CARTER HITS GRAND SLAM, RIDERS WIN IN BLOWOUT FOR FOURTH WIN IN A ROW:

Evan Carter's go-ahead grand slam highlighted a season-high six home runs for the Frisco RoughRiders in a 19-10 victory over the Wichita Wind Surge at Riverfront Stadium on Wednesday. **Thomas Saggese** had the first go-ahead home run for Frisco, smashing a fly ball off the scoreboard to score two runs. The Wind Surge claimed a 3-2 lead in the bottom of the first but Carter's grand slam in the second inning gave Frisco the lead for good. Carter's slam was his first of the season and the ninth by RoughRiders hitters. To set the table for Carter, Chris Seise singled through the right side and Jax Biggers and Acuña walked. Frisco extended the lead with five runs in the fourth inning, all with two outs, highlighted by Saggese's two-run single and Hauver's RBI double. The Riders tacked on a run in the fifth inning when Biggers walked, advanced to third on an errant pickoff, and scored on a wild pitch. Frisco scored seven runs in the ninth, with Acuña and Hauver's homers both for two runs. Acuña's homer was his fourth hit of the day with two singles, a double plus a walk. Carter also doubled in the inning for his second hit of the day. Saggese and Hauver both had three hits including a home run, Hatcher and Kapers both had two hits with a homer, and Seise chipped in a single and a double. The top four hitters in Frisco's order all scored three times and all nine starters scored for the second straight game.

A DAY TO REMEMBER:

The RoughRiders set multiple season highs in their 19-10 win over the Wind Surge. Their 19 runs, 19 hits and six home runs were all season bests while it was also the longest game of the season at three hours and 31 minutes. In the ninth inning, Frisco went back-to-back-to-back for the first time this season (**Trevor Hauver, Josh Hatcher** and **Scott Kapers**).

WINNING IS FUN:

Frisco has won the first two games in Wichita by a combined score of 29-14, and have scored 41 runs in the last four games. Frisco has won all four to equal a season-long winning streak. Over the last four games, the Riders have hit seven home runs and hit .314/.390/.536/.926 as a team.

GENTLEMEN, START YOUR ENGINES:

The RoughRiders have struggled on the starting pitching side of things this season. This year, Frisco has a 6.23 starting pitcher ERA which is the highest in recorded franchise history (dating back to 2005) and last in the Texas League. Including Anderson, they have used 17 different starting pitchers, more than the 14 they used all season in 2022 and just under the 19 they used the whole year in 2021. Frisco has not had a start of more than 5.1 innings since June 10th, when **Ryan Garcia** went seven innings. Over those 36 games since June 11th, the Riders' starters' ERA is 7.71 (108ER/126.0IP) while the bullpen has a 4.56 ERA (95ER/187.1IP). Over the 36 games, the Riders have the third-best offense in the league by OPS (.786) and have hit 37 home runs (5th in the Texas League).

HATCH IS THE RIGHT MATCH:

Since coming to Frisco in June from High-A Hickory, **Josh Hatcher** has been a run-producing machine. In his 21 games, he has driven in 24 runs and in July, Hatcher is hitting .293/.333/.500/.833 with four homers and 20 RBIs in 15 games.

WELCOME BACK, CARTER:

Evan Carter has been fantastic since returning from the Injured List on June 21st against Springfield. Over his last 28 games since his return, he has 10 multi-hit games, batting .330 (36-for-109)/.426/.596/1.022 with four doubles, two triples, seven home runs, 24 RBIs and 24 runs scored.

THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE:

Thomas Saggese has been incredible for the RoughRiders on offense. Over his last 40 games, he is hitting .350/.432/.637/1.069 with 11 home runs and 41 RBIs. The California native is currently sixth in the league in batting average (.311), second in RBIs (76), first in hits (111), fourth in doubles (21) and first in total bases (183).

AMBUSH EARLY AND OFTEN:

Thomas Saggese has been fantastic on first pitches this season, first in the Texas League (min. 11 at-bats) with a .563 average (18-for-32) when he puts the first pitch of an at-bat in play. He has a 1.463 OPS on the first pitch, which is first in the league as well. **Luisangel Acuña** has also been great, hitting .459 (28-for-61) on the initial offering while his 28 hits on the first pitch lead the league and are fourth in the minors.

SPEED KILLS:

Luisangel Acuña leads the league in steals with 41 and is on pace for a career-best 62 swipes. Acuña is on pace to set a single-season record for the Riders, as **Elvis Andrus** has the record with 54 swipes in 2008. The RoughRiders are fifth in Texas League steals with 119 bases in 142 attempts (84 percent).

ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Evan Carter** hitting Frisco's ninth grand slam of the season. They are one of two teams with at least nine grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Seven different players have accounted for the grand slams (**Liam Hicks, Luisangel Acuña, Jax Biggers, Dustin Harris, Trevor Hauver, Thomas Saggese** (3) and **Evan Carter**). On July 5th, the Riders allowed their first grand slam this year, becoming the final Texas League team to do so.

ACUÑA MATATA:

RoughRiders infielder **Luisangel Acuña** has been on fire at the plate. The Rangers No. 3 prospect has reached safely in a Riders' season-high 23 games in a row, batting .371/.435/.495/.930. He is fourth in the Texas League in batting average (.315), tied for first in hits (111), third in doubles (23), second in runs (66) and first in steals (41).

ABOUT NICK

-Went to Northgate High School in Walnut Creek, California (across the Bay from San Francisco, east of Berkeley). His senior season, he went 6-5 with a 2.20 ERA over 11 games.

-Krauth then went to the University of New Mexico for the 2018 season, where he was teammates with current RoughRiders pitcher Justin Slaten.

-After New Mexico, transferred to Diablo Valley College in Pleasant Valley, California where he went 8-4 with a 2.20 ERA. Following that strong season, he transferred again, this time to the University of Connecticut, where he was one of the best pitchers in the country for the 2020 season before it was cut short due to COVID. In his four starts, he went 4-0 with a 0.36 ERA and a .167 BAA. This included five one-run innings against the No. 1 Michigan Wolverines on February 23rd.

-Due to the 2020 MLB Draft getting shortened to five rounds, Krauth went undrafted and signed with the Rangers as a free agent on June 15th.

-Brother, Ben Krauth, pitched for the San Antonio Missions in 2022, making nine starts and recording a 7.18 ERA. In two starts against Frisco, the RoughRiders touched him up for a combined seven runs, six earned, over 7.2 innings while handing him two losses. Ben was released by the Padres organization at the end of the year and retired after six seasons of MLB experience.

2023 SEASON

-Krauth made first appearance of the season out of the bullpen on Friday, April 7th, allowing three runs over four innings.

-In his first start, Krauth went shutout five innings at San Antonio on April 14th to earn the first win among RoughRiders starting pitchers.

-Threw four scoreless innings on April 20th before game was suspended due to rain in the top of the fifth with the Riders up 9-0, ending his night early. The Riders and the Travelers went on to finish the game on April 21st with Frisco winning 13-5.

-Allowed a run in the fourth inning against Amarillo on April 26th, snapping a 14.2-consecutive innings scoreless streak dating back to April 7th.

-Joined Triple-A Round Rock on May 2nd for a spot start and make two appearances. In his start, he went 3.2 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 0 ER, 3 BB, 1 K. Allowed a grand slam to David Freitas of Oklahoma City in relief appearance.

2022 SEASON

-Spent time as both a starter and reliever, going 4-7 with a 5.38 ERA in 17 starts and 1-0, 2.25 ERA out of the bullpen.

-An extreme groundball pitcher, Krauth rolled groundballs at a 50.2% clip with the Crawdads.

2021 SEASON

-Showing his durability, Krauth led the Low-A East and the Rangers organization with 102.2 innings pitched. He also made a team-high 20 starts.

-Earned Low-A East Pitcher of the Week twice, including once for a complete-game, one-hitter on August 28th vs. Fayetteville (9.0 IP, 1 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 2 BB, 9 K).
