OWNER'S BOX

STEVEN A. COHEN

OWNER, CHAIRMAN AND CEO

- Steve Cohen is the chairman and majority owner of the New York Mets, Brooklyn Cyclones, Syracuse Mets and St. Lucie Mets. He bought the team in 2020 and is working on revamping the team's operations to help turn it into a perennial World Series contender with a first-class experience for Mets fans.
- Grew up in Great Neck, New York, where he would take the Long Island Railroad to Mets games and sit in the upper deck.
- Mr. Cohen is the founder, chairman and chief executive officer of Point72 Asset Management, an alternative investment firm with more than 1,600 employees around the globe. He founded S.A.C. Capital Advisors, the predecessor investment firm to Point72, in 1992. The Firm has built a reputation as an industry-leader in talent development, innovation and the use of alternative data analytics.
- In 2016, Mr. Cohen leveraged his lengthy career in the public markets to found Point72 Ventures, which focuses on early-stage investments in private companies in fintech, artificial intelligence and machine learning, enterprise technologies and digital healthcare.
- Mr. Cohen is also an avid philanthropist and has founded and holds active leadership roles in several non-profit organizations.
- Mr. Cohen and his wife, Alexandra, founded the Steven & Alexandra Cohen Foundation in 2001. The Foundation is committed to achieving lasting and meaningful change through commitments to children's health, education, veterans, and the arts. He created Cohen Veterans Network and Cohen Veterans Bioscience in 2015 to improve the mental healthcare, treatment, and quality of life for veterans and their families.
- He serves on the Board of Trustees at the Museum of Contemporary Art (MOCA) in Los Angeles, the Emeritus Board of the Robin Hood Foundation, and the Museum of Modern Art (MoMA) Board of Trustees.
- Mr. Cohen received a BS in economics from the University of Pennsylvania's Wharton School. He began his investing career at Gruntal & Co. in New York, where he managed proprietary capital for 14 years before starting his own investment business.
- He currently lives with his wife in Greenwich, Connecticut. He has seven children and is an avid art collector.



ALEXANDRA M. COHEN

OWNER & PRESIDENT OF AMAZIN' METS FOUNDATION

- Alexandra M. Cohen is the President of the Steven & Alexandra Cohen Foundation, the non-profit organization that she and her husband Steven cofounded in 2001.
- She directs strategic initiatives and leads the day-to-day operations of the Foundation, which is committed to inspiring philanthropy and community service by creating awareness, offering guidance and leading by example to show the world what giving can do.
- Over the past two decades, they have given more than \$958 million in gifts to organizations that improve children's healthcare and education, serve the underserved, support the arts, protect the environment, and further research in the areas of Lyme and tickborne disease and Psychedelics therapy. Their giving often reflects a personal connection with the causes and communities they support.
- Mrs. Cohen was born in Harlem, New York and grew up in Washington Heights. After studying Communications at New York's Manhattan College, she worked in the financial industry until she married Steven Cohen in 1992. Since then, Mrs. Cohen focused on raising her family and driving their philanthropic endeavors.
- Mrs. Cohen is a member of the Honorary Council of the Bob Woodruff Foundation and the New York Restoration Project Chairman's Council

- Andrew B. Cohen is the Vice Chairman, member of the board of directors since 2012, and a minority owner of the New York Mets Baseball Club.
- He is the Chief Investment Officer and Co-Founder of Cohen Private Ventures which invests long-term capital, primarily in direct private investments and other opportunistic transactions, and manages family office activities, on behalf of Steven A. Cohen and his family.
- Prior to his position with Cohen Private Ventures, he was an Analyst and Portfolio Manager at the Firm from 2002 to 2005, investing in public equities and debt securities.
- Began his career at Morgan Stanley where he was an Analyst in the real estate department and principal investing group (MSREF) and then an Associate in the mergers and acquisitions group post business school.
- He is a member of the board of directors of several public and private companies.
- Received his B.A. from the University of Pennsylvania and his M.B.A. from the Wharton School of the University of Pennsylvania.
- Andrew resides in Manhattan with his wife and two children.

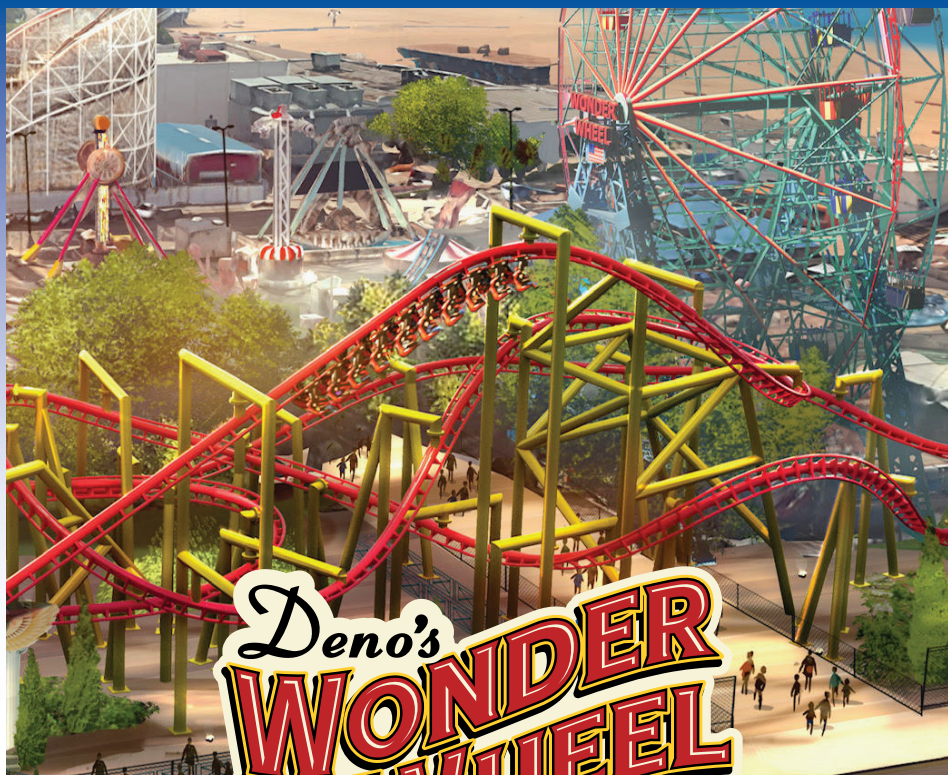

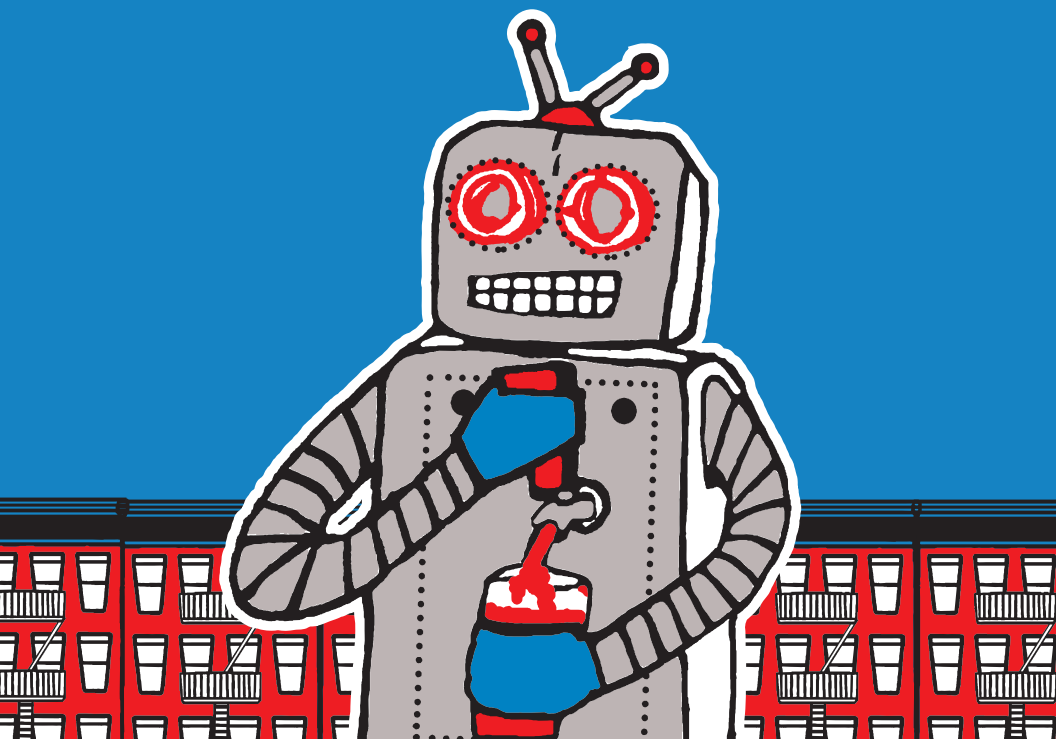

Justin Courtney has gone from Maine to movie star. The Brooklyn Cyclones reliever stepped out of his dream this past October to act out someone else's.

Thanks to networking and true luck, Courtney plays a young Nolan Ryan in the new documentary on the Hall of Fame pitcher called "Facing Nolan" which made a one-day stop in theaters across the country on May 24th and will be circulated by Utopia – a movie distribution company – to streaming platforms in the coming weeks and months.

In one 12-hour period of overnight filming in Austin, Texas at the home of the Round Rock Express, Courtney twisted and turned, twirled and spun pitch after pitch, donning a pair of jerseys that Ryan wore during his 27-year big league career. Two of those teams, the California Angels and the New York Mets, also happen to be the two teams that Courtney has pitched for in his minor league career. That luck led Courtney to the production company through a man named Tom House.

House, a pitching coach whisperer and sometimes referred to as a "throwing doctor," trained Ryan during the late years of his career, helping the flame-thrower pitch into his 40s. House is a master of pitching, conditioning, and

recovery who Courtney also works with closely. When The Ranch Productions called him to ask if he knew of a good candidate for the movie shoot, the "throwing doctor" also became "casting director."

"Tom texted me and told me about this cool opportunity," Courtney recalled. "They were looking for a pitcher to come down to Austin for a week and the timing was perfect right after the season."

Off the big righty from Bangor, Maine went, traveling down to Texas to go play Ryan in a documentary. And the only reason he came to mind is because he has pitched in the Angels organization in 2021 and ended up with the Mets.

"The week leading up, the production company sent me clips of him and basically said 'replicate this,'" Courtney said. "I practiced in front of a mirror for a week."

The shoot took place in a 12-hour period, standard amongst film shoots, in an overnight period so the production company could recreate night game experiences. Under movie and stadium lights, dressed in his vintage best, Courtney worked and worked.

"It was 2 a.m. and I'm thinking, 'this is so

crazy and cool,” Courtney said. “There was so much setup with this crew and they were so intense. Every shot was so meticulous.”

All in all, Courtney said he threw more than 150 pitches that night, generating multiple shots from the different angles with different jerseys. It was truly exhausting, especially since he had not picked up a baseball since the season ended just weeks before.

One of the coolest memories from the shoot, and one of the hardest, which Courtney does not even know if it would make it in the film, came when he was throwing to a real batter. Courtney was tasked with throwing his hardest to the catcher’s glove in the exact spot, mixing both fastballs and change-ups. With a camera positioned perfectly over the catcher’s shoulder and right behind the glove, Courtney had to do his best archer impression at the Olympics and be as precise as humanly possible. One wrong move, the glove shifting left, right, above, or below, and the shot was lost. At the same time, a real batter had to take a full game-speed swing at the pitch and miss, recreating a big moment from Ryan’s career.

“I must have thrown 20 or so pitches,” Courtney said. “It was so difficult. And even when we nailed the shot I had to do it five more times.”

Courtney experienced a one-week trip to Austin for free, a chance at five minutes of Hollywood fame, and a lifetime with the best dinner party story.

But now, at least for the moment, he’s back living out his own dreams

- Chris resides in Clarkston, MI...He has one daughter, Peyton.



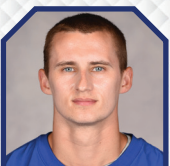

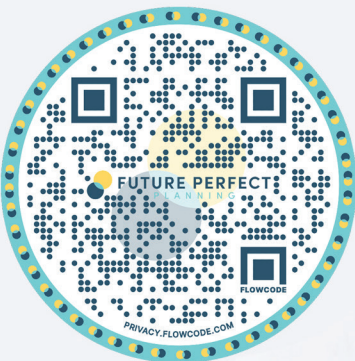

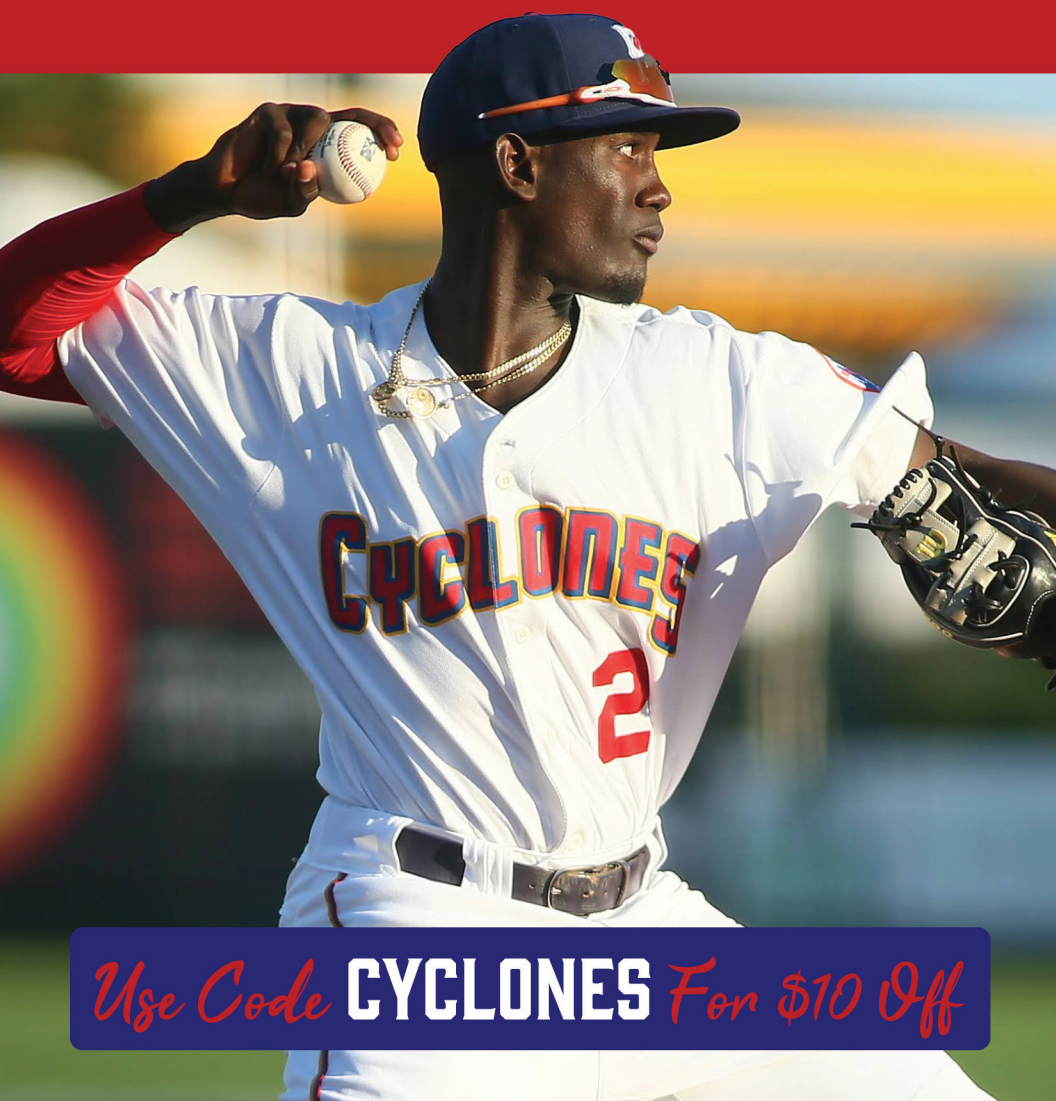
