YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the Baysox, 6-4. Bowie scored its first run in the second on a throwing error and added two runs in the fourth on fielder's choice groundouts. In the fifth, TT Bowens hit a solo homer. Jud Fabian reached on a fielder's choice to bring in a run in the sixth, opening a 5-0 lead. Jimmy Glowenke broke the shutout in the seven with a two-run homer, pulling the score to 5-2. In the eighth, Fabian pushed the Bowie lead to 6-2 with an RBI single. Glowenke brought in a run with a double in the ninth and a second run scored on a fielding error, but Cameron Weston closed out the game for his first professional save. Trevor McDonald started in his Double-A debut for Richmond and allowed three runs (two earned) over four innings with three strikeouts. Mat Olsen pitched a scoreless top of the ninth.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels face the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles, in the finale of a three-game series. To start this week, Richmond took two-of-three in Bowie. In the Flying Squirrels' first trip to Bowie this season, they won five-of-six games in a series from May 21-26, with the lone loss being a 2-1 defeat on May 23. In that series, they outscored the Baysox, 46-26. This is Richmond's final series against Bowie this year. The Flying Squirrels won four-of-six at The Diamond against the Baysox from April 23-28.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have gone 2-3 this week against the Baysox. They dropped four straight games to open the second half last week after going 7-2 in their previous nine games and 8-4 on their last 12-game road trip to New Hampshire and Portland. For the year, the Flying Squirrels are hitting .222 and averaging 3.76 runs per game (143 runs/38 games) at home compared to a .237 batting average and 4.93 runs per game on the road (202 runs/42 games). Richmond is 1-11 in its last 12 home games dating back to June 6.

THE BAYSOX went 4-2 last week at Reading to open the Eastern League's second half before dropping two-of-three against the Flying Squirrels in Bowie to open this week. In the first half of the season, they went 32-36, finishing in fifth place in the Southwest Division. Bowie is hitting .227 as a team this year, 11th in the league. The Baysox pitching staff has a 3.91 team ERA, fourth-best in the league and has allowed 83 homers, most in the circuit. Bowie's roster includes 10 of Baseball America's top-30 Orioles prospects, including C Samuel Basallo (No. 2), RHP Seth Johnson (No. 9), OF Dylan Beavers (No. 10), OF Jud Fabian (No. 12), 3B Max Wagner (No. 14), RHP Trace Bright (No. 20), OF John Rhodes (No. 26), RHP Alex Pham (No. 27), SS Frederick Bencosme (No. 28) and RHP Keagan Gillies (No. 29). Baseball America ranks Samuel Basallo as the best power hitter in the Orioles system, Silas Ardoin as the best defensive catcher, Jud Fabian as the best outfield arm and Trace Bright as having the best curveball. MLB.com's top-30 Orioles prospects list includes nine Bowie players, including Basallo (No. 2), Beavers (No. 7), Johnson (No. 10), Fabian (No. 12), Wagner (No. 14), Bright (No. 16), Rhodes (No. 23), Pham (No. 24) and Bencosme (No. 27).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander John Michael Bertrand makes his 16th start of the season and his fourth against Bowie. He started on Monday in Bowie and threw seven scoreless innings, allowing three hits. In his three starts against the Baysox this year, he has thrown 20 innings without allowing a run. Bertrand has been named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week twice this year, first for throwing seven perfect innings against the Baysox on April 27 and then for working six hitless innings in Bowie on May 23. He has made seven scoreless starts this year, all at least five innings, which is tied for the most in the Eastern League. Last season, he climbed three levels, working from Low-A San Jose to High-A Eugene before joining Double-A Richmond in July for the remainder of the season. For the year, he led all qualified Giants minor league pitchers in winning percentage (.688) and ranked second in ERA (3.65), second in wins (11), tied for second in WHIP (1.23), third in innings pitched (118.1) and fourth in BAA (.248). Entering 2024, Bertrand was rated by Baseball America as having the best control in the Giants system. Bertrand began his collegiate career at Furman University in South Carolina before playing his final two seasons at the University of Notre Dame. He was selected by the Giants in the 10th round of the 2022 MLB Draft. For more on Bertrand, see page two.

**FOR BOWIE:** Right-hander Ryan Long makes his 16th appearance and his ninth start of the season. He pitched on Monday against the Flying Squirrels in Bowie and allowed four runs over five innings in a loss. In his previous two appearances against Richmond this year, Long had combined for nine scoreless innings. He worked four innings and allowed two hits with seven strikeouts in a start at The Diamond on April 25. On May 25, he pitched five innings and allowed two hits with five strikeouts in a relief outing against the Flying Squirrels at Prince George's Stadium. Long was selected by the Orioles in the 17th round of then 2021 MLB Draft. He joined the Baysox from High-A Aberdeen last July and made 12 appearances (six starts), going 3-3 with a 6.51 ERA. In his career against the Flying Squirrels, Long has a 2.37 ERA (5 ER/19.0 IP) in four appearances.

**CARTER'S CRUISING:** Dating back to June 13 in 17 games, **Carter Howell** is batting .348 (24-for-69) with six doubles, two triples and 13 RBIs. In that stretch, he has picked up three hits three times and he has two hits in three-of-his-last-four games. He has two triples in his last nine games, including an RBI triple last Thursday night against Somerset. His four triples are tied for the most in the Eastern League this season. He is also tied for fourth in doubles (17), eighth in batting average (.287) and tied for eighth in hits (72).

**BERICOTO BASHING:** In his last 23 games dating back to June 6, **Victor Bericoto** is hitting .351 (34-for-97) with three homers, five doubles, five walks and 14 RBIs. After leading the Giants organization in homers (27) last year, Bericoto hit just one homer in his first 34 games this season through May 21. From May 22-28, he homered three times in five games. He went deep again on June 14 at New Hampshire and added a homer on June 18 at Portland. In his last 33 games since May 22, Bericoto is batting .326 (42-for-129) with six homers, six doubles, 12 walks and 23 RBIs. Bericoto has picked up multiple hits in eight-of-5 games dating back to June 15 and is batting .371 (23-for-62) in that stretch.

**TO THE MUNGUIA:** Since being assigned to Richmond on June 19, **Ismael Munguia** is batting .346 (18-for-52) and has added three stolen bases. He has at least one hit in 11 of his 12 games played, including a three-hit game and five two-hit games. On Monday at Bowie, he hit his first Richmond homer of the year, a two-run shot. He played 50 games with Triple-A Sacramento to open the year and batted .250 (36-for-144) in the Pacific Coast League. Munguia played 75 games for the Flying Squirrels last year and hit .282 (83-for-294), which led the team (min. 200 PA).

POMARES POWER: Jairo Pomares has three homers in his last six games dating back to June 28. On the year, he leads the Flying Squirrels and ranks fourth in the Giants system in homers (10). Pomares missed the start of the season with an injury and joined the Flying Squirrels for his Double-A debut on May 5. Since then, his 10 homers are tied for third in the Eastern League, trailing only 11 home runs by Erie's Hao-Yu Lee and Chris Meyers. For Pomares, his 17.7 PA/HR is the second-best in a season in franchise history (min. 150 PA), trailing only Sean Roby (14.12) in 2022 when he set the single-season franchise record with 25 home runs in his 89 games.

SCORELESS WORK FROM SILVA: Reliever Eric Silva has thrown five consecutive appearances dating back to June 19 without allowing a run, spanning 7.1 innings. He has nine strikeouts in that time frame. That span has lowered his season ERA from 6.41 to 5.03. Since throwing an immaculate inning on June 9 against the Curve, Silva has gone 2-0 with a 1.64 ERA (2 ER/11.0 IP) with 14 strikeouts and three walks. Earlier this season, Silva threw six consecutive scoreless outings from May 1-21, spanning 9.2 innings with 10 strikeouts. Over his next six outings prior to his current scoreless streak, he posted a 10.38 ERA (10 ER/8.2 IP) from May 26-June 14.

**PACKING THE HOUSE:** The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans in April for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and are ranked sixth among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance (6,964), outpacing the highest average attendance in franchise history (6,689 in 2013).

PROSPECT WATCH: Four of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the Richmond roster, including OF Vaun Brown (No. 10), RHP Trevor McDonald (No. 18), RHP Eric Silva (No. 20), C Adrián Sugastey (No. 23) and RHP José Cruz (No. 28). On Baseball America's Best Tools list, Sugastey is rated as the best defensive catcher and John Michael Bertrand is rated as having the best control. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list features five Richmond players, including McDonald (No. 12), Brown (No. 15), OF Victor Bericoto (No. 19), Sugastey (No. 23) and OF Jairo Pomares (No. 26).

BOULEVARD TO THE BAY: This season, 10 former Flying Squirrels players have reached the majors for the first time. That is tied for the second-most in a season in franchise history. Last year also saw 10 former Flying Squirrels players debut in the big leagues, including a team-record five from that season's Richmond roster. In 2014, a team-record 11 alumni made their MLB debuts, including Joe Panik, Adam Duvall, Andrew Susac, Matt Duffy, Jackson Williams, Edwin Escobar, Hunter Strickland, Chris Dominguez, Gary Brown, Brett Bochy and Chris Heston. The Flying Squirrels alumni to debut in the majors this season are Erik Miller (2023 Flying Squirrels), Landen Roupp (2022-23), Kai-Wei Teng (2022-23), Nick Avila (2022), Randy Rodriguez (2022-23), Mason Black (2023), Gerson Garabito (2021), Spencer Bivens (2023), Raymond Burgos (2023) and Hayden Birdsong (2023-24). Dating back to 2022, 20-of-the-last-21 Flying Squirrels alumni who have reached the majors have debuted with the San Francisco Giants, with Garabito (Rangers) being the only exception.
