FROM THE CROWS NEST

HELLO AGAIN: Tuesday marks the Marauders first road trip to Hammond Stadium of the season. Bradenton won five of six games against Fort Myers at the beginning of May as a part of their franchise-record 11-game winning streak that began on May 2. Last season, Bradenton record a 7-5 record in Fort Myers and won the last two games to end the year.

ROSTER MOVES: Prior to Tuesday night's contest, the Pittsburgh Pirates announced the following roster moves affecting the Bradenton Marauders. C Justin Miknis has been activated off the injured list with LHP Yoldin De La Paz being promoted to High-A Greensboro. The southpaw leaves the FSL tied for first with five wins and is currently riding a scoreless innings streak of 8.1 innings. Miknis was sent to the injured list during the Marauders last road trip in Tampa on May 17 and has appeared in 18 games for Bradenton this year.

BEST OF MAY: Entering Tuesday's opener against the Fort Myers Mighty Mussels, the Bradenton Marauders' pitching staff owns the second-best ERA in the Florida State League at 3.20 in the month of May. The 3.20 ERA is the fifth-best in Single-A and 10th-best in MilB with the Hillsboro Hops (High-A, D-Backs) leading the way with a 2.37 ERA. They also rank second in the FSL with 240 strikeouts in 205.1 innings, only trailing the Dunedin Blue Jays who have racked up 254 in 204.1 frames.

HE JUST GETS ON BASE: With a single and a walk on Sunday, C Omar Alfonzo extended his on-base streak to 12 games. During his streak, the Pirates' No. 28 prospect is slashing .333/.500/.410 with three doubles, five RBIs, 13 walks, two intentional walks, and six runs scored.

FLYING AROUND: On Wednesday night, the Marauders stole a season-high five bases against the Dunedin Blue Jays. In last week's series against the Blue Jays, Bradenton finished a near perfect 14-for-15 in stolen base attempts, the 10th-most in MilB during this span. The Lynchburg Hillcats (Single-A, CLE) swiped 19 in 23 attempts to lead the way. The lone man caught was Keiner Delgado on Sunday on their only attempt of the game.

CHECKMATE: Over the last six games, OF Braylon Bishop has been a tough out at the plate. The Marauders outfielder is 9-for-24 with two doubles, a triple, one HR, seven RBIs, and six runs scored. Bishop played in just four games before being placed on the injured list on April 12. He was activated last Monday and played in two games during last week's series. The home run on Tuesday was Bishop's first since 8/21/23 against the FCL Rays.

HERE COMES THE POWER: The Marauders clubbed two more home runs on Sunday afternoon against Dunedin to bring their team total up to a 19 home runs in 23 games durign the month of May, the second-most in the FSL with the Dunedin Blue Jays in front with 21. It's also the fourth-most HR in Single-A with the Fredericksburg Nationals (WAS), Delmarva Shorebirds (BAL) and Dunedin each hitting 21 this month.

CLOSE QUARTERS: Sunday's loss marked the Marauders 19th one-run contest of the season. The Marauders own a 10-9 record in those games with 33 of their first 45 (73.3%) games having been decided by three runs or less.

GOT EM!:Carlson Reed picked off Victor Arias in the second inning on Thursday night for the Marauders 13th pickoff of the season. As of Tuesday, the Marauders are currently tied for third in MiLB, with the Quad Cities River Bandits (High-A, KC) leading the way with 16. Bradenton had 23 last season, which ranked the second-most in the FSL and 11th-most in MiLB.

After a dropped flyball double, Cristian Feliez hit a two-run HR to right field. In the fourth, four straight hits to start the inning led to two more runs. Chang threw 32 pitches in the inning but was able to strand the bases loaded to end his outing.
