Last Night: **Dragons 14, Lugnuts 10.** Trailing 14-1 entering the eighth, the Nuts rallied for nine runs against Dayton relievers Myles Gayman and Arij Fransen before ultimately falling short. Dayton starter, and top Cincinnati Reds pitching prospect, Rhett Lowder struck out nine in six innings while allowing one unearned run.

Where There's a Will, There's a Way: 1B Will Simpson went 1-for-4 with a triple yesterday and has now reached base in his first 17 games to begin the season. Simpson leads the Midwest League in walks (18) and tops the Lugnuts in hits (21), batting average (.375, 2nd in the MWL), RBIs (18, 3rd), OBP (.526, 2nd), slugging (.589, 4th) and OPS (1.115, 2nd). Jonny Butler, who went 2-for-5 last night, has reached base in 12 consecutive games.

Lighting Up the Scoreboard: The Lugnuts lead the Midwest League in runs scored with 107, thanks in large part to tallying 30 runs the last three games combined. That's due to big innings: five runs in the 8th on Wednesday, six runs in the 6th on Thursday, and nine runs in the 8th last night.

Dayton Draws First Blood: On the other hand, the Dragons have scored in the 1st inning in each of the first four games of this series: one on Tuesday, one on Wednesday, two on Thursday, and three last night.

League Leaderboard, Will Excluded: Colby Halter's 17 walks place him 2nd in the league behind teammate Simpson. Brayan Buevas is 2nd in runs scored (18) and tied for 5th with Henry Bolte in stolen bases (8); Bolte is tied for 4th in runs scored (15); reliever Garrett Irvin is tied for 1st in appearances (7).

Transaction: Speaking of Irvin, he and catcher Jose Mujica were promoted to Double-A Midland yesterday before the game. There were no corresponding moves, leaving Lansing with an active roster of 28 players.

Action on the Bases: In their seven meetings, Lansing (18-for-22) and Dayton (7-for-9) have combined to swipe 25 bases..

A Grand Start: On April 3, first baseman Will Simpson crushed a grand slam (as well as a solo shot) in an 18-0 victory over Michigan State in the Crosstown Showdown. Ten days later, Simpson launched a grand slam off the Great Lakes Loons in an 8-5 loss.

EMU to The Show: The Lugnuts' first debuting Major Leaguer this year is 2021 super utilityman Max Schuemann, who made his Major League debut on April 12 as a pinch-runner for the Oakland Athletics, scoring the game-winning run in the bottom of the 10th, and followed up on April 20 with a solo home run for his first MLB hit (in a 6-3 A's loss at Cleveland).

Prospecting: The Nuts' roster includes two MLB Pipeline Top 30 A's prospects in outfielder Henry Bolte (No. 12) and first baseman Will Simpson (No. 30). Bolte, the A's No. 2 outfield prospect, was selected 56th overall in 2022 from Palo Alto High School, where he led all California high schoolers with 13 home runs. Simpson, the A's No. 2 first base prospect, impressed with a .319/.367/.543 line in his professional debut after he was drafted in the 15th round from Washington last year.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2010: 1st-rounder Chad Jenkins fired eight shutout innings, allowing six hits and one walk while striking out nine, and Evan Crawford wrapped up a seven-hit Lugnuts 6-0 victory at West Michigan.

2016: The Lugnuts extended their scoreless streak to 24 innings, as Angel Perdomo (5 IP, 7 K) combined with two relievers on a four-hit 6-0 shutout at Beloit.

2018: Cullen Large went 5-for-5 and scored the game-winning run on a Norberto Obeso RBI single in the bottom of the ninth, helping the Lugnuts complete a four-game home sweep of the Dayton Dragons with a thrilling 8-7 win. (Obeso, added to the roster earlier in the day from Extended Spring Training, wore eyblack that read "I'm back.") The Lugnuts had lost a 4-2 lead and entered the seventh trailing 7-4, but Ryan Noda singled in Large in the seventh, Kacy Clemens tied the score with a two-run single in the eighth, and Obeso won it in the ninth with a seemingly routine fly to left-center that fell between LF Narciso Crook and CF Miles Gordon.

In a Nutshell: Opens second Midwest League season in a pitching piggyback tandem with Grant Judkins... 75-pitch / 5-inning limit tonight... @JakeGarland25.

Hometown Hero: Started four years for Jupiter High School varsity baseball ("Warriors," wearing green and gold)... totaled 229 strikeouts, 1.49 ERA and 1.13 WHIP... named two-time FHSAA All-State... honored twice as the 9A Player of the Year... also from Jupiter H.S.: Miles Mikolas and Dante Bichette (but not son Bo, who attended Lakewood High School in St. Petersburg)... family originally from New England before moving to Florida shortly before he was born; the Garlands all root for Boston-area teams.

Jupiter? How did Jake's hometown receive its name? The Hobe tribe lived in the area, a Spanish mapmaker miswrote their name as Jobe, which was then miswritten again as Jove, which was then mistranslated to Jupiter. Misunderstandings the whole way down to the city's incorporation in 1925. Jupiter is located on the eastern coast of Florida in Palm Beach County on the Atlantic Ocean.

The Bandit Connection: Burt Reynolds was born in Lansing in 1936, and died in Jupiter in 2018.

The U: Attended the University of Miami (Coral Gables), a baseball program founded in 1940 with four NCAA championships and 25 CWS appearances... played for head coach Gino DiMare... true freshman year was the pandemic-shortened 2020 season, making six relief appearances before the year was shut down... returned in 2021 as a member of the rotation: 16 games, 13 starts, totaling a team-high 68 innings (5.69 ERA, 38 K, 14 BB, .286 avg.)... improved in 2022 to a 3.99 ERA in 65 1/3 innings (54 K, 11 BB, lowering home runs from 10 to four)... fifth of six Hurricanes drafted in 2022, going 514th overall in the 17th round to Oakland... the last Miami product drafted by the A's: Jemile Weeks (1st round, 12th overall, 2008)... two other Hurricanes have played for the Lugnuts: 3B Mark Sobolewski and OF Adam Finnieston.

Professional Debut: After signing for \$100,000, made three appearances, one start, for the Arizona Complex League A's, tossing three total innings.

2023 Season: Opened the campaign pitching in relief in Stockton's second game of the year, started by rehabbing American League All-Star Paul Blackburn... earned the honor of **California League Pitcher of the Week** with his very next outing, firing five perfect innings on April 13 at Fresno with seven strikeouts (69 pitches, 47 strikes)... finished his time in Stockton with back to back six-inning outings against Fresno and Rancho Cucamonga before getting called up to the Lugnuts to replace Jorge Juan on May 15... dominated in Lugnuts debut May 18 vs. Lake County: 95 pitches, 59 strikes, 7 innings, 2 hits, 1 run, 2 walks, 10 strikeouts, in 5-2 win.

In a Nutshell: One of five undrafted free agents on the Lugnuts, joining fellow pitchers Dylan Hall, Garrett Irvin and Jack Owen, and outfielder Cameron Masterman... last Iowa player to suit up for Lansing: former Major League lefty Matt Dermody... started the Crosstown Show-down against Michigan State and tossed four scoreless two-hit innings in 18-0 win, April 3... 45-pitch limit today.

Family of Athletes: Father, Rob, played college baseball at Central College of Iowa, located in his hometown of Pella, as did both of his brothers, Jordan and Blake; his mother, Shannon, played golf in college.

At Pella High School: 2016 Iowa Gatorade Player of the Year as a senior... Des Moines Register's All-Iowa Baseball Player of the Year as both a junior and a senior, 2015 and 2016... 2015 Perfect Game Underclass High Honorable Mention... as a senior: 10-1, 0.64 ERA, 123 K, batting .421 with six homers and 12 steals... as a junior: 11-1, 0.56 ERA, 74 IP, 112 K, 10 BB, batting .520 with 14 doubles, nine triples, 13 homers, 57 RBIs, 51 runs, 15 steals... in his high school career, won 28 career games and totaled 337 career strikeouts.

Onward to Des Moines: Entered the Big Ten ranked by Baseball America as the No. 8 freshman... two-way player in 2017, hitting .270 in 31 starts as a DH (and three starts as a pitcher hitting for himself)... 2018 Academic All-Big Ten... No. 3 starter in 2019; 2019 Collegiate Baseball Player National Pitcher of the Week (Feb. 18), tossing six no-hit innings with 11 strikeouts; ranked 7th in the Big Ten in ERA (2.72)... No. 2 starter in 2020 before season was halted early due to the pandemic: 2-0, 3.00, 4 GS, 21 IP, 24 K, 5 BB... signed with the Athletics following the shortened five-round draft.

International Stage: With Iowa, took part in the 2017 World University Games in Taipei City, winning a silver medal (fell to Japan in the gold medal contest)... part of the first American team to ever advance to the gold medal game as well as the first American team to ever medal, period... team finished 5-2, losing only to Japan... started five games, four at first base, one at pitcher.
