The 23-year-old made his Double-A debut at home against Bowie last Tuesday morning and tossed five scoreless innings with six strikeouts, while allowing three hits and two walks. Sproat currently ranks fourth in all of Minor League Baseball, among pitchers with at least 30 innings pitched, with an 0.89 ERA across two levels, in his first professional season. Over seven appearances and six starts across High-A Brooklyn and Double-A Binghamton, Sproat has allowed just three earned runs. The 2023 second round pick has allowed three hits or fewer in every appearance this season.

NOTES

**MCLEAN MADNESS:** Mets No. 19 prospect **Nolan McLean** has been promoted to Double-A Binghamton. McLean is a two-way player and is slated to make his Double-A hitting debut on Tuesday and pitching debut on Wednesday. The 22-year-old was 2-2 with a 2.57 ERA, 1.07 WHIP, and 36 strikeouts over 28 innings across seven starts as a pitcher for High-A Brooklyn this season. He also played in 25 games as the Cyclones' designated hitter and hit .224 with an .849 OPS, seven doubles, five home runs, and 13 runs batted in. Over his last five starts on the mound for Brooklyn, the McLean was 2-1 with a 0.82 ERA. He recorded 30 strikeouts and allowed just two earned runs over 22 innings pitched in his last five starts. As a hitter, he led the Cyclones with five home runs and a .552 slugging percentage, which ranked sixth in the South Atlantic League among players with 70+ plate appearances. McLean was drafted by the Mets in the third round (91st overall pick) of the 2023 MLB Draft out of Oklahoma State.

**ALL'S WELL WITH TIDWELL:** Mets No. 2 pitching prospect Blade Tidwell has been promoted to Triple-A Syracuse. Tidwell held a 2.41 ERA over his first seven appearances with Binghamton this season. Here's how the 22-year-old ranked among Eastern League pitching at the time of his promotion: T-4th in SO (44), 7th in ERA (2.41), 7th in WHIP (1.07), T-13th in IP (37.1).

**RIDING WITH RHYLAN:** Mets No. 30 prospect Rhylan Thomas has been promoted to Triple-A Syracuse. Thomas hit .323 with eight doubles and 13 runs batted in over 25 games with Binghamton this season. At the time of his promotion, Thomas ranked third in the Eastern League in batting average and top 10 in doubles. He hit .359 with five runs batted in over his final 10 games with the Ponies. Thomas was the Mets Minor League Gold Glove Outfielder last season.

**LAST TIME DUT:** The Binghamton Rumble Ponies beat the Bowie Baysox, 5-3, in the series finale at Mirabito Stadium on Sunday afternoon. With the game tied 3-3 in the eighth inning, **Jaylen Palmer** hit a go-ahead two-run home run. **Kevin Parada** hit his team-leading fifth home run.

**NATIVE NEW YORKER:** Brooklyn native **Jaylen Palmer** hit a go-ahead two-run homer in the eighth inning on Sunday against Bowie, to propel Binghamton to the victory. It marked his second homer of the season. Palmer has at least one hit in five of his last six games. Over his last six games, the 23-year-old is hitting .353 with a .500 on-base percentage, 1.324 OPS, two homers, four runs batted in, two doubles, and five walks. Palmer was drafted by the Mets in 2018 out of Holy Cross High School in Flushing, which is about five miles from Citi Field.

LAST START: Sproat struck out six batters over five scoreless innings in his Double-A debut last Tuesday morning against Bowie at home...He allowed just three hits and two walks...Sproat retired the first eight batters he faced.

**2024 SEASON:** First professional season...Began the season with High-A Brooklyn...Made professional debut on April 9 against Asheville and threw 2.2 scoreless innings with five strikeouts...Made six appearances and five starts for the Cyclones and went 2-1 with a 1.07 ERA and 33 strikeouts over 25.1 innings...Did not allow more than three hits in any outing with Brooklyn and only allowed a combined three earned runs over six appearances, spanning 25.1 innings...Among pitchers with 25.0+ innings pitched, Sproat ranked third in the South Atlantic League in ERA and fifth in batting average against (.141).

LAST SEASON: Went 8-3 with a 4.66 ERA and 134 strikeouts over 106.1 innings in 19 starts at the University of Florida...Started Game One of the College World Series Finals against LSU and allowed two runs over four innings with seven strikeouts.



-Reid Brignac (pronounced Brin-yac) is coming off leading the Rumble Ponies to the postseason last season, for the first time since 2017. In 2023, under Brignac's tutelage, the Ponies went on a second-half surge, going 39-27 overall and 17-5 over their last 22 games. Brignac's team swept the Somerset Patriots in the Eastern League Division Series to lead the Ponies to the ELCS before falling to Erie.

-In 2022, he led a team that saw five players make their major league debut with the Mets after starting the season with the Rumble Ponies, tying a Binghamton franchise record (Francisco Álvarez, Brett Baty, José Butto, Nate Fisher, and Bryce Montes de Oca). He was initially drafted by the Rays in the second round of the 2004 MLB Draft, out of St. Amant High School.

-AJ Sager was named the 2023 New York Mets Minor League Staff Member of the Year for his efforts last year. Sager's pitching staff in 2023 set a Binghamton franchise record with 15 shutouts and took home five Eastern League honors, highlighted by Mike Vasil winning Eastern League Pitcher of the Month for May and Dom Hamel being named EL Pitcher of the Month for September. Sager's staff also ranked first among the 30 Double-A clubs in strike rate and walks issued, and second in opponent on-base percentage. On September 7 at Hartford, right-hander Joander Suarez threw the eighth no-hitter in franchise history, facing the minimum 21 batters over seven innings.

-Sager previously spent 20 years coaching in the Detroit Tigers organization and pitched for parts of five seasons in the major leagues, playing for the San Diego Padres, Colorado Rockies, and Tigers as part of a 12-year professional career. In 123 major league appearances, the right-hander was 12-15, with five saves and a 5.36 ERA. Sager was originally drafted by the Padres in the 10th round of the 1988 MLB Draft, out of the University of Toledo.
