LRST TIME OUT

(MOOSIC, PA - Aug 31) - The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders defeated the Rochester Red Wings 12-7 Saturday afternoon at PNC Field. A four-homer, seven-run fifth inning was enough firepower to lift the RailRiders to victory in a rain-shortened contest.

Rochester opened the scoring in the top of the second. With the bases loaded, Erick Mejia singled home a pair of runs off RailRiders starter Josh Maciejewski to give the Red Wings a 2-0 edge. Scranton/Wilkes-Barre halved the deficit in the bottom of the frame. T.J. Rumfield led off with a double and Taylor Trammell followed with a single. With runners on the corners, JC Escarra plated Rumfield with a groundout to make it a one-run game. In the third, the Nationals' #2 Prospect Brady House drove a two-run homer to right, giving Rochester a three-score advantage. Oswald Peraza tied the game in the bottom of the third with his ninth home run of the season. After Jorbit Vivas grounded into a force and Yankees #1 Prospect Jasson Dominguez singled, Peraza smashed a three-run shot 401 feet to left, knotting the game at four. With two on and two outs in the top of the fourth, Rochester's Jack Dunn hit a sharp line drive to left. Dominguez relayed to Peraza, who gunned it to JC Escarra at home nabbing Stone Garrett at the plate. The outfield assist saved a run and kept the game tied at four. Scranton/Wilkes-Barre took the lead in the bottom of the inning. Carlos Narvaez walked to open the frame and Greg Allen singled to center. Yankees #16 Prospect Jorbit Vivas singled home the go-ahead run. Rochester went back out in front in the fifth. A throwing error to third scored Rochester's Andrew Pinckney to even the game at five. Maciejewski was lifted for Yankee rehabber Lou Trivino, who surrendered a two-run homer to Jake Alu, giving the Red Wings a 7-5 lead. The RailRiders unloaded for seven runs to recapture the lead in the home half of the frame. A pair of doubles from Rumfield and Escarra got them within one. Then Narvaez blasted a 416-foot bomb to center for an 8-7 advantage. Greg Allen singled to keep the line moving and Jahmai Jones sent a blast over the left-field wall to make it 10-7. Vivas and Dominguez followed with solo shots of their own for three straight homers.

NEWS & NOTES

BACK-TO-BACK-TO-BACK - The RailRiders hit three consecutive home runs off of Adonis Medina in the fifth frame. Jahmai Jones squeezed a ball down the left field line for a two run blast. Then Jorbit Vivas and Jasson Dominguez hit back-to-back homers to mark three straight. It was the first time they did this since August 26 of last season when Jamie Westbrook, Jake Lamb and Michael Hermosillo did so against Lehigh Valley.

THE MARTIAN - Yankees #1 prospect Jasson Dominguez has had nine multi-hit contests in his last 15 games. The switch hitter holds a .306 average in 37 games in Triple-A since returning from Tommy John surgery. Dominguez has played just one game in the big leagues this season.

WHEN DO THEY SCORE - The RailRiders have their best offense in the seventh inning where they have scored 113 runs. After a seven run fifth last night, the team has plated 104 runs in the fifth. Conversely, they have allowed the most offense in the first frame with 104 runs coming across.

BETTER THAN BEFORE - The RailRiders have already achieved more wins this season than they did all of last year. In 2023, the team went 73-75 over the course of 148 contests. Last season, the team was 34-40 in the first half and 39-35 in the second. SWB is well out in front of that this summer as they were 43-31 in the first and are currently 31-24 in the second with 20 scheduled games left to play.

BOTH SIDES OF IT - The pitching staff has issued just 11 walks over five games while striking out 40. In total, the arms have doubled their strikeout count, 1124, over their walks, 5011. Conversely the team has walked 22 times compared to the 26 strikeouts that they have this week.

MISCE MESS - SWB has committed at least one error in every game this week, totalling eight in the field. The team has now totalled 103 miscues. It is not close to the 191 that Delmarva has made, but it is far more than just the 71 that Rochester has, the least made. The RailRiders are 42-22 when they do not make an error, but 16-14 when they record two or more in a single game. However, they have not made more than three errors in a contest this season.

TOM'S TURN - Tom Pannone has impressed since coming over to the RailRiders from the Cubs. With SWB he holds a 1.95 ERA in seven starts. In Triple-A on the season with a 3.67 earned run average in 26 starts. In the International League, he leads in starts, second in innings pitched, and third in earned run average and strikeouts.

SEPTEMBER CALL UPS - The RailRiders will send up relievers Ron Marinaccio and Scott Effross along with Duke Ellis to the big leagues. This leaves seven players on the 40-man roster here in Triple-A. For the Red Wings are supposedly sending up Darren Baker, son of Dusty, and reliever Zach Brzycky.
