RECULAR SEASON BY THE NUMBERS

TODAY'S GAME: The M-Braves start a six-game road series against the Pensacola Blue Wahoos at Trustmark Park. This is the third of five series between these two clubs this season. They will meet a total of 30 times, with 18 games at Trustmark Park and 12 games at Blue Wahoos Stadium. The M-Braves lead the season series 8-4, splitting 3-3 with the Blue Wahoos from May 3-8 at Trustmark Park.

- LAST SERIES NOTES: After dropping the first two games of the series, the M-Braves stormed back to take four of six against the Biloxi Shuckers and win their first series since the last week of
- The offense exploded on Saturday, July 2, scoring 18 runs, putting up three runs or more in five different innings. Drew Lugbauer set a club record with seven RBI, and Justin Dean tied a club record with five runs.
- Last night, the offense picked up where it left off with eight runs on 15 hits. Cade Bunnell went 3-for-5 with his first Double-A home run, a triple and a double and two RBI, finishing a single shy of the cycle. RHP Alan Rangel gave up two runs over five innings. Hendrik Clementina lofted a 392-foot solo shot to left center. Six different M-Braves posted multi-hit games: Bunnell, Dean, Alexander, Lugbauer, Moritz, Delgado.
- **FOUR-GAME WIN STREAK:** After dropping their fifth-straight game on Wednesday, the M-Braves have rattled off four straight wins, outscoring Biloxi 36-14 in those contests.
- LAST TIME AGAINST THE WAHOOS: The M-Braves took five of six from May 24-29 at Blue Wahoos Stadium. The offense put up 55 runs, smashing nine homers and 17 doubles, slugging .486 in the series. The M-Braves won the final four games of the series, outscoring Pensacola 48-18 in the final four games. Atlanta selected the contract of Michael Harris II on May 28 while the team was in Pensacola.
- THE SLUGBAUER MAKING MISSISSIPPI HISTORY: 1B Drew Lugbauer set club record with seven RBI on Saturday, July 2 at Biloxi, including his team-leading 16th home run. Lubgauer has hit a club record 34 career M-Braves home runs over two seasons. Lugbauer hit 18 home runs in 2021. He currently ranks 2nd in the Southern League this season in homers, including a two-homer game on May 27 at Pensacola where he matched the previous club-record with
- Lugbauer hit a walk-off single on Friday, June 3 vs MTG, the M-Braves first walkoff since Wendell Rijo's single on 7/9/21. He is in league's top 10 in...home runs (16, 2nd), XBH (33, 3rd), walks (43, T-5th), doubles (17, T-5th), and total bases (125, T-5th).
- DANGEROUS DEAN: OF Justin Dean tied an M-Braves record by scoring five runs on July 2 at Biloxi. Since his return from the injured list on June 4, Dean is batting .306 with 19 runs, 11 stolen bases, six extra-base hits, 15 walks, and a .404 OBP in 26 games.
- VINES SHINES AGAIN: Darius Vines has a 1.50 ERA over his last three starts (3 ER/18 IP), 16 strike-outs, five walks, including matching career highs with 7.0 shutout innings on June 25 at MTG, and July 1 at BLX. He leads the Southern League with 89 strikeouts, and 76.1 innings pitched, while ranking among the league-leaders in WHIP (1.38, 9th), starts (15, T-1st).
- GIVE ME MO MORITZ: OF Andrew Moritz is currently on a 15-game on-base streak, batting .375 with a .438 OBP. Moritz has already logged an 11-game, and 10 game hitting streak this season.
- TRENDING TARNOK: RHP Freddy Tarnok continues to string together solid starts recently. In his last three starts, he has given up four runs in 15 innings with 25 strikeouts. Tarnok matched a career high with 12 strikeouts on Thursday, June 30 at Biloxi.
- RELIEVERS TO THE RESCUE: The relief core for the M-Braves is 2nd in the Southern League and ranks 4th in Double-A with a 3.90 ERA this season.
- SHUSTER TO THE FUTURE: Starter Jared Shuster has a 3.39 ERA through 14 starts, which ranks 6th in the Southern League. The 2020 Atlanta first-rounder ranks among the league leaders in OBA, (.213, 3rd), WHIP (1.06, 3rd), innings pitched (71.2, T-4th) and strikeouts (82, 3rd).
- Shuster receieved an invite to the MLB Futures Game at Dodger Stadium on Saturday, July 16 before the MLB All-Star break, featuring baseball's top prospects from around the league.
- ALEXANDER THE GREAT: INF CJ Alexander hit his career-best 14th home run on Thursday June 30, ranking T-4th in the league. He has two multi-homer games, May 13, at Chattanooga, and May 27 at Pensacola, his third and fourth since 2019. From May 27-June 1, Alexander homered five times in five games. He has homered in back-to-back games three times
- Alexander is T-1st in the Southern League, and ranks T-2nd in Double-A baseball with 14 homers since May 1.

APRIL SHOWERS, MAY FLOWERS, JUNE THUNDERSTORMS, JULY SUNSHINE?: After going 7-13 in April, the M-Braves turned it around with a 16-10 record in May, the most wins of any Southern League team in May. The momentum did not carry into June, where the M-Braves finished 7-19, tying their club record for the most losses in June. The club is off to a 3-0 start in July.

TODAY'S GAME

- Jared Shuster makes his 15th start of the season and his third career start
 against Pensacola. In his last start against the Blue Wahoos, he tossed six
 innings of one-run ball with eight strikeouts, picking up his fourth win of the
 season.
- Shuster is 6th in the league with a 3.39 ERA. The 2020 first-round pick ranks among the leader leaders in OBA (.213, 3rd), WHIP (1.06, 3rd), innings pitched (71.2, T-4th) and strikeouts (82, 3rd)

LAST TIME OUT

 Shuster bounced back from a tough start by allowing one run over 5.1 innings at Biloxi. He struck out eight to just two walks and gave up four hits.

2022 NOTES

- Shuster struck out a career-high 12 over 5.0 shutout innings on Saturday,
 April 16 at Biloxi. He matched a Southern League record by striking out
 the final eight batters of the outing. The only other four Southern League
 pitchers to accomplish eight-straight strikeouts: Jim Jefferson (1988, Chattanooga), Dan Miceli (1996, Carolina), Anthony Reyes (2004, Tennessee), Nik
 Turley (2017, Chattanooga).
- Picked up back-to-back career highs with 7.0 innings in his last two outings (4/22 vs CHA, 4/28 at MTG).
