**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels split a doubleheader with the Baysox. Bowie won Game 1, 1-0. Donta' Williams drove in the only run of the game with a sac fly in the first inning. **Kai-Wei Teng** struck out five and allowed one run over 3.2 innings. **Nick Swin-ey** worked 2.1 scoreless innings out of the bullpen and allowed one hit with three strikeouts. **Ismael Munguia** had the Flying Squirrels' only hit. In Game 2, the Flying Squirrels won, 6-4. The Baysox took a 1-0 lead in the first with an RBI single by John Rhodes. In the third, Munguia tied the game with an RBI single and later scored on a single by **Luis Matos. Tyler Fitzgerald** hit a two-run homer to cap the four-run inning and give Richmond a 4-1 lead. Munguia aded a sac fly in the fourth to extend the lead to 5-1. Bowie picked up a run in the fourth on an error. In the sixth, Munguia opened a 6-2 lead with an RBI single, his third RBI of the night. Zach Watson hit a two-run homer in the sixth to pull the Baysox within two runs. **Erik Miller** worked a 1-2-3 seventh to close out his first save of the season.

TUDAY'S GAMES: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the finale of a six-game series against the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. Today marks the sixth of 24 games between the Flying Squirrels and the Baysox this season, tied for the most Richmond will play against any opponent. The Flying Squirrels return to Prince George's Stadium for a six-game series from June 13-18. The Baysox visit The Diamond for a six-game set from July 4-9 and again from August 8-13. The Flying Squirrels are 9-6 this year against opponents from the Southwest Division. The Flying Squirrels are 7-5 in games following a win.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have won nine-of-the-last-13 games and are in first place in the division, 2.5 games ahead of Altoona. After starting the season 4-0 for the first time in team history, Richmond dropped four-of-the-next-five games before taking four-of-six last week against the SeaWolves. The Flying Squirrels offense ranks first in the Eastern League in batting average (.248), runs (112), RBIs (98), OBP (.345) and OPS (.735) while ranking second in hits (160). The Richmond pitching staff leads the league in strikeouts (215) and have the EL's second-best ERA (3.24).

**THE BAYSDX** have lost nine-of-their-last-11 games, including four-of-five in last week's series in Altoona and four-of-five in this week's series. They snapped a six-game losing streak with a win in Game 1 of Saturday's doubleheader. Bowie's pitching staff currently holds the third-lowest ERA in the Eastern League (3.43). Bowie's roster includes eight of Baseball America's top-30 prospects, including Coby Mayo (No. 10), Heston Kjerstad (No. 12), Cade Povich (No. 13), Justin Armbruester (No. 20), Chayce McDermott (No. 23), Cesar Prieto (No. 25), John Rhodes (No. 27) and Carlos Tavera (No. 28). MLB.com's top-30 Orioles prospects list includes Kjerstad (No. 5), Mayo (No. 9), Povich (No. 12), Prieto (No. 17), McDermott (No. 18) and Rhodes (No. 20).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Carson Seymour** takes the mound for his fifth Double-A start and his second against the Baysox. He started the series-opener on Tuesday afternoon and allowed two runs over three innings in a no-decision. A native of Poway, Calif., Seymour was selected by the New York Mets in the sixth round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Kansas State University. After making four appearances in 2021, he began the 2022 season with Low-A St. Lucie, where he went 4-0 with a 119 ERA in seven outings (four starts). He was promoted to High-A Brooklyn on May 23 for 11 outings before being traded to the Giants on August 2 as part of the deal that sent Darin Ruf to the Mets. Seymour closed the year with High-A Eugene, going 2-3 with a 3.99 ERA in six starts. Seymour is rated by Baseball America as the No. 12 Giants prospect and No. 17 by MLB.com. *For more on Seymour, see page two.* 

FOR BOWLE: Right-hander Chayce McDermott makes his third start and fifth-overall appearance of the year. He pitched out of the bullpen on Tuesday and allowed two runs over three innings. His last start was April 18 at Altoona, when he surrendered two runs over 4.1 innings and struck out five. McDermott did not allow a run in his first two outings this year, spanning nine innings. He joined the Baysox last August and made six starts, going 1-1 with a 6.08 ERA. McDermott was selected by the Houston Astros in the fourth round (132nd overall) of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Ball State University. He was traded to the Orioles last August as part of a three-team deal. The Orioles sent Trey Mancini to the Astros, the Rays sent minor-league pitcher Seth Johnson to the Orioles. The Astros received minor-league pitcher Jayden Murray from the Rays. Tampa Bay picked up outfielder Jose Siri from the Astros. McDermott is currently ranked fifth in the Eastern League in ERA (165), third in BAA (167) and ninth in WHIP (116).

STARTING STRONG: The Flying Squirrels lead the Southwest Division with an 13-7 record this year, the best start in team history through 20 games, surpassing the previous mark of 12-8 set in 2018, 2021 and 2022. The team's best start through 21 games was 13-8 in 2018 and 2022. This year, Richmond went 4-0 to start the season, the longest unbeaten streak to start a year in franchise history.

RISPY BUSINESS: For the season, the Flying Squirrels are batting .314 (59-for-188) with runners in scoring position, which leads the Eastern League. Richmond also has the best batting average in the league with runners in scoring position .321 (26-for-81). With runners on base, the Flying Squirrels are leading the EL with a .307 average (88-for-287). tion and two outs at

HIT2-GERALD: Tyter Fitzgerald hit his second homer of the season on Saturday night in Game 2 of the doubleheader. In this week's series, Fitzgerald is batting .421 (8-for-19) with a homer, a triple, four doubles, two walks and two RBIs. With his triple on Tuesday at Bowie, Fitzgerald became the first player in the Eastern League this year with three three-base hits. He added three hits in Wednesday's win over the Baysox, including a double, and scored three runs, and he hit a double on Thursday night. In the Eastern League, Fitzgerald is ranked fifth in batting average (.324), seventh in OBP (.410), third in SLG (.588), fifth in OPS (.998), tied for fourth in hits (22), tied for fifth in doubles (6), first in triples (3), second in extra-base hits (11), third in total bases (40) and tied for third in runs scored (15). third in runs scored (15).

FULL MUNGUIA: After going 0-for-15 over a three-game stretch from last Sunday through this Wednesday, Ismael Munguia is batting .455 (5-for-11) with a homer, a double and four RBIs. He led off Thursday's game with a homer on the third pitch of the game, his second Double-A home run. In the second game of Saturday's doubleheader, he tied his season high with three RBIs, picking up a pair of RBI singles and a sac fly. Munguia is tied for seventh in the league in hits (20) and second in runs scored (16).

**HEY, HAYDEN: Hayden Cantrelle** has hit safely in 12-of-his-last-13 games, batting .319 (15-for-47) with four doubles, a triple, ei RBIs and 11 runs scored while adding three stolen bases. For the season, Cantrelle is tied for ninth in the Eastern League with runs scored.

MATOS MANIA: Luis Matos reached base in each of his first 17 Double-A games, the longest on-base streak in the Eastern League this season, until going 0-for-3 in the first game of Saturday's doubleheader. During the streak, Matos reached base 28 total times with 16 hits and 12 walks. He hit a homer in his Double-A debut in Game 1 of the Flying Squirrels' season-opening doubleheader on April 8 against Reading. For the year, Matos has struck out just nine times in 82 plate appearances (11.0 percent).

TAKE A WALK: Andy Thomas is tied for second in Eastern League with 17 walks. He leads the Eastern League with a 24.6-percent walk rate. Last season, Thomas led the Northwest League in on-base percentage (.373) and ranked third in walks (58). He has worked at least one walk in nine-of-his-15 games played so far this season. In this week's series, he has hit .375 (6-for-16) with a homer, a double, five walks and four RBIs.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, Patrick Bailey is ranked third in batting average (.333) and 10th in OPS (.881). Tyler Fitzgerald is fifth in batting average (.324), seventh in OBP (.410), third in SLG (.588), fifth in OPS (.998), tied for fourth in hits (22), tied for fifth in doubles (6), first in triples (3), second in extra-base hits (11), third in total bases (40) and tied for third in runs scored (15). Ismael Munguia is tied for seventh in hits (20) and second in runs scored (16). Andy Thomas is tied for second in walks (17). Luis Matos is tied for fifth in runs scored (14). Juan Sanchez is tied for second in wins (3). Kai-Wei Teng is first in strikeouts (30).

WHERE THE BAYSOX RANK: Among the Eastern League leaders, Cesar Prieto is first in batting average (.355), 10th in OBP (.402) and first in hits (27). Heston Kjerstad is tied for first in homers (6), second in SLG (.612), third in OPS (1.004), sixth in extra-base hits (9), tied for first in total bases (41) and tied for third in runs scored (15). John Rhodes is tied for fifth in RBIs (13). Coby Mayo is ninth in OPS (.883), tied for first in doubles (7) and tied for third in ex-tra-base hits (10). Chayce McDermott is fifth in ERA (1.65), third in BAA (.167) and ninth in WHIP (1.16).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have seven players ranked in *Baseball America*'s Top-30 Giants prospects, Luis Matos (No. 5), Mason Black (No. 9), Carson Seymour (No. 12), Erik Miller (No. 15), Ryan Murphy (No. 20), Nick Swiney (No. 24) and Randy Rodriguez (No. 30). MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Matos (No. 7), Black (No. 10), Seymour (No. 17), Rodriguez (No. 26) and Murphy (No. 27).


