- Fort Myers walked off Dunedin for a second straight night to open the series, using a Byron Chourio sacrifice fly to center to hand the Blue Javs a 5-4 loss in 11 innings.
- After falling behind 2-0 in the bottom of the third, Jean Joseph delivered a 2-RBI double in the fourth to put the Jays ahead.
- Juaron Watts-Brown pitched six innings for the first time this season, allowing 2 ER while striking out five.
- Trailing 4-3 in the ninth, Dunedin tied the game in the ninth, as Daniel Perez opened the frame with a triple, and Joseph drove him in with an RBI single. However, the Jays left the bases loaded to end the inning.
- The Blue Jays failed to score in the 10th and 11th, setting up Fort Myers' walk-off in the bottom of the 11th.

HEARTBREAKERS

Last night's defeat was the Blue Jays' second straight walk off loss, and fourth this season in 14 road games.

EXTRA-FRUSTRATING

With last night's loss, Dunedin is 0-3 in extra inning contests this season, with all three losses coming on the road. Blue Jays' bats are just 1-12 in extras with six strikeouts.

SLIMMEST OF MARGINS

Last night's loss continued the trend of close games for Dunedin, as 15 of the Blue Jays' last 17 contests have been decided by four or fewer runs. Dunedin has gone 4-11 in those games.

LEFT STRANDED

Last night's 13 men left on base marked a new season high for the Blue Jays. Dunedin went 4-19 with runners in scoring position.

STAYING UP LATE

The Blue Jays have scored in the seventh inning or later in six of their last seven games, including each of the first two games of this week's series

STRONG FIRST IMPRESSION

Blue Jays outfielder Jean Joseph is off to a strong start in Single-A, having reached in all nine games he's played with Dunedin. The 19-year old has driven in at least one run in three straight games, and has walked (6) nearly as much as he's struck out (8).

FANTASTIC MR. FELIZ

With a two-run homer Tuesday, Cristian Feliz leads the Blue Jays with 5 homers. Feliz's two-homer performance Saturday night marked the first by a Blue Jay this season. Feliz's current four-game on-base streak is his longes this season. Feliz's 41% hard-hit rate leads Dunedin (16th in the FSL), but his 49% K-rate leads the FSL.

TRIPLE THE FUN

After a 2-4 outing last night, Daniel Perez has four hits in Single-A. Three of them are triples.

IN THE ARIAS TONIGHT

Victor Arias ranks among the league's leading hitters in nearly every major rate stat. Arias is top 10 in average (8th - .304), OBP (9th - .396), SLG (10th - .456), and OPS (9th - .852). Arias has more multi-hit games (7) than hitless games (5).

YOUNG GUN

Dunedin shortstop Arjun Nimmala is the second-youngest player in the Florida State league to open the season, at 18.5 years old (behind Daytona's Alfredo Duno at 18.2). Maykel Minoso joins Nimmala as the second 18 year old on the Blue Jays' roster.

FREE PASSES

The Blue Jays racked up 10 walks last night - marking the third time this season Dunedin has drawn double-digit walks. The Jays are third in the FSL in walks drawn with 138 (behind Tampa and Lakeland). However, Dunedin's pitching staff has walked the most batters in the league at 146.
