Maimonides Park – Brooklyn, New York (opened 2001) RHP Jean Cabrera (3-3, 3.54) vs RHP Jonathan Pintaro (0-1, 4.00) Series: Game 2 of 6 (BlueClaws lead season series 7-6 of 27)

Last Time Out...The BlueClaws pulled past Brooklyn 7-2 on Tuesday night at Maimonides Park to stay within a half-game of Greensboro in the SAL Northern Division...Emaarion Boyd had two hits and scored three of the seven BlueClaws runs...Justin Crawford had a two-run double in the top of the ninth iningi...Mitch Neunborn started and gave up one run in four innings while Jack Dallas (win, 1.2 scoreless), Andrew Walling, and Andrew Baker combined for 3.2 innings of scoreless relief in the win.

State of the Claws... The BlueClaws have won nine of their last 11 games and remain a half-game back of Greensboro with two games left in the first half (Greensboro can clinch with a win today in their 12:00 pm game against Hudson Valley AND a loss by the BlueClaws tonight)...The BlueClaws were 3.5 games back of Greensboro entering their game on June 6" but won the last four games from the Grasshoppers to move into first place entering last Tuesday, but they are now a half-game back.

The Battle of the Boardwalks...The BlueClaws are in Brooklyn this week, their first of three trips to Coney Island this year...leresy Shore is 7-6 against the Cyclones (1-0 this week), with two six-game splits in Lakewood, the last series ending June 2nd.

Crawford on a Tear...Justin Crawford is 19-44 in his last 10 games (including 2-4 in both ends of the double-header on Saturday and 2-3 on Sunday), with eight multi-hit games his last 10 games, giving him 24 multi-hit games on the season to lead the BlueClaws...He was a double shy of the first cycle in BlueClaws history on May 30th but went 3-5 with a grand slam...He enters today at .302 on the season and leads the BlueClaws with 24 stolen bases (he has 81 in his career)...He was the 17th overall pick in the 2022 draft from Bishop Gorman HS in Las Vegas.

William The Kid...William Bergolla is 41-110 (.375) since he entered the April 30th game at .145 for the year...He is the BlueClaws youngest player (19) and tied the BlueClaws record with five hits in the win on June 9th (he is the 10th BlueClaw with five hits in a game and first since Emmanuel Marrero in 2016)...He hit his first professional home run on June 8th ...He is 33-80 (.413) in his last 23 starts...The #12 prospect in the system per MLB Pipeline, Bergolla is one of just six 19 year olds to play for the BlueClaws as a High-A affiliate (including teammates Justin Crawford and Bryan Rincon who were 19 when they debuted with Jersey Shore last year and have since turned 20).

Here's Aidan... Phillies 1* round pick Aidan Miller (27* overall, 2023 draft) went deep on Sunday for his first BlueClaws home run, going 2-4 in the win... He is 6-20 since an 0-9 start with Jersey Shore... His first hit was a 107 mph line drive triple to right-centerfield on Saturday... He joined the BlueClaws from Clearwater on June 11*, where he was hitting .275 with five home runs, 26 RBIs, 16 doubles, and 10 stolen bases... His .483 SLG and his .884 OPS were both second in the Florida State League at the time of his promotion... Miller played at Mitchell High School in Trinity, Florida, 19.6 miles from Baycare Ballpark, home of the Clearwater Threshers.

Hit Hit, Pineda...Leandro Pineda had two hits on Sunday, his 18th multi-hit game of the season...Pineda was hitting .196 after April 26th but since then is 55-166 (.331)...He leads the BlueClaws with both seven home runs and 41 RBIs...Pineda hit .330 in May and is 20-64 so far in June...He has a 15-game and a 13-game hitting streak this year, with his 15-game hitting streak the longest by a BlueClaw since the team became a High-A affiliate in 2021...Last season, Pineda hit.-243 (.298 in the second half with an .852 OPS and .193 in the first half with a .607 OPS)...The BlueClaws franchise record hitting streak is 24 by Jiwan James in 2010.

Dissin It...Jordan Dissin has seven home runs on the year and three since June 9th – one on June 9th against
Greensboro, a grand slam on June 11th and a solo home run on June 18th against Wilmington...Four of his seven home runs have come since May 31st and he is 11-33 since then...Dissin was a 12th round pick in 2022 from Saddleback College in California after playing at Malvern Prep outisde of Philadelphia and spent one season at the University of Pichmond

Marvelous Mari...Emaarion Boyd made a spectacular over the shoulder basket catch on Saturday in game two with the BlueClaws trailling 4-0 and a runner on base to end the 5" inning...Then in the bottom of the sixth, he started a 4-run rally with a single...Boyd duties and a grand slam last Sunday at Greensboro and is 12-34 since June 7"...He was an 11th round pick in 2022 from Batesville.

The Comeback Claws...Jersey Shore erased a 5-0 deficit on June 8th at Greensboro and a 4-0 deficit on Saturday to come back and beat Wilmington to stay within a half-game of first place Greensboro in the SAL North...On Saturday

Hitting Triple Digits...A South Atlantic League starting pitcher has thrown 100 pitches six times in a game this season all six are BlueClaws...Sam Aldegheri has done it three times (including 103 on Thursday), Jean Cabrera has done it twice (including 103 on Wednesday), and Braeden Fausnaught has done it once...The 103 from Aldegheri and Cabrera are the most thrown by a SAL pitcher this season.

Pair of 1s...Aidan Miller joins Justin Crawford, who made his BlueClaws debut in August, and is the 16th Phillies first-round pick to play for the BlueClaws...The only previous time when the BlueClaws had two together was in 2017 when Mickey Moniak (2016 first round pick) and Adam Haseley (2017 first round pick) played together for the last three weeks of the season.

Save Index...Andrew Walling earned his third save of the year in the win on Saturday...Daniel Harper earned his 6th save of the season on Tuesday after picking up his 5th on Saturday in Greensboro...He leads the team with six saves...Gunner Mayer has three...Andrew Walling and Charles King each have two.

Going Going Gone...The BlueClaws (15 HRs in Lakewood and 25 on the road) hit three home runs in the June 16th win over Wilmington (Dissin, Miller, Reyes)...Leandro Pineda and Jordan Dissin are tied for the team lead with seven apiece...William Bergolla hit his first professional home run on June 8th at

Just Grand...The BlueClaws hit three grand slams between 2021 and 2023, but they have three grand slams since May 30th - one by Justin Crawford (May 30th), one by Emaarion Boyd (June 9th), and one by Jordan Dissin (June 11th)...Boyd's home run was the second of his career while Dissin's was his sixth home run of the season.

Strike 'em Out Danny...LHP Danny Wilkinson, a Scotch Plains native, has 33 strikeouts in just 18.2 innings this season...Last year, he fanned 106 batters in 56.2 innings with Clearwater...Wilkinson signed with the Phillies in 2022 out of Villanova.

Three Saves for Gunner...Gunner Mayer has earned his first three professional saves over the last few weeks (two at Aberdeen between May 21st and 26th and May 28th against Brooklyn)...He has moved to the

bullpen this year and struck out 30 batters in 23 innings (29 of the 92 batters he faced)...Last year as a starter, Mayer had a 5.47 ERA with 79 strikeouts in 77.1 innings pitched...He was a 5th round pick in 2019 from San Joaquin Delta JC (CA).

Keep On Chuck-king... Charles King earned a save on April 6th in his professinal debut...He threw two scoreless innings on May 19th to earn his first professional win...King signed with the Phillies in February after spending the two previous seasons with the Padres as a biomechanical pitching analyst...He had not played competitive baseball since graduating TCU in 2021 before signing with the Phillies after spending the winter at Driveline in Scottsdale...14 of his 18 outings this year have been scoreless outings and he has two saves.

Going Deep (In the Game)

Trying For Back to Back...The BlueClaws have only made the playoffs in back to back years once - in 2009 and 2010, both SAL Championship seasons...They have a chance to do so again this year after reaching the SAL Northern Division Championship Series last year.

Youth Is Served...Per Baseball America, the BlueClaws have five of the 25 youngest players in the South Atlantic League (based on Opening Day rosters of 360 players): William Bergolla (3rd youngest), Bryan Rincon (9th), Justin Crawford (11th), Hendry Mendez (17th), and Emmaarion Boyd (21st).

In the First Round...Aidan Miller is the 16th former first-round pick to play for the BlueClaws and the fifth to play for the BlueClaws as a High-A team)...(his teammate

Justin Crawford in 2024, Andrew Painter and Mick Abel in 2022 and Bryson Stott in 2021)... Since 2000, the only two Phillies first round picks not to play for the BlueClaws are Joe Savery (2007) and Aaron Nola (2014) plus 2023 first-round pick Aidan Miller, who is currently with Clearwater.

Go Phils...The BlueClaws have several players that grew up Phillies fans: C Jordan Dissin (went to Malvern Prep in Philadelphia, 27 miles from Citizens Bank Park), OF Troy Schreffler (from Harrisburg), and LHP Braeden Fausnaught (from Danville and went to West Chester University).

Walk-Off This Way...The BlueClaws had an Opening Night walk-off win when Emaarion Boyd scored on a wild pitch...They had eight walk-off wins in 2023, including one in their final regular season home game...On September 3rd, Felix Reyes hit a three-run walk-off home run to cap a four-run BlueClaws ninth inning comeback against Aberdeen...It was the first BlueClaws walk-off home run since Ben Pelletier hit one on August 15, 2019 against Delmarva.

From The Shore to the Show...123 players have now gone From the Shore, to the Show including one this year (Ben Brown,

On the Staff...Greg Brodzinski returns to manage the BlueClaws in 2024 after leading the BlueClaws to the playoffs and a league-best 73-58 mark in 2023...Pitching coach Brad Bergesen is in Lakewood for a third time (2018 and 2022) and is joined as a pitching coach by first-year Phillies coach Matt Ellmyer...Hitting coach Adam Lind hit 200 big league home runs and is in his first year as a coach...Position coach Orlando Munoz is in his first year with the BlueClaws after managing the DSL Phillies since 2017...Development coach Beth Greenwood is the first BlueClaws female position coach and a member of Team USA Women's National Baseball Team.

The BlueClaws have had 13 games this year where their starting pitcher has thrown at least six innings.
