STORYLINES AND HEADLINES

CAPS SILENCED ON SUNDAY: The West Michigan Whitecaps took advantage of a late-inning miscue to score the go-ahead run as part of a 4-3 win over the Great Lakes Loons at Dow Diamond on Tuesday night. The 'Caps, who maintained a 3-0 lead for most of the game, demonstrated their resilience in the ninth inning. Despite being tied at three, they seized the opportunity when a wild pitch by Great Lakes reliever Michael Martinez allowed Peyton Graham to score the go-ahead run. This led to a 4-3 victory for West Michigan, marking their first win since April 10 over Quad Cities at LMCU Ballpark. Outfielder Roberto Campos opened the scoring with a two-run double down the left-field line in the first inning to help West Michigan take a 2-0 lead. Andrew Jenkins brought home a run with a double of his own in the third. The Loons had great scoring chances in the next three innings, bringing the potential tying run to the plate in all three frames but coming up empty-handed. In the eighth, the Loons finally broke through to tie the contest with three in the frame, highlighted by a pair of bloop hits from Jake Vogel and Alex Freeland to even the contest. In the ninth, the wild pitch scored Graham, leading to the victory that helped West Michigan break its four-game losing streak. 'Caps reliever Erick Pinales (1-0) allowed three unearned runs in relief in his first win of the season. 20-year-old righty Carlos Marcano got the start and tossed four scoreless innings, allowing just two hits and struck out four. Martinez (0-1) took his first loss, while West Michigan pitcher Tanner Kohlhepp tossed a perfect ninth in collecting his first save with the club. The Whitecaps record improves to 4-6, while the first-place Loons fall to 6-4. Campos reached base three times and drove in a pair of runs to lead the 'Caps in the victory.

GETTING BLANKED: The Whitecaps pitching staff collected a Midwest League-best 15 shutouts of their opponents this season, with the last one occuring on August 20 in a 5-0 win over the South Bend Cubs at LMCU Ballpark. The 'Caps also hold the Midwest League record for shutouts in a season with 27 back in 2017. They also began the 2024 season with a 2-0 blanking of the Lake County Captains at Classic Park in the first game of a doubleheader on April 7.

SWING FOR THE FENCES: The Whitecaps totaled 109 home runs last season - breaking the franchise record of 101 set in 2022.

Acquired: Drafted by the Tigers in the 9th round, (255th Overall) of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Ohio State University.

Previously a Top-30 Prospect in the Detroit Tigers farm system, the 24-year-old has done little to change his prospect status. Only the improved state of the farm system has pushed him below the cut line. Burhenn played three college seasons with the Ohio State Buckeyes, compiling a career 15-8 record with 189 punchouts through 192.2 innings, earning All-Big Ten Third Team honors his Junior season with Ohio State.

LAST GAME: Burhenn posted his second straight impressive start, allowing just one run on two hits in four innings without walking a batter and striking out five as part of a 2-1 loss to the Quad Cities River Bandits in the first game of a doubleheader on April 12 at LMCU Ballpark.

2023: Burhenn's 2023 campaign was spent in its entirety at West Michigan, where his strikeout totals dropped off to just 70 in 93.2 frames on the hill, but he appeared in a single-season high 24 games, making 18 starts.

2022: Burhenn spent most of 2022 at Low-A Lakeland, racking up 103 strikeouts in 78.2 innings while compiling a 3.43 ERA in 78.2 innings pitched, earning himself a spot in the Detroit Tigers Top-30 prospects at the time.

2021 (Junior): Earned All-Big Ten honors after a standout season, finishing 7-2 with a 3.81 ERA and 103 strikeouts to just 19 walks. Burhenn also enjoyed a complete game shutout in his home city of Indianapolis, allowing just one run while striking out a career-high 10 batters in a 3-1 victory over the Indiana Hoosiers on May 23, 2021.

2020 (Sophomore): Burhenn struggled with hard contact early, posting a 2-2 record with an 8.02 ERA in the COVID-shortened season. However, he maintained a walk-to-strikeout ratio of 25-to-1 (ranked third in the BIG 10) while also compiling 29 strikeouts in just four games pitched.

2019 (Freshman): Earned Big Ten All-Freshman Team after going 6-4 with a 3.96 ERA in 15 starts. Burhenn struck out 69 batters while walking only 31 through 91 innings of work before missing the Big Ten Tournament due to injury.

MORE: Son of Heather and Dave Burhenn. Has one brother, Nick. Loves hockey and enjoyed going to see games at Ohio State Ice Rink. Graduate of Lawrence North High School in Indianapolis, Indiana where he hearned First Team All-State honors his senior season. Went to school for accounting and financing.
