TODAY'S GAME: The Curve continue a six-game series with the Portland Sea Dogs at Hadlock Field. Altoona dropped four-of-six at PNG Field in late-May against the Sea Dogs.

LAST TIME OUT: Portland's Isaac Coffey struck out 11 in 5.0 innings and the Curve dropped their series opener at Portland, 7-0.

THIS IS NOT A CIMULATION: First baseman Nick Cimillo has reached base safely in 9 straight games (July 30 - Present) during which he's batting: .400/.514/.600/1.114 with 3 2B, 1 HR, 6 RBI, 6 BB and 1-1 SB. Cimillo ranks second among Pirates minor leaguers in HR (19), RBI (56) and 1st in OPS (.999) among players who have taken 150 MiLB PA's this year.

THOMAS' ENGLISH MUFFINS ARE JULY'S CARB OF THE MONTH: After leading all Double-A pitchers in ERA (0.70) and strikeouts (32), right-hander Thomas Harrington was named the Eastern League's Pitcher of the Month. Harrington, who has since been promoted to Triple-A Indianapolis on August 4, is the first Curve player to earn a monthly honor since Barrett Barnes in 2016.

SOME KNOCKS: Altoona's 66 hits during their week-long series with Richmond from July 30 - August 4 were tied for the most by an Eastern League club (.322 batting average).

SLAMMIN' SAMMY SIANI: Outfielder Sammy Siani turned in one of his best weeks of the season against Richmond from July 30 - August 4, earning a hit in each of his five games played. During the week, he batting: .474/.524/.648/1.208 with 2 2B, 1 3B and 5 RBI.

**GENERATION Z**: Since July 23 (12 games) **Tsung-Che Cheng** has recorded a .396 on-base percentage. Six times in his last 12 games, Cheng has reached base safely in a game twice.

THREE BAGS ARE MY FAVORITE: The Curve matched the franchise record with three triples in a game on Friday, August 2 against Richmond. Yoyner Fajardo tripled home Eli Wilson in the second inning and then Abrahan Gutierrez and Sammy Siani hit triples on consecutive pitches in the seventh inning to match the record. It was the first time since June 2, 2022 that the Curve picked up three triples in a game, which they also did against the Flying Squirrels on that day.

LOTS OF PUNCHIES: Altoona has had 17 7-strikeout games this season, the most since 2018 when the Curve had 25 7-strikeout peformances. Tyler Glasnow in 2015 recorded 8 7-strikeout games, the most by an individual in a single-season in franchise history. Bubba Chandler has recorded six 7-strikeout games this season. The Curve are one of five teams in the affiliated minors and the only Double-A team to have three different pitchers (Thomas Harrington, Bubba Chandler and Braxton Ashcraft) strike out at least 11 batters in a game. The six 10-strikeout games by Curve pitchers this season are the most in a single-season in franchise history (35 total in first 24 years of the franchise).

NO STRESS FOR TRES: July has been the hottest month of the season for Tres Gonzalez. In 17 games during the calendar month, he batted .357/.429/.393 with 2 2B and 8 RBI. From July 23 - August 1 he put together a season-long seven-game hit streak which included three two-hit games and a three-hit game. After recording six multi-hit games in the first three months of the season, Gonzalez had seven multi-hit games in July.

THE CHEN CHRONICLES: Righty Po-Yu Chen overcame a difficult month of April (7.93 ERA) and hit his stride as of late. Chen has allowed one run or fewer 7 times in his last 12 outings, and since May 25 he has recorded a 2.43 ERA (20 ER / 74.0 IP) with 60 strikeouts. Chen ranks second in the Eastern League in ERA (2.44), fifth in strikeouts (58), second in batting average against (.215) and first in innings pitched (70.0) since the beginning of June.

THE SEA PUPPERS: Chad Epperson leads the Sea Dogs for his third season as Manager, he previously served as the Red Sox Catching Coordinator. Portland has many of the Red Sox top prospects according to MLB Pipeline including: No. 1 INF Marcelo Mayer (IL), No. 2 OF Roman Anthony, No. 3 C Kyle Teel, No. 5 RHP Wikelman Gonzalez, No. 19 INF Blaze Jordan, No. 25 RHP Hunter Dobbins. Former Sea Dog Nick Yorke was acqiured by the Pirates in exchange for RHP Quinn Priester at the trade deadline last week.

THE FIRST OUT OF BED: Connelly Early takes the ball for the Sea Dogs on Wednesday night. A 22-year-old from Midlothian, VA, Early was Boston's 5th round pick in 2023 out of the University of Virginia. Early posted big strikeout numbers at High-A this year (90 in 67.2 IP) and is making his third start with Portland tonight. Early, not all that dissimilar from Pirates righty Paul Skenes, left Army West Point after two seasons where he won back-to-back Patriot League championships to transfer to Virginia and was named a 3rd team All-ACC selection and led Virginia to a Super Regional appearance in his lone season with the Cavaliers. Early attended James River High School in Richmond and is probably looking forward to a chance to pitch against the Flying Squirrels. Early was a collegiate teammate of Curve killer Kyle Teel at UVA.

# **TODAY IN CURVE HISTORY**

1999 - Adam Hyzdu smacked his 19th homer of the Curve's inagural season (1-3 day), which was his fifth straight game with a home run, and extended his season-best hitting streak to 18 games. Stood as the longest hitting streak in franchise history until 2002 when Kevin Sefcik hit safely in 21 straight. HR streak stood until Brad Eldred's six straight in 2005.

2000 - Adam Hyzdu clobbered two home runs to run his season total to 28 and drove in five RBIs, went 4-5 in a 6-2 win over Erie at BCB. It was Hyzdu's sixth two-homer game, still standing as the most in a career by a Curve slugger.

Was rated as the 22nd-best international prospect for the 2019-20 signing period according to Fangraphs. Signed for \$1,250,000, one of the largest amounts in the 2019-20 International signing class for the Pirates. Pittsburgh was able to secure his services after trading for International Bonus Pool money in deals that sent Domingo Robles to St. Louis and Jarrod Dyson to the Chicago White Sox...
