FOUR-RUN EIGHTH SINKS CARDS IN FINALE: The San Antonio Missions scored four runs in the top of the 8th inning as the Cardinals dropped the series finale 5-4 on Sunday evening at Hammons Field. The Cardinals outhit San Antonio 12-5. Ramon Mendoza had a two-run homer as part of a 3-run 4th inning for the Birds and RJ Yeager added a solo shot in the 7th while Nathan Church had 3 hits. Cardinals starter Quinn Mathews struck out 6 and allowed just 1 R on 2 H over 5.0 IP in his 7th Double-A start. With the loss the Cardinals settled for a series split dropping 3 of the final 4 games.



**OPPOSING STARTER:** Right-hander **Ben Anderson** makes his 16th start (18th appearance) for the RoughRiders...Last pitched on Tuesday, August 6 at Midland and took the loss allowing 3 ER on 5 H with 4 BB and 5 K over 5.0 IP...Over his previous 7 appearances (6 starts) in June and July went 2-2 with a 2.60 ERA and a .228 BAA coming after registering a 6.35 ERA and .322 BAA in May...Made just 6 appearances between the ACL and High-A Hickory recovering from Tommy John surgery...Made just 9 starts in 2022 before going down with the elbow injury that required Tommy John...Split his first full season in 2021 between Low-A Down East and Hickory going 3-1 with a 3.70 ERA over 20 appearances (4 starts)... Selected by the Rangers in the 13th round of the 2019 draft out of Binghamton...Named America East Pitcher of the Year as a junior in 2019 going 9-4 with a 2.76 ERA...BU single season record for wins and strikeouts...Set America East record with a mark of 11.05 K/9...Twin brother of Braves right-hander lan Anderson who is also on the mend from Tommy John surgery and currently pitching at Triple-A Gwinett... Ben had the procedure in July 2022, Ian underwent Tommy John in April 2023...26 years old

#### CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD

The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to the Queen City of the Ozarks from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

#### CARDS' RADIO HOME

TEVAC I EAGUE OCCDEDOADE



For the second straight season all 138 Cardinals games can be found across the FM airwaves of Southwest Missouri all season long on Classic Rock 106.7, the radio home of the Springfield Cardinals!

ROAD WARRIORS: To date, the Cardinals have been the best road team in the Texas League. Springfield is 31-19 (.620) away from Hammons Field this season, and .500 at home (29-29). The Cardinals' .620 road winning percentage is the 2nd best in all of Double-A behind the Binghamton Rumble Ponies (NYM) who are 36-19 (.655).

The Birds have a road ERA of 3.75 as opposed to a 5.18 mark at home. The Cardinals' road ERA is 3rd in the circuit (and tops in the North Division) while their home ERA is 9th.

POWER SURGE: The 2024 season has been a tale of two halves when it comes to the Cardinals' power numbers. With 39 homers in 39 games in the 2nd half, Springfield has already eclipsed its 1st half total of 37. The Cards are on pace for 69 longballs in the 2nd half of Texas League play, a number that would be good for 3rd in the 1st half.

The Cardinals lead the league in runs scored in the 2nd half (201, 5.15/game) and are 2nd in both SLG (.406) and OPS (.749), with both numbers trailing Midland. In the 1st half, the Cards were 6th in SLG (.361) and 5th in OPS (.712).

THEY GET ON BASE: The top-hitting team in the Texas League all season long, it should serve as no surprise that the Cardinals also have the top OBP in the circuit. Sitting at .348, Springfield's on-base mark is 14 points higher than any other team in the league (Midland and Tulsa, .334).

**GRINDIN':** The Cardinal lineup has been one of the hardest in the minor leagues to strike out all season long. With 779 K's in 108 games (18.9% K rate), Springfield has the 2nd-fewest whiffs in all of full-season ball, trailing only the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers (MIL) of the Midwest League (744 K in 107 games; 18.6% K rate).

"DOG DAYS" OF AUGUST: After putting together their best month of the season with a 16-7 July, the Cardinals have gotten off the a good start in the month of August. Despite a 5-5 in the month, the Cards lead the Texas League with a .260 batting average through its first 10 games of the month and has also scored a league-high 52 runs (5.2/game). The Birds have also put together a solid 3.45 ERA with an opponents' batting average of .202 which is the 3rd best mark in the league.

CROOKS CATCHING FIRE: Over his last 33 games dating back to the final day of the first half on June 23, Cardinals catcher Jimmy Crooks has been swinging one of the hottest bats in the Texas League. During that time the Euless, TX native leads all qualified hitters in the circuit with a .345 average while adding 8 of his 9 HR this season and 27 RBIs, 2nd highest in the league behind Brennan Milone of Midland (28). Crooks during that stretch is slugging a league-high .621 and has a 1.023 OPS.

Among active qualifited Texas League hitters in 2024, Crooks leads the league in batting average (.309), OBP (.403) and OPS (.890). With a flyout to left field in a pinch hit appearance on Sunday evening, Crooks had a season-long 10game hitting streak come to an end.

HERE COMES THE KING: Springfield home run king Chandler Redmond has turned his season around in the 2nd half. After producing just a .188/.271/.234 line in 49 games through June 23, Redmond has produced a .303/.415/.517 line with 5 of his 7 homers this season in the 2nd half.

KING OF THE "K": With 26 strikeouts over his last 3 starts, Cardinals starter Quinn Mathews reclaimed the minor league lead in whiffs. With 157 K's, Mathews leads Matt "Tugboat" Wilkinson of the Cleveland organization by one strikeout (150). Among qualified pitchers in the minor leagues, Mathews is 7th in K/9 at 12.62.

**SLAM THE DOOR:** Cardinals closer **Matt Svanson** has been lights out so far in the 2024 campaign in save situations. Svanson is a perfect 19-for-19 and his 19 saves and 41 appearances lead all of Double-A. So far in the 2nd half, the Birds closer has allowed just one earned run in 17.0 IP (0.53 ERA) and is 9-for-9 in save opportunities. Over his last 14 appearances, **Svanson** has been unscored upon, allowing just 9 H with 12 K over his last 16.0 IP.

The Cardinals are 44-1 when leading after 8 innings this season.


