LAST TIME OUT...

TRENTON, N.J. (June 13, 2021) – A six-run eruption in the top of the fourth inning and a combined shutout by five pitchers led the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders to an 8-0 win over the Buffalo Bisons on Sunday at Trenton Thunder Ballpark. Luke Voit went 1-for-3 with a double and an RBI in the first game of his MLB rehab assignment, playing five innings at first base.

The game remained scoreless into the top of the fourth, but the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre offense broke through against Anthony Kay (0-2), touching up the left-hander for six runs. Trey Amburgey kicked off the frenzy with a double and scored on a single by Estevan Florial. The RailRiders also benefited from a three-run home run by Derek Dietrich and RBI doubles from Voit and Ryan LaMarre in the frame.

Amburgey finished the game 1-for-4 with a double and a run scored to stretch his season-long hitting streak to 18 games, the longest in Triple-A East this season. Dating back to the end of the 2019 season, the outfielder has a hit in 20 consecutive games, and owns a 26-game on-base streak.

Nick Nelson began the game on the mound for the RailRiders and turned in 3.2 scoreless innings in his first start of the year. Adam Warren contributed 2.1 innings after, and Brooks Kriske and Sal Romano each twirled a single frame without allowing a run.

In the top of the ninth, LaMarre drove a two-run home run to left off Kirby Sneed to expand the RailRiders lead to 8-0. In the third game of his MLB rehab assignment, LaMarre had a monster day, going 4-for-5 with a double and a home run and three RBIs. He also stole a base in the first inning.

SWB closer Luis Garcia worked around a pair of hits to set Buffalo down in the ninth to close out the win.

NEWS & NOTES

MEET THE METS: For the first time since the opening series of the season, the RailRiders take on the Syracuse Mets in a six-game series at PNC Field this week. After losing on opening night, Scranton/Wilkes-Barre reeled off five straight wins to close the series at NBT Bank Stadium in an impressive offensive showing. The Baby Bombers hit .306 AVG/.426 OBP/.578 SLG in that series, slugging 15 home runs and scoring at least 10 runs in a game twice. The RailRiders and Mets also played the longest game in SWB franchise history in a 4-hour, 9-minute marathon on May 6, a 17-11 final. Unbelievably, that was the first of two four-hour games in that series (also May 9) and one of three four-hour games that SWB has played this season.

MAMA SAID SHUT YOU OUT: Five RailRiders pitchers combined to pitch the second shutout of the year for the club on Sunday against Buffalo in Trenton. Following the first start of the year for **Nick Nelson** (3.2 IP), **Adam Warren** (2.1 IP), **Brooks Kriske**, **Sal Romano** and **Luis Garcia** (1.0 IP each) kept a tough Buffalo offense off the board for the rest of the game. The 8-0 victory was the first shutout for Scranton/Wilkes-Barre since a 6-0 win over Lehigh Valley in the home opener on May 11. In 2019, the RailRiders staff racked up six shutouts on the season. Sunday's contest continued a streak of 17.1 consecutive scoreless innings thrown by the SWB pitching staff, dating back to the second inning on Saturday. They have a long way to go to reach the SWB franchise record of 32.1 consecutive scoreless innings, set from June 23-28, 2007.

ON A SILVER TREY: RailRiders outfielder **Trey Amburgey** has been among the best hitters in all of minor league baseball this season, and entering play Sunday afternoon, has at least one hit in all 18 games he has played. That stands as the longest active hitting streak in Triple-A East, and is the longest in the league this season. Amburgey's streak is the second-longest active streak in the minor leagues, with **Cal Raleigh** of Tacoma working on a 21-game hitting streak entering Tuesday night. Dating back to the end of the 2019 season, Amburgey has hit in 20 consecutive games and has at least one hit in 25 of his last 26 contests, and has reached base safely in all of those games. He is hitting .391/.462/.717 (36-for-92) in that span. The SWB franchise record for longest hitting streak belongs to **Pablo Ozuna**, who hit in 27 straight games in 2004 for the Red Barons, while the longest on-base streak is **Brandon Drury's** 32-game streak in the 2018 season.

OTHER STREAKS OF NOTE: In addition to Trey Amburgey's impressive run, the RailRiders offense features two other players with double-digit on-base streaks. Outfielder **Greg Allen** is riding a season-long 13-game on-base streak into play on Sunday afternoon, and infielder **Hoy Park** has reached base safely in 13 consecutive games. Allen has also played in two other games this season in which he did not record an official plate appearance, therefore not jeopardizing his streak and spent time on the injured list in the middle of his streak.

COMEBACK KIDS: The RailRiders erased multi-run deficits two times en route to victory during the last series with Buffalo. On Tuesday, they trailed 5-0 and eventually won 7-5, with a two-run single from **Derek Dietrich** in the top of the eighth putting SWB ahead for good. Then on Saturday, the RailRiders erased an early 4-0 advantage to win 6-4 in 10 innings. **Andrew Velazquez** put the RailRiders on top in the 10th inning when he scampered home on a wild pitch. Overall, the RailRiders have 10 come-from-behind wins this season.

EXTRA, EXTRA! Saturday night's 10-inning affair with the Buffalo Bisons was the first extra-inning game of the season for the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders. It took until Game 33 of the season for the RailRiders to need extra frames to decide a game after 16 extra-inning contests in 2019. SWB went 10-6 in those contests.

CALL IT A COMEBACK: The last time the Syracuse Mets played a game at PNC Field was the memorable Game 141 of the 2019 season, when the RailRiders completed the Miracle on Montage Mountain. Trailing 7-1 entering the bottom of the 7th and having just one hit to that point off starting pitcher Ervin Santana, the RailRiders scored five times to make it a 7-6 deficit. When Syracuse responded with six runs in the top of the 8th inning it seemed as if the RailRiders' fate was sealed, but instead they plated a season-best eight runs in an inning and grabbed a 14-13 lead en route to a win. Fittingly, this game was the final regular season game ever played in the International League, a circuit which began play in 1884 but has been disbanded and reconstituted as the Triple-A East League.

LAST TIME OUT: García had a down start in Game 2 of the RailRiders doubleheader against the Buffalo Bisons on June 10, giving up five runs in 2.0 innings to tie a season-high. The right-hander was fine through two innings, but allowed four runs in the bottom of the third without recording an out. With the RailRiders losing 10-0, Deivi was tagged with his third straight loss, and his second in as many starts with SWB. The outing raised García's ERA on the road to 16.43, while at home it is a stellar 1.17.

RECORD SETTING ROOKIE: Deivi García made his big-league debut in Game 2 of a doubleheader on 8/30/2020 against the New York Mets (6.0 IP, 4 H, 1 R, 0 ER, 0 BB, 6 K). He became just the 10th Yankee since 1935 and the first since 1992 to throw at least 6.0 IP and not allow an earned run in his MLB debut. García went on to become just the second pitcher in Yankees history with at least 6 K and no more than 2 BB in each of his first four big league appearances (Masahiro Tanaka, 2014). He did this while being the youngest pitcher (21 year, 103 days) to start a game for the Yankees since Phil Hughes (21 years, 95 days in 2007), and the second-youngest player to start a game in the majors in 2020 (Luis Patiño, SD; 20 years, 329 days). The right-hander capped off the season by starting Game 2 of the ALDS against Tampa Bay, and became the youngest pitcher (21 years, 140 days) ever to start a postseason game for the Yankees (previous: Whitey Ford, 1950 World Series Game 4; 21 years, 351 days).

2021 HIGHLIGHTS:

- Began the season at the Yankees Alternate Training Site, recalled by Yankees for a spot start on 4/26.
- Optioned to the Yankees Alternate Training Site on 4/27 and assigned to RailRiders Opening Day roster on 4/30.
- Named Triple-A East Pitcher of the Week for 5/10-16 (1-0, 10.0 IP, 5.0 H, 1 R, 0 ER, 2 BB, 16 K), the first weekly award for an SWB pitcher since Jonathan Holder in 2016 (8/22-28).

PERSONAL:

- Launched a new Instagram account dedicated to showcasing his artwork "@drawings_deivi83".
- Full name is Deivi Anderson García.
- Watches the same 5-minute clip of his idol Pedro Martinez from the 1999 All-Star Game before each of his starts.
- Credits his Father for a lot of his success, he was the first one to teach him a curveball and made countless sacrifices for him to attend tryouts. His mother was a doctor who gave up her career to focus on raising her children.
- Grew up wanting to play shortstop, began pitching when he went to tryouts as a 15-year-old and scouts had him work out on the mound.
- Younger brother, Andres García, is a prospect in the Toronto Blue Jays organization. He most recently played for the DSL Blue Jays in 2019.
- Pitched in the 2019 SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game at Progressive Field in Cleveland, and was promoted to Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre for the first time after the game.
