark for their storied rivalry.

When Janson Junk received the news that he was being traded in 2021 from the New York Yankees to the Los Angeles Angels, he could not help but think of everything he had accomplished while being a part of the Yankees farm system. At the time of the trade, Junk was pitching for the Somerset Patriots, the Double-A affiliate of the New York Yankees. The Federal Way, Washington native was in the midst of the best season of his career. At the time, Junk had started 12 games, pitching to an ERA of 1.78 in 65.2 innings on the mound. He struck out 68 while walking 20, securing four wins in the process.

When the deal was made, Junk experienced his first major change since becoming a professional pitcher. A player can often struggle with a change like that, but Junk had a different outlook. The right-hander stayed optimistic, focusing on the relationships he made, rather than the stress of joining a new organization. For Junk, the most important relationship was with his pitching coach Daniel Moskos, who made being traded to the Angels a “bittersweet” moment.

“I created such good relationships with the guys, and our big-league pitching coach Daniel Moskos was my Double-A pitching coach with the Yankees during that time,” said Junk. “He made a big impact with me during that year, I really leveled up my game around him, being under his guidance.”

For Junk, the 2025 offseason was uncharted territory for the 29-year-old right-hander. For the first time in his career, Junk was a free agent, and he had the opportunity to make his own decision on where he wanted to take his talents next. A lot of elements can affect a player’s decisions on where to continue his career. Money, location, and competitiveness are all common reasons, though Junk’s decision to sign with the Marlins was because of one main factor: relationships.

“It was my first free agency in my career, and I thought with the relationships I’ve had in the past with the big-league pitching coach (Moskos), bullpen coach, and minor league pitching coach, it made my decision easier,” said Junk.

Junk has pitched for six different organizations and has logged over 600 innings on the mound. He's been traded and claimed off waivers twice and designated for assignment three times. For someone who has not cracked the age of 30, that's a lot of transactions. A notable time when Junk changed organizations was when he was traded from the Los Angeles Angels to the Milwaukee Brewers on November 22, 2022.

Over 170 of Junk's career innings occurred with the Nashville Sounds, Triple-A affiliate of the Brewers. He appeared in 55 games between 2023 and 2024, starting 28 of them. While he made seven appearances with the big league, Junk's tenure ended on a sour note when he was designated for assignment on July 28, 2024 and claimed by the Houston Astros. It did not get any easier for him, as he was DFA'd again a month later and claimed by the Oakland Athletics. When something like that occurs, a player has every right to be frustrated and bitter about their situation. Putting hours or work into your craft for an organization that inevitably lets you go can make a player lose sight of what is important.

When Junk returned to Nashville for the Jumbo Shrimp's opening weekend series against the Sounds, he wasn't bitter about no longer being in Tennessee. He found pleasure in seeing those who he has built relationships with have success in the game of baseball.

"When I went to Nashville, it was great to see people I've been with, the staff and stuff so that is always fun to see them flourishing around the league," said Junk.

At the end of the day, Junk is relatable. He was selected in the 22nd round of the 2017 draft, a round that no longer exists. He never was a top prospect when he was with the Yankees. As soon as he began to find his footing in Somerset, he was shipped off to the Angels for a pitcher who accumulated a WAR of -0.5 and had an ERA of 7.32 in the Bronx. Despite being drafted nearly a decade ago, he's only totaled 40.0 innings in the majors. Yet through all the organizational changes, Junk has never lost sight of the people he's bonded with along the way. Junk's career is a reminder to filter out the negatives, build strong relationships, and stay optimistic.
