LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones were shutout for the 3rd time in 5 games, as the IronBirds snapped a 13-game losing streak with a 4-0 win...Aberdeen scored in the 2nd on a LF Jacob Teter RBI single...IronBirds capped the scoring with a 3-run home run to left by RF Elio Prado in the 7th...1B Samuel Basallo, 2B Anthony Servideo, and Prado each tallied multi-hit games for Aberdeen...Servideo doubled twice...1B William Lugo reached base 3 times for Brooklyn on a pair of singles and a walk...RHP Kyle Virbitsky tossed 5.0 shutout innings for his 4th win... He, RHP Logan Rinehart (2.0 IP), RHP Hayden Nierman (1.0), and RHP Dan Hammer (1.0) united on a 5-hit shutout...RHP Jawilme Ramírez suffered his 1st South Atlantic League defeat despite 6.0 innigs of 1-run ball.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: Baseball America released their updated list of Top 30 New York Mets' prospects on Wednesday...10 members of the 2023 squad are featured...OF Ryan Clifford (No. 3), SS Jett Williams (4), C Kevin Parada (7), RHP Blade Tidwell (9), RHP Christian Scott (10), OF Alex Ramírez (12), 3B Jacob Reimer (14), RHP Tyler Stuart (22), RHP Raimon Gómez (24), and RHP Jordany Ventura (29)...Williams (No. 98) and Clifford (99) also appear on the publiciation's list of Top 100 prospects...Former Cyclones listed include: INF Ronny Mauricio (No. 6), RHP Mike Vasil (8), RHP Dominic Hamel (19), OF Matt Rudick (20), and RHP Junior Santos (27)...In all, 15-of-30 members of BA's Top 30 have experience playing on Coney Island...MLB Pipeline released their updated list on Thursday evening...8 members of the 2023 team are recognized...SS Jett Williams (No. 3), C Kevin Parada (5), OF Ryan Clifford (6), RHP Blade Tidwell (10), OF Alex Ramírez (11), RHP Christian Scott (12), IF Jacob Reimer (13), RHP Tyler Stuart (17), and RHP Raimon Gómez (25)...Former Brooklyn stars featured are: IF Ronny Mauricio (No. 4), RHP Mike Vasil (9), RHP Dominic Hamel (16), and OF Matt Rudick (27)...Williams (No. 84), Mauricio (93), and Parada (96) are recognized in the Top 100.

**OUT IN FRONT:** SS **Jett Williams** started the home first inning for the Cyclones with a solo home run off RHP **Trace Bright** — the first of his Brooklyn career — in Wednesday's win vs. Aberdeen...The 19-year-old's blast marked the 2nd leadoff home run for the Cyclones in 2023... LF **Alex Ramírez** was the first to accomplish the feat, smacking a solo home run to left-center field off RHP **Johan Domínguez** on May 24 vs. Winston-Salem...Both leadoff home runs came in Wednesday afternoon games on Coney Island...OF **Ross Adolph** and INF **Rylan Sandoval** are tied for the franchise record in leadoff home runs with 3 in 2018 and 2010, respectively.

AIR JORDANY: RHP Jordany Ventura set new career highs in innings pitched (7.1) and strike-outs (9), earning the win and tossing a quality start in August 2's win at Jersey Shore...He then set a new career-high with 10 strikeouts in his next start on August 9 vs. Aberdeen, allowing 1 run and 1 hit over 6.2 innings...Ventura tossed a career and team-season-high 101 pitches and 66 strikes...The 101 pitches were the most thrown by a Brooklyn pitcher since RHP Briam Campusano tossed 103 pitches (57 strikes) over 5.2 innings in a 5-2 loss at West Virginia on July 28, 2018...In 5 starts with Brooklyn, the Mets' No. 29 prospect per Baseball America is 3-0 with a 2.73 ERA (8 ER in 26.1 IP), 13 walks (12.7 BB%), and 27 strikeouts (26.5 K%)...Narrowed down to his last 3 starts, Ventura is 3-0 with a 2.37 ERA (5 ER in 19.0 IP) and 8 walks (11.3 BB%) to 23 strikeouts (32.4 K%) with only 6 hits allowed...Brooklyn is 5-0 in starts made by the 23-year-old.

BIG APPLE ELI: LHP Eli Ankeney tossed a pair of shutout innings to earn his 3rd save of his professional career on Wednesday afternoon vs. Aberdeen...Between Brooklyn and Single-A St. Lucie, the 22-year-old has accrued a 1.42 ERA (5 ER in 31.2 IP) in 21 appearances (1 start)... Among Minor League pitchers with 30.0-plus innings pitched and 1-or-fewer starts, Ankeney is 11th in ERA (1.42)...Ankeney is also tied for 2nd in fewest hits allowed (14) and 8th in opposing batting average (133)...Since making his Brooklyn debut on June 3 at Jersey Shore, the Phoenix, Ariz. native is tied for 3rd among South Atlantic League relievers with 20.0-plus IP in fewest hits allowed (12), 4th in batting average against (160) and ERA (1.99).

THE JETT AND JACOB SHOW: INFs Jett Williams and Jacob Reimer have made an impact since making their Cyclones debut last Tuesday...Williams has reached base safely in all 8 games played with the club and is 8-for-28 (.286) at the plate with 3 runs scored, 2 doubles, a home run, 4 RBI, 4 stolen bases, and 9 walks (23.7 BB%) to 8 strikeouts...Since returning from the All-Star break on July 14, the 19-year-old is slashing .324/500/.592 with a 1.092 OPS, 6 doubles, 2 triples, 3 home runs, 8 RBI, 24 walks, and 10 stolen bases in 22 games between Brooklyn and Single-A St. Lucie...On the season, Williams is tied for 7th in Minor League Baseball in walks (78)...Since June 1, Reimer has recorded a .303/.435/.474 slash line with a .909 OPS, 33 runs scored, 8 doubles, 6 home runs, 30 RBI, and 29 walks in 46 games between 3 levels in the Mets' system.

STAN THE MAN: Since OF Stanley Consuegra made his return from the injured list on June 29, the 22-year-old is tied with his teammate OF Ryan Clifford and 3 others for the South Atlantic League in home runs (9)...On the year, Consuegra is tied for 8th in the SAL in home runs (14) and tied for 9th in slugging percentage (.462)...His 14 home runs are also tied for 5th in the Mets' organization.

CLIFFORD THE CYCLONE: OF Ryan Clifford was added to Brooklyn's roster on August 3...

The 20-year-old was acquired by the New York Mets with OF Drew Gilbert from the Houston Astros in exchange for RHP Justin Verlander on August 1...Clifford smashed a 2-run home run to right in his first at-bat and closed out his organizational debut with a 2-for-3 day, adding 2 walks and 2 runs scored on August 3 at Jersey Shore...The 2022 11th-round pick enters Friday ranked 2nd in the South Atlantic League in slugging percentage (.517)...He is also 3rd in OPS (.861) and tied for 5th in home runs (17)...Among players with at least 250 plate appearances, Clifford is 2nd in isolated power (.258), 5th in OPS (.861), and 9th in wOBA (.379) and wRC+ (129).

ALEX THE AMAZING: Since the start of June, OF Alex Ramírez is tied for 3rd in the South Atlantic League in runs scored (39)...Dating back to his 6-hit game on July 21 at Hudson Valley, the 20-year-old is slashing .343/.375/.478 with a .853 OPS...Ramírez is 23-for-71 at the plate (.324) with 10 runs scored, 6 doubles, a home run, 9 RBI, 4 walks, and 5 stolen bases...Alex is scattered among the Cyclones' all-time leaderboard despite joining the team last July 4...Entering Thursday, the Dominican native is tied with INF Luke Ritter for 2nd in franchise history in RBI (80) and is 11 behind INF José Peroza (91) for the all-time mark...He surpassed Peroza for 1st in doubles (36), is 2nd in total bases (222) and hits (151), and 3rd in runs scored (79).

vs. ABERDEEN: Brooklyn returns home to open up a 2-week homestand with 6 games against the Orioles' High-A affiliate...The IronBirds possess 4 of Baltimore's top 30 prospects per Baseball America: C Samuel Basallo (5), C Creed Willems (24), RHP Juan Núñez (26), and RHP Trace Bright (30)... Brooklyn and Aberdeen are meeting at Maimonides Park for the 2nd and final time and the first time since the two side split a 6-game series from May 2-7...The Cyclones are 8-7 (.533) against the IronBirds in the first 12 meetings of the campaign...Dating back to their first meeting in 2002, Brooklyn is 124-112 all-time against Aberdeen (.525).

THE RHY-T STUFF: In 23 games since July 4 at Wilmington, OF Rhylan Thomas is slashing .358/.391/.420 with a .811 OPS at the dish and a 125 wRC+...Thomas has added 10 runs scored, 2 doubles, a home run, 9 RBI, and 5 walks to only 5 strikeouts...Since July 18 at Hudson Valley, the left-handed swinger is slashing .371/.391/.452 with a .842 OPS and 132 wRC+...Thomas already has as many RBI (9) as he did in St. Lucie in 39 fewer plate appearances (139 to 100)...Among players with 85 or more plate appearances since the start of July, Thomas ranks 3rd in the South Atlantic League in batting average (.345) and has 3 fewer strikeouts (6) than any other batter.

THE ROCO SHOW: RHP Robert Colina has been on a tear since he struck out a season-high 7 on June 21 vs. Hudson Valley, which was matched on August 1 at Jersey Shore...After tossing a season-high 5.1 innings of shutout relief on Tuesday, Colina holds a 3-0 record with a 1.53 ERA (5 ER in 291 IP)...The 22-year-old has surrendered just 21 hits and walked 6 with 35 strikeouts over his last 8 appearances (3 start), Colina...Colina's strikeout rate is up 3.4 percent (31.8 K%) and walk rate is down 1.8 percent (5.5 BB%) during the time span.

BANANA'S FOR FOSTER: RHP Cameron Foster took the loss but punched out a career-high 12 on July 29 vs. Wilmington...The 12 punchouts are the most by a Cyclone pitcher in 2023... Foster is the 3rd different Brooklyn arm to strike out 10+ batters in a single game this year... RHP Tyler Stuart whiffed 11 on June 22, while RHP Blade Tidwell has accomplished the feat 4 times...The Houston native is the first Cyclone pitcher to strikeout 12-plus batters in a single contest since RHP Marcos Molina collected 12 strikeouts on August 15, 2014, in a 7-0 win at Vermont...Foster is the first to accomplish the feat at home since RHP Collin McHugh collected 12 K's vs. Jamestown on August 8, 2009...Since the start of June, the 24-year-old holds a 2-2 record with a 3.05 ERA (15 ER in 44.1 IP) with 13 walks and 52 strikeouts over 9 starts...Foster's strikeout rate is up 3.7% from his overall numbers (28.3% from 24.6%) and his walk rate is down 1.9% (7.1% from 9.0%).

THE BEST AROUND: Since the start of a 4-game winning streak at Hudson Valley on May 17, the Cyclones' pitching staff has, statistically, been the most dominant in Minor League Baseball... Entering Friday, Brooklyn has posted a MiLB-low 3.02 ERA (214 ER in 637.0 IP) over their last 73 games, holding a 41-32 record in that span...The Yankees' High-A Hudson Valley (3.22) is 2nd in the minors and SAL...The Cyclones have hurled 7 shutouts in that span and hold a strikeout rate of 27.9% and a walk rate of 10.8%...Additionally, Brooklyn pitching holds the 2nd lowest opposing OPS (.622), in addition to the 3rd lowest hits-per-9 innings (6.98) and batting average against (.212) in that period...RHPs Blade Tidwell (1.92), Christian Scott (2.35), and Tyler Stuart (2.37), hold the 1st, 3rd, and 4th best ERA's in MiLB during that time (min. 65.0 IP).

**BULLPEN BOOM:** The Cyclones' relief staff has been exquisite at quelling fires in 2023...Entering Friday, Brooklyn holds 2nd-best bullpen ERA (3.45) in the entire South Atlantic League and the 4th-lowest throughout Minor League Baseball...The Rangers' Single-A Down East (3.11) leads MiLB and Hudson Valley (3.39) is tops in the SAL.

**TOP OF THE CYCLONE:** Brooklyn 7-series streak without losing a set came to a close with Sunday's loss at Jersey Shore...Brooklyn had not dropped a set since Greenville won 4-of-6 on Coney Island from June 6-11, going 5-0-2...The Cyclones are 24-15 in the second half and hold a 2-game lead in the North Division of the SAL over Jersey Shore (22-17).

I GOT YOUR SIX: OF Alex Ramírez became the first player in Cyclones history to record a 6-hit game with a 6-for-6 performance on July 21 at Hudson Valley...The 20-year-old also stole 3 bases, scored 3 runs, drove in a tally, and robbed 3B Marcos Cabrera of a home run in the 2nd inning...Ramírez is 1-of-5 players in Minor League Baseball to compose a 6-hit game in 2023... Alex is the first player in Minor League Baseball since the stat portal began in 2005 to record 6+ hits and 3+ stolen bases in a single game...Only two players in Major League history have accomplished the feat in the modern era (since 1901)...OF Sammy Sosa (Chicago-NL, 7/2/93 at Colorado) and OF Max Carey (Pittsburgh, 7/7/22 vs. New York-NL).

DE RECORD SETTER: OF Omar De Los Santos entered as a pinch-runner and stole second base on July 21 at Hudson Valley, giving him 33 stolen bases in 2023...The current 34 swipes breaks INF Walter Rasquin's franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017 when Brooklyn played in the short-season New York-Penn League...He is also 4th in the SAL in stolen bases for 2023...De Los Santos remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The Dominican native has accumulated 104 stolen bases in that span, which is 7th most in MiLB...Only Aberdeen OF Luis Valdez (114), Mariners farmhand OF Jonatan Clasé (114), D'Backs prospect OF Wilderd Patiño (113), Red Sox prospect INF David Hamilton (113), Marlins farmhand INF Nasim Núñez (110), and Cardinals prospect OF Mike Antico (107) have tallied more...De Los Santos has also snagged 56 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow 2023 Cyclone IF/OF Jaylen Palmer is 2nd with 48.

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered his 3rd-straight defeat last Friday night at Jersey Shore...Allowed 5 runs (4 earned) on 7 hits over 4.1 innings...Did not walk a batter and struck out 4...Permitted a 2-run home run to C Anthony Quirion in the bottom of the 5th...Relieved by RHP Brendan Hardy with the bases empty and 1 out in the bottom of the 5th and Brooklyn trailing, 5-2...BlueClaws went on to defeat the Cyclones, 6-3.

YO-JOANDER: Suárez continues to hit his stride after returning from Tommy John surgery in June of 2021...The 23-yearold hurled a quality start on July 22 at Hudson Valley and set a new career-high with 7.0 innings of work in a July 8 defeat at Wilmington...Over his last 9 appearances (8 starts) since June 14 at Aberdeen, Suárez holds only a 2-5 record, but a 3.76 ERA (17 ER in 40.2 IP), 14 walks (8.2 BB%), and 55 strikeouts (32.4 K%)...Narrowed down to his last 5 starts, to Cumaná, Venezuela native is 0-4, yet holds a 3.00 ERA (9 ER in 27.0 IP) with 7 walks (6.2 BB%) and 36 strikeouts (32.1 K%)...In his first 9 appearances (8 starts), the right-hander was 1-4 with an 8.02 ERA (30 ER in 33.2 IP), 28 walks (16.5 BB%), and 39 strikeouts (23.1 K%).

PROSPECT RADAR: While not currently ranked, Suárez was deemed the Mets' No. 30 prospect entering the 2022 season by Baseball America...Considered the No. 25 farmhand entering 2021.

2022: Placed on Single-A St. Lucie's 60-day injured list to start the season...Sent on a rehab assignment with the Florida Complex League Mets on August 12...Tallied a 1-1 record with a 3.97 ERA (

5 ER in 11.1 IP) and 12 strikeouts in 6 games (3 starts)...Returned to St. Lucie on August 23...Registered an 0-2 mark with a 7.20 ERA (8 ER in 10.0 IP) and 13 K's in 4 appearances (2 starts).

**COMEBACK TRAIL:** Suárez is participating in his first full season since the 2019 campaign...The 23-year-old made 6 starts with Single-A St. Lucie in 2021 before undergoing Tommy John surgery in June...Made his return to play in game one of a doubleheader with the FCL Mets vs. the FCL Cardinals on July 14, 2022.
