LAST GAME

The Bowie Baysox had their losing streak extend to five-consecutive games on Tuesday night, as they dropped the opener of their six-game series with the Harrisburg Senators. A back-and-forth affair, Harrisburg took the early lead with three runs in the first inning, before Bowie used two home runs to jump ahead 4-3. Harrisburg took the lead in the fifth inning with a two-run home run, and Bowie immediately tied the game in the home half of the frame. As the tie game stretched, Harrisburg took the final lead with a solo home run in the eighth inning. Gunnar Henderson collected his fourth home run of the season with a three-run shot off the batters' eye, and J.D. Mundy hit one to the same spot for his second of the year, a solo shot.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Senators had held the top spot in the Eastern League's Southwest Division for most of April, but enter the first series in May tied for second place behind Richmond. A team mostly lead by its pitching staff, Harrisburg has the third best team ERA in the league at the start of this series, at 3.59, as well as the fewest home runs allowed in the league, at just 16. They also sport one of the best closers in the league, as Matt Brill has already collected seven saves and a win in his nine appearances. The Senators sport one of the oldest rosters in the league with an average age around 25.5 years old.

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-handed pitcher Richard Guasch enters his first full season in the Nationals organization after being traded from Oakland in the Yan Gomes/Josh Harrison deal. Since the deal, Guasch has impressed with a 3.15 ERA in High-A Wilmington last season and a 3.66 ERA through four starts this season in Harrisburg. In his last two starts, Guasch has earned the win while giving up one earned run in 11 2/3 innings pitched, striking out a combined 12 Fighting Phils & Yard Goats. Guasch's last outing of 2021 was against Aberdeen, giving up two earned runs over four innings. He struck out seven IronBirds in that game.

SOME GOOD TEAMS

It is a rare sight to see Bowie go on losing streaks that stretch to five games. Since the 2018 season, Bowie has only gone on losing streaks of five or more games three times, twice in 2019, and once in 2021, from 6/18-6/25. Notably, Bowie made it to the League's Championship Series in both seasons. The three previous losing skids all extended to exactly seven games before being snapped.

TOP GUNNAR

Infielder Gunnar Henderson went 3-for-4 at the plate yesterday, extending his on-base streak to 21-consecutive games, the best mark in the Eastern League this season. Henderson also has 21 walks on the year, second-most in the League. Gunnar has increased his walk rate from just 12.1% across three levels played last season up to 24.7% so far this season. Henderson is ranked as the Orioles #3 prospect and Minor League Baseball's #64 overall prospect entering the 2022 season according to MLB Pipeline. Listed as #4 for the Orioles and #57 in MiLB by Baseball America. He was named the Orioles Organization All-Star at third base by MiLB.com for his 2021 season.

PULL AWAY EARLY

Bowie has ran into plenty of trouble this season in the middle of their games. Bowie has only scored four runs in the fifth inning all season, the lowest tally in the League. Their -17 run differential in the frame is understandably their worst in any inning this season, and is the worst in the Eastern League in the fifth inning. Things don't get much better in the sixth inning, as Bowie has only scored six runs in the sixth, the third-fewest, and allowed 17 runs, the second-most.

SLIM MARGINS

Bowie had an early handle on one-run games this season, as they won three of their first four games decided by one run, but have dropped their last three close contests. The Southwest Division stands to see plenty of tight games this season, as all six teams have played at least six games decided by one run. Richmond currently leads the pack at 5-3, including a pair of one-run wins against Bowie last week during their current five-game skid.

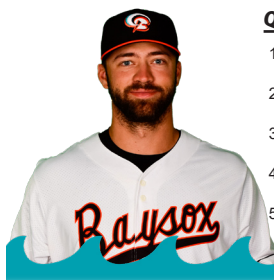

Notes

- Gained 27 pounds between the start of spring training and Opening Day. "Just eating and lifting. Starting to focus now on making some muscle out of it"
- Picked up tips on his changeup from Orioles starter John Means when Means made a rehab start with Bowie in 2021: "I was kind of like the little kid, just nervous to talk to him. Eventually I got the nuts to ask him about his changeup. He was the nicest, most genuine guy. He told me how he throws it, how he grips it. He was awesome about it."
- Closed 2021 with 13 consecutive scoreless innings for Bowie after allowing at least one earned run in each of his previous seven outings, including all of his outings with Bowie.
- In 2021, Aberdeen averaged eight runs in games Drew appeared in, while Bowie only averaged 5.8 runs in the same games
- Major contributor for manager Kyle Moore with the Delmarva Shorebirds in 2019. Team finished with a 90-48 record, the best in Minor League Baseball. Rom was one of eight Shorebirds named to the South Atlantic League All-Star Game.

What They're Saying:

Matt Blood, Orioles Dir. of Player Development: "He throws a lot of strikes. He's deceptive, he's an uncomfortable at-bat for hitters and he's still pretty young, so we're excited about that."

MLB Pipeline: "Lean and projectable, Rom hides the ball well by creating deception with his 6-foot-2 frame. He releases from a three-quarters arm slot and uses his long stride and crossfire finish to create good extension, which allows his pitches to play up and miss barrels consistently. He is comfortable throwing either off-speed pitch in fastball counts as well as mixing up arm angles; he couples this unpredictability with a quick pace and moderate effort delivery that projects durability."

Baseball America: "Rom hasn't yet developed a standout pitch, but a varied mix and precocious pitchability have helped him carve up hitters at every level. He experimented with dropping his arm slot against lefties to create different action on his two-seam fastball. Rom knows how the pitches play off one another, and pitches backwards while taking advantage of his deception and angles."

Notes by Outing

- Apr 8 v RIC** Bowie's Opening Day starter, was peppered with base hits over his three innings, six singles. Allowed three single over the first two innings, but did not allow a runner to reach third base. Once he reached the second trip through the order, Richmond started with two singles and two walks to eventually score three runs.
- Apr 14 @ BNG** Five shutout frames versus the Ponies, with his only hiccup coming in the second inning, where he allowed a pair of base hits and a walk to load the bases with only one out. Those three baserunners were the only three he allowed all day.
- Apr 21 v AKR** Retired 12 of the first 13 batters faced. Only baserunner was a two-out infield single in the first inning. First inning was also hampered by reaching a three-ball count on each of the first three batters. Left midway through the fifth inning after allowing the first three batters to reach on a walk and two singles. Bowie won with a walk-off in the tenth inning.
- Apr 28 @ RIC** Gave up a string of five-consecutive base hits with one out in the first inning, allowing three runs to score. Labored through lengthy plate appearances for the following two innings, including stranding the bases loaded in the second inning. Only finished three innings.
