12 game road trip. Stiven Acevedo put the Shorebirds ahead quickly with a two-run homer in the first, making it 2-0. Delmarva added two more runs in the fourth on a balk and then an RBI single by **Jalen Vasquez** extend-ed the lead to 4-0. **Juan Rojas** led the charge for the pitching staff as he dealt his best performance with the Shorebirds be throwing five shutout inning with a pair strikeouts. Stiven Acevedo continued his excellent night as he drove in two more runs with a single to give him a career-high four hits and four RBI, extending the lead to 7-0. Raul Rangel and Brayner Sanchez would follow Rojas and complete Delmarva's fourth shutout victory over the Hillcats.

TODAY'S OPPONENT: Deivy Cruz gets the ball for Game 2 against the Hillcats and he'll face Alonzo Richardson for Lynchburg who will be making his fifth start against Delmarva this season. Richardson pitched twice against the Shorebirds in the last series the two teams played and did not factor into the decision either time, but he combined to allow 3 runs in 9.2 innings. On the season, Richardson is 0-1 with an ERA of 5.95 in 19.2 innings versus the Shorebirds and has struck out 13 with 9 walks and a .338 opponent batting average. Last time out, Richardson went four shutout against the Fayettevile Woodpeckers and matched his season-best for strikeouts with six.

SPEED, I AM SPEED: Enrique Bradfield Jr. has made his presence felt since he's joined the Shorebirds as the 1st round pick from Vanderbilt has 13 steals in his starts as a Shorebird. He swiped 4 bases against the Carolina Mudcats on August 13 the most by a Delmarva player in a single game this season. More impressively, Brad-field has reached base at a .583 clip so far thanks to 15 walks he's drawn in his brief Single-A tenure. Bradfield has reached base in all 10 games a Shorebirds and is currently riding a 7 game hitting streak.

DRIVING THEM HOME IN BUNCHES: Anderson De Los Santos has gained steam as a key run producer for the Shorebirds as of late as he drove him six in the previous series against the Salem Red Sox and is the current leader on the team in RBI amongst active members with 41.

ON THE RUN: The Shorebirds currently ranked 11th in the league in stolen bases, but have been running much more lately as they have 47 steals in the month of August, which is second most in the league in that span (Augusta).

A LITTLE EXTRA: The offense for Delmarva leads the league in extra-base hits this season with a total of 278. They are top five in the league doubles (169), triples (30), and home runs (79). The Shorebirds produced 17 extra-base hits in the previous series against the Salem Red Sox.

FINAL ROAD TRIP OF THE SEASON: The Shorebirds embark on a 12 game road trip before returning home for the final series of the regular season. The first half of their two city trips is to Lynchburg against the Hillcats where the Shorebirds won four out of six from June 28 - July 3. Delmarva was won the first two series against Lynchburg and split their most previous one in Salisbury and currently hold an 12-7 record against the Guardians affiliate this season.

TODAY'S STARTER: Deivy Cruz takes the mound for Game 2 against the Lynchburg Hillcats, making his 22nd appearance and 14th start.

LAST OUTING (8/17 vs SAL): Cruz took a loss last time out against the Salem Red Sox on Thursday as he allowed 3 runs on 3 hits in with 4 strikeouts but also walked 4 and hit 3 batters. Salem would go onto win the game 4-2.

vs. LYNCHBURG: This will be the fifth time this season Cruz pitches against the Lynchburg Hillcats with his most recent outing coming on August 5 where he did not factor into the decision, throwing 4 innings allowing 2 runs and a season-high 7 hits, while matching his careerbest with 7 strikeouts. On the season, Cruz is 2-0 with a 2.04 ERA in 17.2 innings and has struck out 17 against Lynchburg.

2022 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS: At 18 years old, Deivy Cruz was a bright spot in the in the Orioles organization pitching most of the season in Delmarva. He began in the FCL and made 3 starts that covered 13 innings, striking out 17 with 4 earned run allowed. Was moved up to the Shorebirds on June 21 and would appear in 13 games, 12 starts where he finished with an ERA of 4.02 and a 2-5 record. Opponents hit .224 against Cruz as he struck out 52 with 37 walks during his time in Delmarva. He was very effective in his first two months in a Shorebird uniform as he allowed just 3 earned runs across his first 6 starts that covered 26.1 innings in June & July.

REVERSE SPLITS: Despite being left-handed, Cruz has handled rig handed batters better than lefties as he owns an opponent batting average of .191 versus righties with an opposing OPS of .616


