GAME RECAP:

The Reading Fightin Phils shutout the Altoona Curve 9-0 for a Thursday night victory. Every-one in the starting nine reached successfully for the R-Phils. Ethan Wilson launched his first Double-A homer while a five-run fourth really sealed the victory for the Fightins. Five pitchers combined for shutout frames with ten strikeouts and just one walk.

SHUTOUT CITY:

The Fightins shutout the Curve last night for their eleventh shutout win of the season. The night prior Reading was shutout themselves for the ninth time of the season last night recording just five hits and one walk. Baseball is weird.

ARIZONA FALL LEAGUE:

The R-Phils will send a squad of players to compete for the Surprise Saguaros in the prestigious Arizona Fall League. Relievers Taylor Lehman (LHP) and Brett Schulze (RHP) are coming off Tommy John surgery so the 90-game season will give them some extra innings. Francisco Morales will join them after making his Phillies debut this season and getting the promotion to Triple-A. Outfielders Johan Rojas, Carlos De La Cruz, and Jhailyn Ortiz will be accompanied by High-A hitting coach Jake Elmore in Arizona.

TEAM AT BATS:

Reading recorded three sacrifice fly balls in the series so far, two from Carlos De La Cruz and one off the bat of Kevin Vicuna. This totals 36 on the season, putting them in the top half of the Eastern League in that category. Aldrem Corredor and Wendell Rijo have four apiece. The R-Phils also do well notching sac bunts with an Eastern League leading 27 for the summer. Jonathan Guzman leads the way with eight laid down successfully.

HIGH STRIKEOUTS:

This summer the Fightins set a new season-high strikeout count with a current total of 1,285. Starters have compiled 543 K's while relievers have recorded 744 strikeouts. In 2019, the Reading Fightin Phils rewrote the record books with 1,271 total strikeouts recorded to set the league record. 642 were by starters and 629 were by relievers. It has since been rebroken twice by Akron, including this season with over 1,300.

BIG LEAGUE CLUB WATCH:

The Phillies fell to the Marlins 5-3 despite outhitting them 8-7. Bryson Stott had two hits, while Brandon Marsh had four. The team moves to 80-63 for third in the NL East but 2.5 games up on a wild caard spot. The Phillies have an off day before taking on Atlanta at Truist Park. They play their next 7 of 9 games against the Braves.

ON THIS DAY IN BASEBALLTOWN HISTORY:

September 16, 1972: At Veterans Stadium in Philadelphia, Mike Schmidt hits his first Major League home run, a three-run shot in the 7th inning that lifts the Phillies past Montreal, 3-1. Schmidt had been a shortstop in Reading just a season before.
