## FROM THE CROWS NEST

.259/4HR/I.40ERA ED, ED, AND EDDY: Over the last two games, Eddy Rodriguez has been hard to stop at the plate. The 20-year-old is 5-for-6 with two 29 (5.8) | 8 (1.6) doubles, six RBIs, two walks, and two runs scored in the last two contests. The four RBIs on Saturday night were a season-high among any Marauders batter this season.

**HEATING UP:** Over the last six games, **Esmerlyn Valdez** is hitting .409/.480/.727 with four doubles, a HR, six RBIs, one walk, and six runs scored. Valdez has also reaching base in eight straight contests, his longest on-base streak of the season. Among qualified hitters in the FSL since April 27, Valdez's .409 batting average ranks at the top.

**GOING FOR THE WIN:** Having won four of the first five games of this week's series against the Fort Myers Mighty Mussels, the Bradenton Marauders have captured their first series victory of the season. The three-game win streak is currently their longest of the season.

**BLANKED:** After shutting out the Fort Myers Mighty Mussels the previous two nights, the Marauders scoreless inning streak came to an end at 22.1 innings on Saturday night. The run allowed in the second inning was the first since a Jose Rodriguez solo-home run in the sixth on Wednesday. So far in the month of May, Bradenton has allowed just five runs, good for a 1.25 ERA, the best in FSL and fourth-best in MiLB.

**FINDING THEIR GROOVE:** Since April 17, the Bradenton Marauders pitching staff owns the second-best ERA in the Florida State League and Single-A at 2.45, only trailing the Daytona Tortugas who sport a 2.31 ERA. It's also the third-best ERA in all of MiLB during this span, with the Birmingham Barons (CWS, Double-A) who sit second with a 2.40 ERA.

HE GETS ON BASE: INF Garret Forrester's 11 game hit streak came to an end on Friday night. With a hit in nine of the 11 games, Forrester hit .417 (15-for-36) with 4 doubles, a HR, 6 RBIs, 6 walks, and 6 runs. It was the longest active on-base streak for the Marauders with Forrester raising his season batting average from .139 to .261. The former Oregon State Beaver also recorded five multi-hit games in this span with the highlight being a 3-for-3 night at the plate versus Fort Myers on Tuesday night.

**GOT EM!: Peyton Stumbo** picked off Omari Daniel in the seventh inning on Friday night for the Marauders ninth pickoff of the season. As of Sunday, the Marauders are currently tied for second in all of MiLB only trailing the Fredericksburgh Nationals (Single-A, WAS) who have 10. Bradenton had 23 last season, which ranked the second-most in the FSL and 11th-most in MiLB.

A GOOD DAY AT THE OFFICE: RHP Tyler Kennedy set a new career-high, striking out six batters in two scoreless innings of relief on Wednesday night against Fort Myers. The six strikeouts were also the most by a Marauders reliever this season until Connor Oliver matched that total the next night on Thursday.

# IN HIS GROOVE: With another scoreless outing on Tuesday night, LHP Hunter Furtado has extended his season-long scoreless streak to 5.2 innings. Over his last three outings, the 2023 Sixth-Round pick has struck out seven and walking one while allowing just three hits.

CLOSE QUARTERS: Last Saturday night's loss to Clearwater marked their 10th one-run contest of the season. The Marauders own a 3-7 record in those games with 18 of their first 26 (69.2%) games having been decided by three runs or less. In last week's series against Clearwater, all six games were by a total of eight runs. The series featured four-one run contests with another two decided by two runs each.
