### Inland Empire 66ers (19-14, 51-48) AT RANCHO CUCAMONGA QUAKES (16-17, 52-47)



RHP Jack Kochanowicz (1-4, 5.84 ERA) vs. LHP Ronan Kopp (5-2, 1.89 ERA)

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Quakes continue the home stand with the fourth game of a six-game series against the Inland Empire 66ers. Tonight is Tony Gonsolin Bobblehead Giveaway to 1500 fans and Friday Night Fun, presented by Yamaava' Resort and Casino at San Manuel. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

**VS THE 66ERS:** Today's game is the 22nd of 30 head-to-head meetings with Inland Empire this year and the 16th of 18 here at home. Rancho is 10-11 against Inland Empire this year, 8-7 here at home.

**LAST GAME:** The Quakes got a shot in the arm with five debuting players in last night's lineup, but it was the pitching that stole the show, in Rancho's 4-1 victory over the Inland Empire 66ers on Thursday night at LoanMart Field. Dalton Rushing smacked a game-tying homer in his first at-bat as a Quake and Taylor Young had a tie-breaking double in the seventh, as Rancho took the lead for good. Benony Robles and the rest of the bullpen starred though, as Robles tossed 4.2 innings of two-hit scoreless relief. Joan Valdez (3-1) was credited with the win and Madison Jeffrey notched his fourth save, as they combined for 2.2 innings of scoreless work. Inland Empire reliever Alex Martinez (2-1) was charged with three runs in the loss.

**PLENTY O' MOVES:** The Quakes made a total of nine roster moves on Thursday, after making six on Wednesday. Thursday's additions include the activation of catcher Yeiner Fernandez from the Temporary Inactive List and four players who were all drafted in the 2022 draft. Catcher Dalton Rushing (second rounder), outfielder Nick Biddison (fourth rounder), infielder Sean McLain (fifth rounder) and outfielder Kyle Nevin (11th rounder) all made their debuts last night. Gone from the active roster are infielder Hector Martinez (released) catcher Jorge Puerta and Javier Armas (sent to the ACL), and catcher Marco Hernandez (placed on the Developmental List). Congratulations goes out to Damon Keith and Austin Gauthier, who were promoted to Great Lakes of the High-A Midwest League on Wednesday. Both hitters rank amongst the league leaders in several categories in 2022. Taking their respective spots on the roster are a couple of 2022 draft picks, infielder Taylor Young (Louisiana Tech University) and outfielder Chris Alleyne (University of Maryland). In addition, RHP Jon Edwards was placed on the Developmental List on Wednesday, while RHP Huei-Sheng Lin was activated from the Developmental List. On Tuesday, right-hander River Ryan was promoted to High-A Great Lakes.

**NEW GUYS ALREADY CHIPPING IN:** The Quakes have added several new players to the roster who are already contributing. Dalton Rushing, who was the Dodgers' first pick in this year's draft (#40 out of Louisville), homered (first pro hit) in his first at-bat as a Quake, while Taylor Young's first pro hit will be memorable too, as he drove in the game-winning runs with his seventh-inning double. Chris "Bubba" Alleyne went 2-for-5 on Wednesday in his debut, collecting one hit from each side of the plate. The Dodgers' 2022 19th-round pick out of Maryland was 1-for-4 in two games in the Arizona Complex League, prior to moving to Rancho on Wednesday.

**TIM NEVERETT HERE TONIGHT:** Dodgers' broadcaster Tim Neverett is here at LoanMart Field tonight, as he'll be available on the concourse to meet fans and sign autographs of his book, "Covid Curveball". Please stop by and meet Tim!

**RONAN KOPP:** Left-hander Ronan Kopp makes his 22nd appearance of the year and his seventh start, his fifth appearance and second start against the 66ers. In his four previous outings against the 66ers, he's 1-0 with a 2.16 ERA, allowing three runs (two earned) on four hits, over 8.1 innings. Kopp's last outing was in San Jose, where he allowed two runs on one hit, but with two hit batters and a walk over three innings in a no-decision. Kopp was drafted by the Dodgers in the 12th round in 2021 out of South Mountain CC.

**JACK KOCHANOWICZ:** Jack Kochanowicz goes to the hill for his tenth appearance and ninth start for the 66ers, his third start against the Quakes this year. In his two outings against Rancho, he's 0-1 with a 3.27 ERA, allowing five runs (four earned) on eight hits over 11 innings. In his last appearance overall, he fired a scoreless inning of relief against Visalia on July 31. He was drafted by the Angels in the third round of the 2019 draft out of Harrison High School in Pennsylvania.
